

• Louisiana Tech aims to snap a three-game losing streak on Saturday as the Bulldogs host CUSA newcomer Delaware inside the Thomas Assembly Center on Karl Malone Court.

• This will be just the second meeting between LA Tech and Delaware on the hardwood. The inaugural matchup came in 2018 when the Bulldogs made the long trek to Newark, Delaware to take part in the Delaware Invitational. LA Tech would go 0-2 in the multi-team event, falling 80-73 to UNC Greensboro and 75-71 to host Delaware. At the time, LA Tech had two players – DaQuan Bracey and Anthony Duruji – from Maryland, which was the primary reason the Bulldogs played in the non-conference MTE.

• Delaware will be the 22nd different opponent LA Tech will face as part of CUSA. The Bulldogs are 16-5 all-time in the first matchup against a new CUSA opponent. They have never lost at home in such contests, going 11-0.

• LA Tech had its nine-game home winning streak end Thursday, falling 72-56 to Liberty. Facing one of the best three-point shooting teams in the country, the Bulldogs matched the Flames as both squads went exactly 9-of-24 from beyond the arc. The difference in the game ended up being the paint where LU had a 28-18 scoring advantage and outrebounded LA Tech, 41-33.

• Defensively, the Bulldogs were able to hold the Flames under their shooting percentages. LU came into the contest shooting 52.3 percent from the field (shot 46.3 percent) and 40.4 percent from beyond the arc (shot 37.5 percent). LA Tech continues to boast the No. 2 in the country in scoring defense (59.9) as well as third in the nation in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 37.0 percent from the field.

• **DJ Dudley** scored a game-high 17 points against Liberty. He currently anchors the team with an average of 12.1 points per contest. The junior also leads the Bulldogs in most games as the top scorer (six) and most double-digit scoring efforts (nine). He went 3-of-5 from deep versus the Flames, extending his streak with at least one triple to 10 games (has multiple threes in seven). In doing so, LA Tech has now had a different Bulldog each season have such a streak for 13 consecutive years. After missing his first eight three-point attempts through the first five games, he has gone 24-of-50 (48.0 percent) over the last 10 contests.

• **AJ Bates** tallied eight points to go along with three assists. The sophomore guard, who has started every game this season, has registered at least three dimes in 14 of the 15 contests. He currently ranks top 40 in the country in both total assists (85) and assists per game (5.7), both of which rank third in CUSA.

• **Avery Thomas II** pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds against Liberty, marking his second contest this season with double-digit rebounds (season high is 16 versus Dallas Christian). LA Tech has had at least one Bulldog record 10+ boards in six games this season.

• **Talvin Hester** enters his fourth season at the helm at LA Tech. In his third year, Hester guided the Bulldogs to a 20-win season, marking the 30th time in program history the team has reached 20+ victories. This was the second straight season Hester led the team to 20 wins, going 22-10 in 2013-14. As a result, he became the seventh head coach in program history to register back-to-back 20-win seasons.

TALVIN HESTER

HEAD COACH | 4th SEASON

ATTITUDE AND EFFORT.

They are more than words on a wall or slogans on a t-shirt. Inside the Louisiana Tech men's basketball program, they are a mindset — a daily standard.

For head coach Talvin Hester, who enters his fourth year at the helm of the Bulldogs, these two pillars are not just motivational fluff. In a game full of variables, he believes attitude and effort are the two things you can always bring — and always control.

Emphasizing attitude and effort helped the 19th head coach in program history orchestrated a 20-win campaign in his latest season and three All-Conference selections, highlighted by Daniel Batcho who was named CUSA Defensive Player of the Year. Batcho ranked 27th nationally with 64 blocks, anchoring a team identity built around attitude and effort.

The Bulldogs opened the year with a scorching 7-0 start—the program's best since the 1984-85 season—and went on to capture the Gulf Coast Showcase championship, earning victories over Southern Illinois, Richmond, and Eastern Kentucky. The team also tallied a signature non-conference win against WAC Tournament champion Grand Canyon in the WAC/CUSA Challenge.

Under Hester's leadership, the Bulldogs set a program record for single-season free throw percentage, shooting 75.0 percent from the line and surpassing a mark that had stood since the 1976-77 season. The squad continued to hang their hat on defense, finishing top 50 in the nation in both field goal percentage defense (41.3) and three-point field goal percentage defense (30.9).

Hester was named NABC District 11 Coach of the Year and a Ben Jobe Award finalist after guiding LA Tech to a 22-10 overall record in his second season at the helm. LA Tech registered a 12-4 CUSA record, finishing second in the league. The Bulldogs went 8-7 in road games, including a 6-2 mark in league contests away from home.

They ranked as the top CUSA team in both NET rankings and KenPom while sporting one of the best defenses in the country. The Bulldogs ranked seventh in the nation in field goal percentage defense, allowing teams to shoot just 39.1 percent (lowest in program history since the 1957-58 season). LA Tech held 20 teams under 40 percent shooting this season, tied for the third most in the country. They also ranked 16th in the nation in scoring defense, holding their opponents to 64.5 points per game.

Among the players Hester helped develop were Isaiah Crawford who was voted CUSA Player of the Year/CUSA Defensive Player of the Year as well as Batcho who was selected as the CUSA Newcomer of the Year. Crawford, who is now with the Houston Rockets organization in his second season in the NBA, and Batcho were joined by Tahlik Chavez and Sean Newman Jr. as All-CUSA honorees, the most in program history since 1985.

Hester led LA Tech to a 15-win season in his first season as head coach, picking up his first ever victory in the season opener against Mississippi College as well as claiming the title of the Samford MTE with wins over Alabama A&M, Tennessee-Southern, and host Samford.

Hester brought 20 years of coaching experience back to Ruston, a place he spent three seasons (2018-21) as an assistant coach with the Bulldogs. He departed for Texas Tech, spending one season as an assistant coach where he helped the third-seeded Red Raiders reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

While in Lubbock, he worked under Associated Press Big 12 Coach of the Year Mark Adams. Texas Tech put together a 27-win season including victories over Montana State and Notre Dame to help the program make its fifth Sweet 16 appearance in program history. TTU, which had five All-Big 12 selections, was ranked as high as No. 9 in the country and reached the Big 12 championship final for just the second time in program history. The Red Raiders had the No. 1 ranked defense in the country (per Kenpom.com) while limiting opponents to only 60.2 points per game, holding teams to 38.2 percent shooting and forcing 15.9 turnovers per contest.

During his three successful years at LA Tech under Eric Konkol, Hester helped the Bulldogs register three winning seasons of 20-plus victories. The 2020-21 season saw the 'Dogs register a 24-8 overall record while claiming a CUSA West Division title and a third place finish in the National Invitation Tournament. The team received an at-large berth to play in the NIT for the first time since 2015 and became just the second team in program history to make the Final Four.

LA Tech, which had the highest-rated defense in CUSA ranking top 30 in the country in field goal percentage defense and three-point field goal percentage defense, upset Ole Miss in the first round, defeated league foe WKU in the quarterfinals and won a 76-74 thriller over No. 1 overall seed Colorado State in the Final Four consolation game.

In his second season in 2019-20, the Bulldogs registered a 22-8 overall record during the regular slate, but the team did not have a chance at postseason play with the CUSA and NCAA/NIT Tournaments being canceled due to the public health threat of COVID-19. The 22 wins ended up being the most victories of any CUSA team and of any Louisiana Division I team. The Bulldogs also recorded a 13-5 league record, finishing in a tie for second place.

In his first year with the 'Dogs, Hester helped the team to 20 victories, eight of those coming against teams who also produced 20-win seasons, the most in program history. One of those came in the season opener at Wichita State as the Bulldogs shocked the Shockers, handing them only their fourth loss in their last 76 home games.

Along with the four Bulldogs who earned All-CUSA honors in 2023-24, Hester has also coached All-CUSA selections DaQuan Bracey (First Team), Kenneth Lofton Jr. (Third Team and CUSA Freshman of the Year), Cobe Williams (Honorable Mention), and Keaston Willis (Honorable Mention) as well as Jordan Crawford who was chosen to the CUSA All-Freshman Team for the 2022-23 season. Lofton, who spent two seasons in the NBA with the Memphis Grizzlies, Philadelphia 76ers, and Utah Jazz, plays in China where he was named the Best International Player in 2024-25 with the Shanghai Sharks.

Hester began his coaching career in 2002 at North Lake College in Irving, Texas before he spent one year at his alma mater Texas Wesleyan and one at Texas College. His coaching resume also includes a stop with the Texas Rim Rockers of the United States Basketball League as an assistant coaching intern and the Dallas Mustangs AAU team for one season. He was an assistant coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas for the 2004-05 season before going to Prairie View A&M.

As a student-athlete, Hester played at Dallas Christian College during the 1996-97 season.

/// THE OPPONENT

ABOUT DELAWARE

Delaware is playing its inaugural season in Conference USA, joining the league as a full member. The Blue Hens spent the last 24 seasons competing in the Colonial Athletic Association.

UD had a strong finish to non-conference play, winning three straight over George Washington, Cal State-Northridge, and Rider. Then Blue Hens then opened CUSA play with three straight home games, dropping contests to Missouri State and Jacksonville State before claiming its first CUSA win which was a 67-52 victory over Kennesaw State.

Most recently, UD suffered a 72-60 road loss to Sam Houston as the Bearkats led wire-to-wire.

SHOT MAKING

Delaware is one of the better shooting teams in the league. The Blue Hens are shooting 35.0 percent from beyond the arc with an average of 8.5 made triples per game.

They have made at least nine three-pointers in nine of their 15 games, including 10 in their matchup with Sam Houston on Thursday.

BLISS-FUL BLUE HEN

Christian Bliss has been a welcome addition for Delaware. The junior guard, who spent the last two seasons at Virginia, has been stuffing the stat sheet so far this season.

He is averaging a team-high 15.3 points per game, having made a team-high 36 three-pointers (has scored in double figures in 13 of the 15 games played). He also is a strong converter from the free throw line, having made 45 of his 53 attempts for an 84.9 percent shooting clip. On top of that, he ranks second in CUSA and 20th in the country with an average of 6.3 assists per contest. Defensively, he owns a team-high 29 steals.

Bliss rarely leaves the floor, as evident by him leading the entire country in minutes per game (38:47). He has played every minute in eight games this season, including the overtime loss to Delaware State.

MISSING REILLY

Delaware has been riddled with injuries this season, none more so than Cavan Reilly. The CUSA All-Preseason selection who has been a primary starter for the Blue Hens the last two seasons has seen action in only one game this season, which was the season opener.

NEWARK, Del. – The Louisiana Tech men's basketball team was very efficient on offense against the zone of Delaware, but the Bulldogs' defensive woes was too much to overcome as they narrowly fell to the Blue Hens 75-71 inside the Bob Carpenter Center.

Offensively, LA Tech shot 47 percent from beyond the arc which included eight three-pointers. They were also a perfect 11-of-11 from the foul line. Unfortunately, Delaware had just as much success on offense, regaining the lead down the stretch to seal it.

From a score standpoint, the game was much like that of Saturday night when the Bulldogs trailed by only one or two possessions for the majority of time.

The 'Dogs built as much as a five-point lead (21-16) on one of sophomore Amorie Archibald's three triples midway through the first half, but the Blue Hens quickly responded with five straight points and eventually took the lead at 26-25 with 4:12 to go and held the lead for the rest of the first stanza and for over 12 minutes into the second stanza.

This time, LA Tech was able to string together a few much-needed stops and made them count on the offensive end. Down two, senior Derric Jean drilled one of his four three-pointers to help give the Bulldogs a lead at 57-56 with 7:18 to play.

After getting a stop on Delaware's next offensive possession, Jean pushed the ball up the floor and made a gorgeous bounce pass to junior Oliver Powell who made the fastbreak layup which forced a Blue Hens timeout.

However, a technical foul called on sophomore Anthony Duruji during the break ultimately resulted in a five-point swing for Delaware who sank the two free throws and got a corner three-pointer from Matt Veretto right as the shot clock expired.

Powell was able to make another contested layup to tie it at 61-61 with 5:38 to go, but the Bulldogs had trouble stopping Delaware, in particular Eric Carter, who made five of his team-high 23 points over the next three minutes of action when the Blue Hens scored on four straight possessions.

FUN FACTS OF THE GAME

GAME 1 | LA TECH AT NEVADA

LA Tech opened the 2025-26 season at Nevada, marking the fourth straight season the Bulldogs have faced a current Mountain West Conference opponent in the non-conference slate.

GAME 2 | LA TECH VS. LYON

The Bulldogs held the Scots to just 35 points, the fewest in a single game since Nov. 13, 2015, when LA Tech held Millsaps College to 33 points. The 35 points was the second fewest allowed by the Bulldogs in the TAC.

GAME 3 | LA TECH VS. JACKSON STATE

LA Tech pulled down 57 total rebounds, the most in a single game since Nov. 26, 2022, against Tennessee-Southern. It is the most against a DI opponent since the Bulldogs had 57 against San Jose State on Feb. 15, 2006.

GAME 4 | LA TECH AT INDIANA STATE

Scooter Williams registered the first double-double of the season for the Bulldogs with 23 points and 11 rebounds. He is only the fourth LA Tech guard in the last 10 years with a 20/10 game (first since 2023).

GAME 5 | LA TECH VS. INDIANA STATE

DJ Dudley hit the game-winning shot with 1.4 seconds left to give the Bulldogs the 75-73 win over the Sycamores. It was the first game-winner by LA Tech in the final two seconds since Kenneth Lofton Jr. did it in 2021 to defeat Colorado State in the NIT consolation game.

GAME 6 | LA TECH VS. ALCORN STATE

LA Tech went 2-0 in its home MTE, defeating Alcorn State, 83-58, following a 2-point victory over Indiana State. The Bulldogs have won 14 straight MTE contests dating back to 2020.

GAME 7 | LA TECH AT GA. SOUTHERN

LA Tech limited Georgia Southern to 27.3 percent from three-point range. Not a single opponent through seven games this season has shot over 30.0 percent from beyond the arc.

GAME 8 | LA TECH VS. ECCLESIA

LA Tech shot 65.4 percent while limiting Ecclesia College to 24.1 percent. This marked the first time in at least 25 years that the Bulldogs shot over 60 percent and held their opponent to under 30 percent in the same game.

GAME 9 | LA TECH VS. UL-LAFAYETTE

LA Tech extended its winning streak to three over rival UL-Lafayette, the longest streak for the Bulldogs versus the Ragin' Cajuns since 1997-98. It also marked the 1,500th win in program history for the Bulldogs.

GAME 10 | LA TECH AT TULANE

LA Tech held Tulane to just 61 points on 17 made field goals and just three made three-pointers, all season lows for the Green Wave. The Bulldogs have now held seven of their 10 opponents to less than 65 points this season.

GAME 11 | LA TECH VS. DCC

LA Tech went a perfect 7-0 in non-conference home games. The Bulldogs have now been perfect at home in non-conference in six of the last eight seasons (28 of 44 seasons in the TAC). The team is now 218-22 all-time in non-conference home contests in the TAC.

GAME 12 | LA TECH VS. UTEP

Six Bulldogs scored in double figures, the first time that has happened since Dec. 22, 2021, versus Crowley's Ridge. It was the first time against a DI opponent since Feb. 8, 2020, versus Marshall.

GAME 13 | LA TECH AT MTSU

DJ Dudley connected for two three-pointers, extending his streak of games with at least one triple to eight. He has made multiple threes in six of the eight contests.

GAME 14 | LA TECH AT WKU

BRYCE DIXON

Bryce Dixon is a 6-foot-4, 197-pound guard who hails from Cedar Hill, Texas and plays for The Colony High School. He has already showcased his elite talent this season by being named HoopDFW Player of the Week after averaging 39.5 points and 8.0 rebounds, highlighted by a school-record 48-point game against Denton Guyer.

His junior year featured a dominant two-way impact as he was voted the 12-5A District Defensive MVP, earned First Team All-District, and secured a spot on the UIL All-Region 2 Team. During the season, he also eclipsed 1,000 career points.

ADAM BOYD

Adam Boyd, a 6-foot-4, 170-pound guard, enters his senior high school season at Atascocita as one of the most highly regarded guards in the state of Texas. The three-star prospect is ranked No. 3 in the Greater Houston Area by OTR Exposure, No. 18 in Texas, and the No. 38 point guard in the country by Rivals/On3.

As a junior, the Humble, Texas native earned First Team All-District and All-Region honors after averaging 12 points and three assists, helping lead Atascocita (along with current Bulldog Jaylen Fenner) to the UIL Class 6A Division I regional semifinals.

TRASHAUN COMBS-PIERCE

Trashaun Combs-Pierce, a 6-foot-8, 210-pound forward, emerged as one of the top frontcourt players in the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference. As a freshman at Independence Community College, he earned KJCCC All-Conference Honorable Mention, averaging 11.6 points, 7.8 rebounds, and 51 blocks, while leading the team with nine double-doubles.

The Norman, Oklahoma, native, who's mother, Tashia, played for the Lady Techsters (2004-05) starred for Norman High School, where he was named to The Oklahoman's 2024 Big All-City First Team as a senior after averaging 17.2 points, 9.8 rebounds, and 3.1 blocks.

BRAYLON WENGER

Braylon Wenger, a 6-foot-7, 205-pound wing plays for Trinity Valley Community College. Last season, he played a key role off the bench for a Trinity Valley squad that captured the 2025 NJCAA DI national championship, averaging 5.0 points and 1.6 rebounds.

Wenger competed for the IMG Academy post-grad team in 2024. He also starred at Dalton High School, where he was named the 2023 Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Association Division IV State Player of the Year, averaging 25.2 points and 7.6 rebounds. He led Dalton to a league title, the school's first district championship in 21 years.

POST-BATCHO

It will be easy to notice that Daniel Batcho is no longer on the basketball floor for the Bulldogs this season.

After manning the paint for the past two seasons at LA Tech as a two-time First Team All-CUSA selection, CUSA Newcomer of the Year, and CUSA Defensive Player of the Year, it will now be Bulldog-by-committee in replacing Batcho's production.

LA Tech brought in a trio of big men to protect the rim this season -- 6-foot-10 Sir Issac Herron, 6-foot-10 Kylan Howze, and 7-foot Melian Martinez.

UNCLE WILL

Will Allen (aka Uncle Will because he's old) is back for his fifth year with the program.

The 24-year old who graduated this past summer brings a wealth of leadership to a fresh roster. He will also be counted on for his playing experience where he enters the season having seen action in 89 career games for LA Tech, including 20 starts.

AIR KADEN RETURNS

Kaden Cooper, who was one of 10 players voted to the Conference USA All-Preseason Team, is back with the Bulldogs after having a standout season last year following the transfer from Oklahoma.

He appeared in all 32 games for LA Tech as a sophomore while making 30 starts. He averaged 9.3 points per game, shooting 47.6 percent from the field.

He made his mark as one of the top rebounding guards in the country after leading the 'Dogs on the boards with an average of 7.8 per contest. His 6.22 defensive rebounds per game average ranked first in CUSA and 32nd in the country.

Cooper led the Bulldogs in rebounding 18 times while registering 10 double-digit rebounding games. Over his last seven games last season, he averaged 10.1 rebounds.

AJ PLAYS IN CZECH REPUBLIC

AJ Bates was selected to join Athletes in Action Basketball for an international tour this past summer, traveling to the Czech Republic.

He was part of a select team comprised of student-athletes from eight college basketball programs across the country. The team competed in exhibition games against the Czech Republic's U20 and U23 national teams while also participating in outreach activities, including a one-day youth basketball camp and coaching clinic.

He helped Athletes in Action go 3-1 while averaging 14.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, and 7.3 assists per game.

COMEBACK FOR WILL JEFFRESS

It is comeback season for Will Jeffress.

Following a four-year stint in his home state at Pittsburgh, the Bulldog had gotten off to a terrific start in his first year at LA Tech last season, starting in the first three games while averaging 12.5 points and 8.0 rebounds going into the Nov. 13, 2024 contest versus UMass in Long Island, New York.

Late in the first half, Jeffress went for a loose ball and suffered a season-ending injury.

He is back for the Bulldogs in a redemption year as his last collegiate season.

Jeffress graduated in 3.5 years from Pitt with two degrees in Psychology and Communications. He was a three-time ACC All-Academic Team selection and a 2024 Academic All-District honoree.

LOST PRODUCTION

LA Tech will have to replace 78.5 percent of its scoring from a season ago, including its top four scorers. By comparison, the Bulldogs have lost approximately 60 percent of its scoring the previous two seasons.

WE LOST A LEGEND

June 24, 2025 was a sad day for Louisiana Tech as Dave Nitz -- the legendary Voice of the Bulldogs for half a century -- passed away at the age of 82.

A proud native of Milton, West Virginia, Dave's journey to Ruston was paved with a passion for the microphone. It was the spring of 1974 — the NCAA District Tournament at old Arlington Stadium — when he first called LA Tech baseball, the sport he loved above all others.

That marked the beginning of something special.

Later that fall, Dave officially joined the Louisiana Tech Football Network. And over the next half century, he became the voice of Bulldog athletics behind the mic for football, basketball, and baseball. His calls weren't just descriptions of the action — they were memories etched in time.

By best estimates, Dave called more than 4,500 Louisiana Tech games. That's thousands of moments, plays, and stories told by someone who truly loved telling them.

DUNKIN' DOGS TBT TEAM

For the first time, alumni of the Louisiana Tech Men's Basketball program formed a team called Dunkin' Dogs, which took part in The Basketball Tournament (TBT), the 64 team, \$1 million winner-take-all event.

The Bulldogs victory over Southern Miss on Jan. 13, 2022 turned out to be their 100th CUSA victory. It took them only 145 games to get there, the second fastest of any team in league history behind only Cincinnati.
