Location and Directions

Ortmayer Stadium, 1950 3rd Street, La Verne, CA 91750

From I-10, take the Towne Ave. exit. Keep right at the fork to stay on Towne Ave (0.1 miles). On the first traffic light, make a left onto La Verne Ave. (1.2 miles). When reaching the final cross street on La Verne Ave., make a left onto Arrow Highway (0.9 miles). Make a right onto D. St. (0.1 miles). Make a left onto 3rd St. (0.1 miles)

From 210 E take the Foothill Blvd exit. Take Foothill Blvd (1.3 miles) to D. St. and take a right. Drive down D. St. (1.0 mile) to 2nd St. and make a right into Pavilion Parking Lot.

Entry Information

Open entries available for **4x800, 3000m Steeple, 5000m and 10000m only.** \$40 per entry. No entry standards. **Collegiate athletes only, no unattached entries.** Late entries \$80 per entry.

The primary goal of this meet is also to accommodate athletes who cannot get into Bryan Clay Invite sections and want to run at night, or who don't meet the BC entry standards.

Entries must be made online through Direct Athletics. Entries will close at 1pm on Tuesday, April 9th, 2024. Late entries will be allowed **until 12pm on Friday April 12**th, and on a case by case basis after that. Entries are public on Direct Athletics (click View All Entries). We will consider speculative marks and entry notes provided, but priority will be given to verified marks run in the event being contested.

We are hoping to provide opportunities for athletes pursuing times that are regionally/nationally competitive in D2/D3 (mid-low 14s, mid-low 29s, low 17s/sub 17, mid-low 35s/sub 35). We are going to try to arrange pacers accordingly for the fast sections of each event. Please send pacing requests to Jamie Norton inorton2@laverne.edu. Please let us know if you know people who can pace.

We do not have an entry standard!! We will run as many open sections as needed to accommodate whatever athletes you want to bring, but please note that due to our city-imposed lighting restrictions slower sections *may* need to take place before sunset. See very tentative schedule below.

The SCIAC multi-dual on Saturday April 13th is a CLOSED meet, no athletes from non-invited teams will be added to these events under ANY circumstances.

Parking

The University of La Verne would like to ask that any guests visiting the University of La Verne Ortmayer Stadium to please park in the La Verne Parking Structure on 1st, accessible from D street. *Timed parking is available near the University in the business district allowing parking for 90 minutes and 3 hours.* Please check posted signs for parking hours and availability. ADA Parking available in Lot A off of 3rd St.

Bus Parking

The loading and unloading area for buses and other high occupancy passenger vehicles is located at the yellow loading curb on C Street, directly in front of Miller Hall on the west side of the street.

This is the **ONLY** location on campus where buses may stop. Buses are not permitted to enter University parking lots or park on city streets.

The physical address for bus staging is:

To Enter: C Street is a ONE-WAY STREET south of Third Street and may only be entered by turning south onto C Street from Bonita Avenue.

To Exit: Buses will proceed south on C Street until it ends at Second Street, then proceed east on Second Street.

Buses may not park and wait on campus longer than 1/2 hour before their departure time. It is the bus company's responsibility to locate off-campus parking.

Team Camps

Team Camps are welcome to be set up anywhere outside the stadium fencing or in the grandstands

Athlete Check-in

Runners must check in with the Clerk Tent (located adjacent to the finish line tent) at least 15 minutes before their heat.

Warm-ups

All warm-ups will take place on the main field (Ortmayer Stadium). NO TEAM Camps will be allowed on the infield.

Designated Entrances

All student-athletes and coaches can enter the facility through the side gate at the northwest end of the stadium prior. After the competition starts, the only entrance to the stadium will be through

this entrance. Entry to the track / infield during the competition will be limited to the gate nearest the entry gate (near the 100m starting line).

Spectator Entrance Fees

- Tickets can purchased at the gate for \$10 each.
- Children under 18 are free of charge.

Restrooms

Restrooms for participants and spectators are available in the adjacent Maineiro (brick) Building outside the stadium gates. Additional restrooms will be available inside the Sports Science & Athletics Pavilion throughout the first and second floors of the facility. The largest restroom is on the 2nd floor near the "A" door entrance
