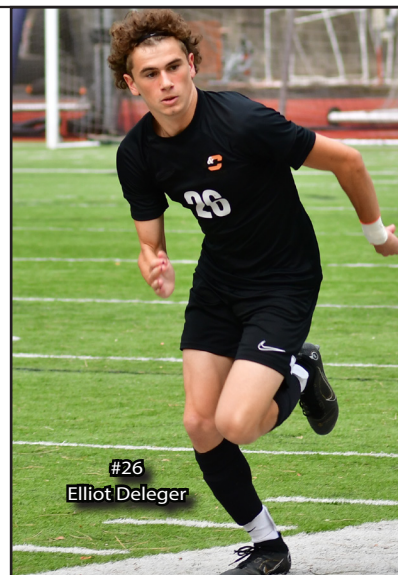

As a player, Tursi set the Pilots program record for goals and assists in a career and points and goals scored in a single-season.
