




HEAD COACH: JIMTURSI

He is in his 12th season as the head coach of the L&C women's soccer program and coached the men's and women's teams at fellow Northwest Conference school Willamette University from 1993-2007. While at Willamette, he led two Bearcats squads to the Final Four. He started his career at his alma mater, Portland University, where he was named the Conference Coach of the Year two times in three seasons. As a player, Tursi set the Pilots program record for goals and assists in a career and points and goals scored in a single-season.
