Last Game

After forcing a second championship game in the Northwest Conference Tournament, Lewis & Clark jumped our to a 7-0 lead against the #1 seeded Pacific University. Brennen Davis (3), Luke Bass (3), Will Heron (2), and Jack Thomson (2) all had multiple RBI to lead the team to their first NWC Tournament Championship, first NCAA tournament qualificaion, and first national tournament appearance in over 30 years. The Pioneers won their 30th game of the year 10-7 over the Boxers.

Lewis & Clark Notes

- The Pioneers are playing Birmingham-Southern College for the first time in program history.
- Lewis & Clark comes into regionals winning nine of their last ten games. Their lone loss was a 9-3 loss in the second round of the NWC Tournament.
- Head Coach Matt Kosderka was honored with his first NWC Coach of the Year. Kosderka is the first coach in NWC history to win the Coach of the Year and NWC Player of the Year awards. He won Player of the Year when he played for Willamette University in 1995.
- Thomson is the first Pioneer to win the NWC Player of the Year award twice in their career and only the second player in NWC history to win the award twice.
- Lewis & Clark had the most All-NWC selections since joining the NCAA with seven honrees. Thomson, Davis, and Jakob Ghammachi earned First Team honors. Bass, Heron, and Luke Ritter were selecited to the Second Team and relief pitcher Anthony Clerici was named to the Honorable Mention team.
- Thomson currently is fourth in program history with 191 hits, he needs three hits to tie the program record and four to earn his sixth career program record.
