Because service is spotty on the lake, times will be recorded the old fashioned way with stopwatches and flags, and entered manually into a spreadsheet accessible to coaches to share with their teams and fans.

See below for trailer parking and boat staging designation. Keep in mind this space remains open to the public during racing. Though community members are encouraged to launch motorized boats at a boat launch across the lake, we do not have exclusive use of this parking lot or boat launch.

Vehicles transporting athletes or spectators will need to **purchase a \$7 parking pass** at the kiosk when entering the park.



Launching & Landing

Crews will be launching from the southernmost dock visible on this image. The pink line shows the path to keep clear. The dock can fit an 8+ on either side, or 2 4+s on each side as long as the first is walked all the way to the end. Crews may also decide to beach launch/land south of the staging area as long as they are directed by a coach. I will cover this more in the C&C meeting.

Course & Warmup:

The course is indicated in yellow. There will be two buoy lines marked every 500m, with 4 lanes, similar to this past weekend at American Lake. Numbered 1 through 4 from west to east.

To warm up, crews will cross the course to the East-Northeast side of the lake and proceed along the shoreline to the start line.



Spectating:

There is a lot of space to spectate along the shore near the boat staging area. Spectators should plan to bring binoculars to get a better view of the finish line.
