

Lee University President : Dr. Phil Cook



Dr. Phil Cook began his term as the eighteenth president of Lee University on July 1, 2025. Cook brings over 30 years of experience in higher education, most recently serving as President and CEO of the North American Coalition for Christian Admissions Professionals (NACCAP) beginning in 2021.

Of his experience in higher education, the lion's share is with a specific focus on enrollment management, as NACCAP is an association for enrollment professionals, and his prior experience was in service at Lee University in the enrollment sector. From 1997 to 2021 he held every administrative position in the unit from Assistant Director of Admissions to Vice President for Enrollment Management. He led the enrollment team during an extended period of consistent, dramatic growth that revolutionized the university's profile on the landscape of Christian higher education.

During his long stint as a Lee employee, Cook also gained a familiarity with other aspects of university life, as he served as a resident director and as Director of Student Events and also found time to serve as a sponsor of the men's social service club Alpha Gamma Chi, as an instructor in both the School of Religion and the Office of First Year programs, as moderator of Dixon Center chapel services, and even as the public address announcer for Lee University home basketball games. This track record not only speaks of a significant long-term commitment to Lee University, but also an investment into the day-to-day lives of its students.

Cook holds a PhD in higher education administration from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, a Master of Divinity from the Church of God School of Theology, and a Bachelor of Science in Business from Lee.

An ordained bishop in the Church of God, he is married to Tonya Cook, and they have three children and two grandchildren.

Lee University Chancellor : Dr. Charles Paul Conn



Charles Paul Conn remains as chancellor of Lee University after serving as president and chancellor for the past year. Conn served that institution as president for thirty-four years, becoming president in 1986, after fifteen years as a member of the psychology faculty at the same institution. During his administration, the university saw significant growth: enrollment increased from 1000 to over 5000, the physical campus was enlarged substantially, and the school's reputation as a regional leader was firmly established.

EDUCATION: Conn earned the Ph.D. degree in psychology from Emory University in 1974. Subsequently, he has spent three years at Harvard University as a postdoctoral student, studying with Lawrence Kohlberg (1978), David Breneman (1993), Derek Bok (1998), Suarez Orozco (2003), Robert Kegan (2008), and Rick Weissbourd and Nancy Hill (2018). He was a Visiting Scholar at Harvard Divinity School in 1982 and 2023. He did his undergraduate work at Lee College and Georgia State University, and earned a M.A. degree at Emory.

LEADERSHIP: He has served on the Board of Directors of numerous higher ed organizations, including the Council of Independent Colleges, and chairman of the President's Council of the Southern States Athletic Conference. He served six years as a Commissioner of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, including two years on the Executive Committee of the Commission on Colleges. He has served on the Executive Committee of the Appalachian Colleges Association, on the board of the Tennessee Independent Colleges and Universities Association, and on the national board of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities. Conn served nine years (2015-2024) on the Board of Commissioners for the Chattanooga Airport Authority.

PERSONAL: Conn is married to Darlia McLuhan; together they have three children and ten grandchildren.

Athletic Director : John Maupin

John Maupin is in his third year as the Lee University Athletic Director. He was named as the Athletic Director in June of 2023 after an outstanding coaching career as the Director of Golf with Lee, including winning the first NCAA D2 National Championship in school history in 2022.

In his first two seasons as the Athletic Director, Maupin saw the Flames and Lady Flames win an unprecedented fourth and fifth straight GSC All Sports Trophy. The Lee 2024-25 athletic teams ranked 28th out of over 300 NCAA DII schools in the final Learfield Director's Cup Standings.

Maupin came to Lee in 2008 as the men's golf coach after a decorated playing career with Berry College from 2003-2007. He served as a team captain and was named to the Dean's List in 2007. Maupin was selected to multiple All-Conference and All-Region teams and guided the Vikings to three National Tournament appearances.

As a coach, Maupin led his Flames and Lady Flames to a dominating run of success over his 15 years as head coach. After several conference titles and national tournament appearances in the NAIA, Maupin's teams continued their run of excellence in the NCAA and the Gulf South Conference. The Lady Flames won three GSC titles and made two National Championship appearances while the Flames capped off an amazing 2022 postseason run by winning the NCAA DII National Championship, the first team title in any sport for Lee since joining the NCAA. The Flames won the South Region title in 2021 and are the only program to make three straight appearances in NCAA National Championship Match Play, after a quarterfinal berth this past season.

John and his wife Jayne have three children Addie, Jackson, and Annie. Jayne was a successful collegiate golfer at Berry College. She is currently an Instructional Coach at Ocoee Middle School.



MEN'S HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON

Coach Spence begins his third year as head coach. He replaced John Maupin who moved into Lee's athletic director's position. The former Flame golfer served as a volunteer assistant for one season before becoming a fulltime Lee assistant coach under Maupin.

He was born and raised in Chattanooga and played high school golf at McCallie School. Already a seasoned athlete, Spence joined the Lee golf team in the fall of 2016. During his playing career he was runner-up at the 2019 (Tennessee Tech) Bobby Nicholls Intercollegiate with scores of 69-69-68; had two top 5 (3rd and 4th) finishes at the Gulf South Conference Championship in 2019 and 2021; qualified for the 2019 NCAA South/Southeast Regional Championship as an individual; was a two-time GSC All-Conference team selection, and a three-time NCAA Academic All-American.

The 2004-05 season saw the Flames win the Mizuno Intercollegiate and the Barry University Invitational. The Flames finished second in the GSC Championship, fifth in the South/Southeast Regional and advanced to the NCAA DII National Championship where they placed 12th out of 20 teams.

In his first season as head coach (2023 fall and 2024 spring seasons) his team had second place finishes in the Hurricane Invitation, placed first in West Florida's Copperhead Championship and Tennessee Tech's Bobby Nichols Intercollegiate, earned a spot in the NCAA South/Southeast Regional, and moved on to place 11th in the NCAA National Championship.

Spence married fellow Lee All-American golfer Haverly Harrold in the summer of 2020 after both had received undergraduate degrees. His undergraduate is in Business Administration - Marketing Management (graduated Summa Cum Laude) and he also has an MBA from Lee.

Coach Almeida begins her fourth year of leading the Lady Flames. In the 2021-22 season the former Lee All-American served as an assistant under Coach John Maupin who also was Lee's Director of Golf. She was promoted to Head Women's Golf Coach at the beginning of the 2022-23 season.

Geandra is also a full-time mother. She and her husband Steve have two children, Nikki 9, and Benji 7.

The Lady Flames opened the 2024 fall season at the Savannah Lakes Invitational and took the team title while Banthita "Pearl" Phoncharatkun claimed the individual title in a playoff. It was the lowest-ever score for Phoncharatkun, a 4-under 212 (69-74-69). Lee set a school record at the LeeAnn Noble Memorial Invitational hosted by the University of North Georgia an 871 (286-304-284).

The 2025 official spring season saw the Lady Flames battle the wind, dust, and place third in the Gulf South Conference Tournament. Led by the final round play of Hannah Nall Lee finished seventh in the NCAA DII South Regional Tournament. Hannah Nall was named the GSC Golfer of the Year. Also, for the first time in program history, Lehane Louis-Dumond walked away with GSC Freshman of the Year honors. The Lady Flames had four of the six golfers on the First-Team All-GSC as well. Nall, Louis Dumond, Banthita "Pearl" Phoncharatkun, and Haley Blevins were each named to the First

Team. For Nall it is the third time she has been named to the First Team. She is the 12th golfer in conference history that has achieved that honor and only the fifth of that group to be on the first team three times. Nall and Phoncharatkun were named Honorable Mention All-Americans.

The 2023-24 campaign was highlighted by the return to the National Tournament after the 2022-23 club failed to qualify. The Lady Flames were runner up in six of 11 invitational events before placing fourth against talented opponents in the DII South/Southeast Regional.

Over those past two years the Lee coach, who the GSC named as Co-Coach of the Year, helped direct the outstanding play of Supuschaya "Yui" Srichantamit. For the second consecutive year "Yui" was named First-Team All-American by Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA). Earlier she was selected First-Team All-South Region for a second time by the WGCA. "Yui" walked away with the Gulf South Conference Golfer of the Year honors again and claimed medalist honors in the GSC Tournament.

In her first season as head coach, Almeida led Lee to the Gulf South Conference Tournament Championship and was named the GSC Coach of the Year. All-American Srichantamit was joined on the All-GSC team by Hannah Nall, Carson McKie, and Emily Felix.

Almeida graduated from Bethel University (Mishawaka, Indiana) with a major in Business Administration and minor in Economics. She completed her Master of Business Administration (MBA) in May of 2020, also from Bethel.

Before coming to Lee University, she was the No. 1-ranked amateur in Brazil (2009). At Lee she was a NAIA All-American (2011-2012), Southern States Athletic Conference Newcomer of the Year (2011), and Southern States Athletic Conference All-Conference (2011, 2012).

At Bethel University (Mishawaka, Indiana) Almeida was an NAIA All-American (2013-2014), NAIA Scholar-Athlete (2013-2014), Crossroads League Female Athlete of the Year (2014), Crossroads League Women's Golf Player of the Year (2013-2014), Crossroads League All-Conference (2013-2014), and a member of the NAIA National Championship All-Tournament Team (2014).

She had head coaching experience and success at Bethel before returning to Lee as an assistant. Almeida coached the Pilots to the North Central Region Championship (2019, 2020), was named NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year (2019, 2020) and her 2020 team finished runner-up in the NCCAA National Championship. She coached a NAIA All-American (2021) and four NCCAA All-American (2019, 2020). She had a number of players earn NAIA, NCCAA Scholar-Athlete honors.
