

#### **OUR LEADERSHIP TEAM**

#### Lee University President: Dr. Phil Cook



Dr. Phil Cook began his term as the eighteenth president of Lee University on July 1, 2025. Cook brings over 30 years of experience in higher education, most recently serving as President and CEO of the North American Coalition for Christian Admissions Professionals (NACCAP) beginning in 2021.

Of his experience in higher education, the lion's share is with a specific focus on enrollment management, as NACCAP is an association for enrollment professionals, and his prior experience was in service at Lee University in the enrollment sector. From 1997 to 2021 he held every administrative position in the unit from Assistant Director of Admissions to Vice President for Enrollment Management. He led the enrollment team during an extended period of consistent, dramatic growth that revolutionized the university's profile on the landscape of Christian higher education.

During his long stint as a Lee employee, Cook also gained a familiarity with other aspects of university life, as he served as a resident director and as Director of Student Events and also found time to serve as a sponsor of the men's social service club Alpha Gamma Chi, as an instructor in both the School of Religion and the Office of First Year programs, as moderator of Dixon Center chapel services, and even as the public address announcer for Lee University home basketball games. This track record not only speaks of a significant long-term commitment to Lee University, but also an investment into the day-to-day lives of its students.

Cook holds a PhD in higher education administration from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, a Master of Divinity from the Church of God School of Theology, and a Bachelor of Science in Business from Lee.

An ordained bishop in the Church of God, he is married to Tonya Cook, and they have three children and two grandchildren.

#### Lee University Chancellor: Dr. Charles Paul Conn



Charles Paul Conn remains as chancellor of Lee University after serving as president and chancellor for the past year. Conn served that institution as president for thirty-four years, becoming president in 1986, after fifteen years as a member of the psychology faculty at the same institution. During his administration, the university saw significant growth: enrollment increased from 1000 to over 5000, the physical campus was enlarged substantially, and the school's reputation as a regional leader was firmly established.

EDUCATION: Conn earned the Ph.D. degree in psychology from Emory University in 1974. Subsequently, he has spent three years at Harvard University as a postdoctoral student, studying with Lawrence Kohlberg (1978), David Breneman (1993), Derek Bok (1998), Suarez Orozco (2003), Robert Kegan (2008), and Rick Weissbourd and Nancy Hill (2018). He was a Visiting Scholar at Harvard Divinity School in 1982 and 2023. He did his undergraduate work at Lee College and Georgia State University, and earned a M.A. degree at Emory.

**LEADERSHIP:** He has served on the Board of Directors of numerous higher ed organizations, including the Council of Independent Colleges, and chairman of the President's Council of the Southern States Athletic Conference. He served six years as a Commissioner of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, including two years on the Executive Committee of the Commission on Colleges. He has served on the Executive Committee of the Appalachian Colleges Association, on the board of the Tennessee Independent Colleges and Universities Association, and on the national board of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities. Conn served nine years (2015-2024) on the Board of Commissioners for the Chattanooga Airport Authority.

PERSONAL: Conn is married to Darlia McLuhan; together they have three children and ten grandchildren.

#### Athletic Director: John Maupin


John Maupin is in his third year as the Lee University Athletic Director. He was named as the Athletic Director in June of 2023 after an outstanding coaching career as the Director of Golf with Lee, including winning the first NCAA D2 National Championship in school history in 2022.

In his first two seasons as the Athletic Director, Maupin saw the Flames and Lady Flames win an unprecedented fourth and fifth straight GSC All Sports Trophy. The Lee 2024-25 athletic teams ranked 28th out of over 300 NCAA DII schools in the final Learfield Director's Cup Standings.

Maupin came to Lee in 2008 as the men's golf coach after a decorated playing career with Berry College from 2003-2007. He served as a team captain and was named to the Dean's List in 2007. Maupin was selected to multiple All-Conference and All-Region teams and guided the Vikings to three National Tournament appearances.

As a coach, Maupin led his Flames and Lady Flames to a dominating run of success over his 15 years as head coach. After several conference titles and national tournament appearances in the NAIA, Maupin's teams continued their run of excellence in the NCAA and the Gulf South Conference. The Lady Flames won three GSC titles and made two National Championship appearances while the Flames capped off an amazing 2022 postseason run by winning the NCAA DII National Championship, the first team title in any sport for Lee since joining the NCAA. The Flames won the South Region title in 2021 and are the only program to make three straight appearances in NCAA National Championship Match Play, after a quarterfinal berth this past season.

Coach Marty Rowe continues to build on his resume as not only the most successful coach in the history of Lee basketball, but one of the best in Tennessee women's college basketball overall as he returns for his 22<sup>nd</sup> year as head coach of the Lady Flames.

In addition to his coaching duties he now carries the role of Associate Athletic Director for Internal Operations. In this role he facilitates communication between faculty and staff, help engage student athletes into the life of the university and work across departments to ensure student-athlete success.

The veteran coach claimed his landmark 600th-win on Dec. 2, 2022 (66-59) over at West Alabama. His 26year overall career mark as head coach stands at 666-212. Rowe's teams have won 20-plus contests in 23 of his 26 seasons, including 20 with the Lady Flames.

Coach Rowe's success began at Brescia University (Owensboro, Ky.). In six years, he posted a 131-65 overall record. In 2004, his Lady Bearcats reached the Fab Four of the NAIA National Tournament before falling to the eventual national champion, Southern Nazarene University.

A native of Central City, Ky., Rowe is a 1988 graduate of Murray State University. He and his wife, Pam, reside in Cleveland. The couple has one daughter, Brittany, son-in-law Chris Gates and two grandchildren, Bryson, and Brooklyn.

Jan (Dodson) Spangler is in her 14th year as an assistant coach and seventh season as the team's associate head coach.

Spangler was a 2022-23 nominee for The Leadership Playbook Coach of the Year. The award seeks to honor coaches who maximize success, value growth, and make a positive impact on those they are entrusted to lead. The Leadership Playbook helps athletic departments and sports teams build stronger cultures by developing better teammates and more positive leaders.

As a player, Spangler scored 1396 points and pulled down 716 rebounds in leading the Lady Flames to four trips to the NAIA National Tournament. She was named a Second Team NAIA All-American in 2007-08 and an NAIA All-American Honorable Mention in 2006-07. Spangler was a three-time All-SSAC member and was named to the 2004-05 SSAC All-Freshman Team. She also excelled off the court by becoming a three-time NAIA Scholar-Athlete. She was inducted into the Lee Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013.

After five years as a player and two as a graduate assistant with Rowe, Spangler accepted the women's head coaching position at Walker Valley High School. Taking over the after the retirement of longtime coach David Tucker,

she directed the Lady Mustangs to a 23-1 record, claiming the District 5-AAA regular season championship, including a No. 3 ranking in the final Class AAA Associated Press poll.

Jan is married to former Lee University baseball player Patrick Spangler. The couple has two sons, Hudson, and Houston, and they reside in Cleveland.



Ryan "Bubba" Smith begins his 10<sup>th</sup> season as head coach of the Lee men's basketball program. Under his leadership the Flames have established themselves as one of the top teams in the rugged Gulf South Conference (GSC). Coach Smith reached the 100-win milestone at Lee when his Flames defeated Montevallo (73-57) on Nov. 11, 2022. On Jan. 5, 2023, his team helped him join a select group at 300 wins with a 72-56 decision over Christian Brothers. His overall record is now 344-251.

Smith, a graduate of Furman University, enjoyed a four-year basketball career with the Paladins. He was a four-year letterman and team captain during his junior and senior seasons.

His first head coaching opportunity came at Hampden-Sydney (Va.), a nationally recognized program and a member of the ODAC (Old Dominion Athletic Conference). After serving as an assistant for three years, he was named head coach in 2003 and remained in that position for five years. He became the first rookie coach to direct a D3 program to a No. 1 ranking.

Smith's overall record at Hampden-Sydney was 93-45, including two ODAC Championships and two NCAA national tournament appearances.

The Hendersonville, Tenn., native moved closer to home in 2008 and took over a Sewanee basketball program that had struggled for years. Built on defense and rebounding, his 2011-12 squad was 11-2 at home, the school's best home mark since 1998.

Smith was twice named the SAA (Southern Athletic Association) coach of the year. The Tigers recorded five straight winning seasons and in 2015-16 went 20-8 becoming only the fourth 20-win mark registered in Sewanee basketball history.

Smith resides in Cleveland with his wife Cortney and their four children: Isaac, Mary Brittain, Emma, and Izzy.

Micka Stout enters his first year as the top assistant under head coach Bubba Smith. Stout brings an impressive resume having served as an assistant under Coach Dwaine Osborne at The University of Charleston (West Virginia) from January 2019-May 2024 and was an assistant on the University of Texas Permian Basin staff from June 2024 until March 2025. He graduated with honors and a double major in Sports Business Administration & Biblical Studies from Calvary University (Kansas City, Mo.).

"We are excited to welcome Micka to Lee and our men's basketball program," said coach Smith "When hiring staff, you lean heavily on the people you know and trust. Micka comes highly recommended from his time under Coach Osborne at The University of Charleston.

"Micka aligns with our mission and vision of developing young men through the game of basketball. His passion for building meaningful relationships and helping young men reach their full potential though their sport is evident. Micka brings us invaluable experience after being a part of Osborne's staff."

During his five years with the Golden Eagles, the team was in the top seven in the nation in offensive field goal percentage across all three NCAA divisions,

including being first in the nation across all divisions during the 2023-24 season. The club finished first in conference all five years in team defense as well. Stout also oversaw the development of the post players, developing two top ten scorers in Charleston's history, a conference player of the year, a conference freshman of the year, and several all-conference selections.

Coach Smith noted, "Micka will oversee our recruiting efforts, our post and forwards development and have a hand in every facet of the program. We are excited that he chose Lee Men's Basketball!"

"Words cannot fully express how excited and grateful I am to join coach Smith's staff here at Lee. In the coaching industry, opportunities to work for coaches, but more importantly people of coach Smith's caliber are rare and hard to come by," stressed the new assistant. "To have the chance to join him, assistant coach (Alex) Kelehear, and this fantastic group of players has me fired up to show up every day and give everything I have to help fulfill coach Smith's vision for this program!"





#### PAUL DANA WALKER ARENA





Paul Dana Walker Arena is home to the men's and women's basketball teams and the volleyball team and has seating for up to 2,000 fans.

The first game in the arena was played on November 3, 1983 and over the years the facility has been the site of many thrilling basketball and volleyball contests.

In 2005, Lee completed a project to upgrade the facilities at Walker Arena and an additional 500 seats were added to the arena's north elevation in the form of a new mezzanine level. Additionally, the lobby was tripled in size to accommodate the growing number of students and fans attending athletic events.

In 2017, 700-plus chair-back seats were added to the lower boxes on each sideline. In the summer of 2023, a brand new hardwood floor was laid down. Two new video boards and LED lights were installed prior to the 2024-25 school year.

Walker Arena was constructed in memory of former Lee basketball player, Paul Dana Walker As he returned home from a Lee College Homecoming game on November 19, 1980, Paul and his wife were involved in a fatal automobile accident. Paul Dana Walker was killed instantly and his wife, Julie, suffered multiple injuries but survived the horrible collision.




