- ► LAST TIME OUT: Noah Boler-Kyle tallied a career-high 32 points, with the help of two 3-pointers, and 12-12 shooting in the second half to lead the Flames to an 86-73 win over West Florida. JJ Barnes added 12 points, eight assists, and seven rebounds. Willie Walton had a career best 11 points and Beyuan Hendricks had eight points.
- **◆ TEAM STATS:** The Flames are leading the GSC with 92.8 ppg and a scoring margin of +31.5. Lee is also leading the GSC with 45.8 rebounds and 23.0 assists per game.
- UP NEXT: Lee returns to Walker Arena for two straight against UAH and West Alabama on Dec. 8 and 10.


