## **Driving Directions & Visiting Team Parking**

### **Larry Carpenter Stadium at Olympic Field - Baseball**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the eighth red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Olympic Field is approximately an eighth of a mile on your right.

From Chattanooga:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn left onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Olympic Field is approximately an eighth of a mile on your right.

Visiting Team Parking:

Parking is limited at Olympic Field due to a Middle School being located on the property.

The Middle School is still in session and the school zone is active between 3 p.m. and 4 p.m.

### **Paul Dana Walker Arena - Volleyball, Men's & Women's Basketball**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the eighth red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Proceed through one traffic light (20<sup>th</sup> Street).

Paul Dana Walker Arena is on your right shortly after the street divides.

From Chattanooga:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn left onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Proceed through one traffic light (20<sup>th</sup> Street).

Paul Dana Walker Arena is on your right shortly after the street divides.

### **Ray Conn Sports Complex – Men's and Women's Soccer, Lacrosse, Men's and Women's Track & Field**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the eighth red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. The complex is approximately an eighth of a mile on your left.

From Chattanooga:

Visiting Team Parking:

There is a 110-car parking lot next to the complex.

### **Men's & Women's Tennis (DeVos Tennis Center)**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Proceed through one traffic light (20<sup>th</sup> Street).

Turn right onto Billy Graham Avenue (right before the street splits). The courts are on your left.

From Chattanooga:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn left onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. Proceed through one traffic light (20<sup>th</sup> Street)

Turn right onto Billy Graham Avenue (right before the street splits). The courts are on your left.

Visiting Team Parking:

There is parking available next to the tennis courts off Billy Graham Avenue for vans.

### **Butler Field – Softball**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street). Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS). Turn right onto Parker Street. Turn right onto 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The field is on your left.

From Chattanooga:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn left onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street). Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS). Turn right onto Parker Street. Turn right onto 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The field is on your left.

Visiting Team Parking:

There is parking available across from the field at Schimmel's Park on Parker Street.

### **Lee Soccer Field – Alternate Men's & Women's Soccer**

From Knoxville:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn right onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the eighth red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. The Lee Soccer Field is approximately 2 ½ miles on your left.

From Chattanooga:

Take exit 25 off I-75. Turn left onto a four-lane road (25<sup>th</sup> Street).

Go straight until you get to the seventh red light (one light after Walgreens and CVS).

Turn right onto Parker Street. The Lee Soccer Field is approximately 2 ½ miles on your left.

Visiting Team Parking:

Buses can park along Walker Street (East end of field).

## **Game Filming**

Visiting teams should restrict game recording to the following designated areas

Walker Arena – In the camera bay at the top of the bleachers opposite the benches and scorer's table.

Ray Conn Sports Complex – behind the benches on the track

Butler Field – directly behind home plate or anywhere behind the outfield wall

Larry Carpenter Stadium – Camera Bays located at the end of the seating area

DeVos Tennis Center – Recording is permitted throughout the Tennis Center but is not permitted on the playing the surface. When filming please be respectful and mindful of spectators' sight lines.

## **Prohibited Behavior**

Examples of prohibited behavior include, but are not limited to: throwing objects of any kind; demonstrating unruly behavior; attempting to enter the field of play; engaging in behavior that endangers the safety of student-athletes, coaches, officials, or other guests; taunting event staff, visiting teams and/or public safety officials.
