

LEHIGH VS LAFAYETTE | A-Z GUIDE



Alcohol Policy: Alcoholic beverages of any kind are not permitted in Goodman Stadium. Consumption of alcohol in plastic containers is allowed within the tailgating lots. Glass containers are not permitted.

ATM : There is an ATM machine located in the southeast corner of Goodman Stadium, just inside the main entrance.

Bag Policy: Patrons are encouraged to limit the number of items they bring into Goodman Stadium. All bags are subject to search prior to entering Goodman Stadium. Bags larger than 12" x 12" x 10" are not permitted with the exception of child care bags. Food and beverages are not permitted to be brought into the Stadium

Concessions: Food and beverages can be found located on the East and West sides of Goodman Stadium.

Disability Services: Wheelchair seating is available in sections WB, WI, EB, and EI.

First Aid: An ambulance unit and EMS personnel are scheduled at all public events in Goodman Stadium. For Lehigh Football games the unit will be parked at the southwest corner of Goodman Stadium.

Game Day Programs: Programs for the 155th meeting of Lehigh vs. Lafayette can be purchased on either side of the stadium at the program booths for \$5.00.

Gear: Lehigh Athletics apparel can be purchased at the Lehigh Bookstore tent located on the West Side of Goodman Stadium

Grass Bank Seating: Currently, the Grass Bank will remain closed for this game.

Lost and Found: Items that were lost in the stadium can be picked up at the Fan Services tent near the front gates of Goodman Stadium.

Mobile Tickets: Due to heavy wireless and cellular data usage, we recommend that you screenshot your mobile tickets in case WiFi or cellular data drops. All mobile tickets are optimized to be scanned on your phone. Please have your QR codes pulled up on your phone prior to arriving at the main gates.

Parking: Parking lots can be accessed at 9:30 on game day. Parking Passes are required in the reserved lots located by Stabler Arena. Fans who did not purchased Reserved Lot passes will be directed to the General Admission lots the morning of the game. ADA Parking is located just south of Stabler Arena, and there are ADA accessible shuttle buses running between the parking lot and Goodman Stadium. Due to heavy traffic, please plan to arrive early.

Prohibited Items: The following items will not be permitted in Goodman Stadium: Air Horns (and other noise makers), Alcohol, Animals (except service animals), beverage containers, coolers, drones, electronic cigarettes, tobacco, firearms or weapons of any kind, fireworks, food and beverage (with the exception of child care), laser pointers,

Radio: Fans can tune into Fox Sports 1230/1320 AM and 94.7 FM to support the Lehigh Mountain Hawks!

Re-Entry: Re-entry will not be permitted on game day.

Restrooms: Restrooms are located underneath the stands on both sides of Goodman Stadium.

Seating: All seating for the 155th meeting of Lehigh versus Lafayette is reserved. Guests are required to sit in the seats that were assigned on the date of purchase of the ticket.

Shuttle Services: Buses to and from the parking lots will run on a continuous loop to accompany any guests that may require a shuttle.

Smoking: Smoking is not permitted within Goodman Stadium.

Social Media: Stay connected throughout the game on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram.

Stadium Behavior: Lehigh University, along with the Patriot League and in compliance with the NCAA request good sportsmanship behavior from spectators, coaches and student athletes.

We ask that you join us, coaches, players, and officials in practicing good sportsmanship in supporting your team and in your conduct toward players, coaches, officials, and other spectators. Unruly and disrespectful behavior will not be condoned. Please note that the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the use of tobacco products also are prohibited. Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time. Our Events Management staff has the responsibility to enforce this policy, and may choose to eject fans that do not comply.

Tailgating: Tailgating lots will open at 9:30am. Tailgating is permitted only in areas where the flow of traffic is not obstructed and must comply with parking regulations. Please limit your tailgate to the area immediately behind your vehicle. Please do not set tables, chairs, or coolers in adjacent parking spaces. No tents or awnings may be erected in parking spaces or in such a manner as to impede the flow of traffic. Please dispose of any trash, containers, and food items in the appropriate trash or recycling containers which are provided throughout the grounds. Please properly dispose of charcoal when cooled in dumpsters or trash containers. No fire pits or similar items with open fires are permitted in the parking lots.

Tickets: Tickets can be purchased beforehand at LehighTickets.com or the day of the game at Ticket Services. All guests will be required to show their ticket prior to entry.

Television: Tune into local channel WFMZ or live stream on the Patriot League Network to watch your Lehigh Mountain Hawks.

Will Call: Tickets left at will call can be picked up at the ticket windows to the right of the main entrance. A valid ID will need to be shown at the time of pickup. Fans and guests may access Will Call at 11am.
