SETTING THE SCENE

The 142nd season of Lehigh football begins with a Top 25 Patriot League showdown at Goodman Stadium as the No. 14/15 Mountain Hawks host Patriot League newcomer No. 25/22 Richmond on Kickoff Weekend presented by JFR Salvage. Lehigh posted the second-largest turnaround in FCS football in 2024, going from 2-9 to 9-4 and capturing the program's league-best 13th Patriot League championship. The Mountain Hawks then went on the road and defeated Richmond 20-16 in the opening round of the FCS Playoffs for their first postseason win since 2011. The Spiders were 10-3 a season ago and will make their debut as an associate member of the Patriot League in football. Lehigh returns eight of its 10 All-Patriot League selections from a season ago and many key contributors from last year's championship squad.

KEY STATS

- Lehigh ranked 12th in the nation in rushing offense last year (201.8 ypg.) and returns its top seven rushers.
- Last year the Mountain Hawks ranked in the top 20 in the FCS in pass defense (174.5 ypg.), total defense (303.8 ypg.) and sacks (2.62 pg.)
- Lehigh's roster features 13 first-years, 39 sophomores, 22 juniors, 17 seniors and one fifth-year.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH KEVIN CAHILL

Kevin Cahill is in his third season as Lehigh's head coach. The 2024 Patriot League Coach of the Year, Cahill engineered one of the biggest single-season turnarounds in Division I football, leading the Mountain Hawks to their 13th Patriot League title. He has mentored 13 All-Patriot League performers and a pair of All-Americans in his first two seasons. A coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience, Cahill came to Lehigh following 10 seasons at Yale University, where he was a member of the coaching staff for three Ivy League championship teams and oversaw one of the nation's top offensive units. From 2018-2022 Cahill served as the Bulldogs' Associate Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator. Cahill is a 2001 graduate of Springfield College, where he was a three-year starter at quarterback.

RICHMOND HEAD COACH RUSS HUESMAN

Russ Huesman is in his ninth season as Richmond's head coach. This is his second stint with the Spiders as he was an assistant coach from 2004-08 including Richmond's 2008 National Championship team. In his 40-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 53 All-Americans and 23 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of 11 conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. Prior to his return to Richmond, Huesman won three SoCon Coach of the Year awards in eight seasons at Chattanooga. Huesman is a 1983 graduate of Chattanooga.

THE SERIES

Lehigh and Richmond meet for the fifth time with the series tied 2-2. Lehigh's two victories have come in the two NCAA playoff games, while Richmond has won the two regular season meetings.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

RICHMOND, Va. (11/30/24) - Trailing 16-7 with 10:36 remaining, Lehigh's offense put up a pair of big plays, while the defense finished the job as the Mountain Hawks defeated No. 9 Richmond 20-16 in the first round of the FCS playoffs at Robins Stadium. First-year quarterback Hayden Johnson connected with junior Geoffrey Jamiel on a 54-yard catch-and-run that gave Lehigh a 20-16 lead with 6:21 to play. Jamiel had a career day with 10 catches for 137 yards and the go-ahead score. Johnson completed 14-of-18 for 199 yards, with two touchdowns and an interception. Lehigh's defense limited Richmond to one touchdown in four red zone trips and held the Spiders to 1-of-3 on fourth down conversions. First-year Jaden Green answered Richmond's lone touchdown with a 65-yard scoring run to bring Lehigh within 16-14 prior to the Johnson-to-Jamiel connection. The win was Lehigh's first in the FCS playoffs since 2011 and sent the Mountain Hawks to Idaho for a second round contest.

LID LIFTERS

Lehigh has an 84-51-6 all-time record in its season-opening contests. The Mountain Hawks are 2-8 in their last 10 openers and are looking to snap a six-game opening-day losing streak. Lehigh's last opening day win came against Saint Francis in 2018. Lehigh has never opened its season against Richmond.

WELCOME TO THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

Richmond is playing its first game as an associate member of the Patriot League in the sport of football, with 2025 marking the first time since 2001 that the Patriot League added a new member in football. Georgetown made its Patriot League debut in 2001, with Lehigh serving as the opponent for its first game. The Mountain Hawks claimed a 41-14 win over the Hoyas in the season-opener for both teams in Washington, D.C. on the way to an 11-1 championship campaign.

LEADING OFF WITH A LEAGUE GAME

In a scheduling rarity, Lehigh is opening its season with a Patriot League contest. The Mountain Hawks only played league games in the abbreviated three-game Spring 2021 season. Prior to that, the last time Lehigh opened its season against a Patriot League opponent was 2003, when the Mountain Hawks defeated Holy Cross 38-20 at Goodman Stadium. That year, Lehigh opened with back-to-back home league games, with the Mountain Hawks beating Fordham in week two. Lehigh opened with a league game 12 times from the formation of the Patriot League in 1986 through 2001, with Fordham (8 games) serving as the most popular league opponent.

TURN-TURN-TURN IT AROUND

Lehigh's 9-4 record in 2024 marked a seven-win improvement over its 2-9 campaign in 2023, with the Mountain Hawks owning the second-biggest turnaround in FCS football. Only Stony Brook (0-10 to 8-4) had a bigger win improvement than the Mountain Hawks last season at the FCS level.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

A defense that statistically ranked among the nation's best keyed Lehigh's six-game late-season winning streak and run to the second round of the FCS playoffs. From its Oct. 26 win over Fordham through its Nov. 30 playoff win at Richmond, Lehigh allowed just 281.8 yards and 13.2 points per game. The Mountain Hawks finished the 2024 season ranked 11th nationally in total defense (303.8 ypg.) and 16th in pass defense (174.5 ypg.). Lehigh also led the Patriot League in sacks (34) and interceptions (14) with the Mountain Hawks ranking 19th nationally with 2.62 sacks per game.

THEY SHALL NOT PASS

Pass defense was an area of strength for Lehigh in 2024. The Mountain Hawks led the Patriot League and ranked 16th nationally allowing 174.5 passing yards per game. Take out Lehigh's opener against run-heavy Army and the Mountain Hawks allowed just 184.3 passing yards per game, after allowing an average of 243.8 passing yards per game in 2023. Lehigh also had a Patriot League-best 14 interceptions, led by Nick Peltekian with four.

WELCOME BACK

Lehigh had 10 All-Patriot League selections following the 2024 season with eight of the 10 back in the fold for 2025. Senior safety Nick Peltekian is a two-time all-league honoree. Other returning first team All-Patriot League performers include senior offensive lineman Langston Jones and senior defensive linemen TJ Burke and Matt Spatny. All four of Lehigh's second team All-Patriot League performers in 2024: senior offensive lineman Aidan Palmer, senior wide receiver Geoffrey Jamiel, junior running back Luke Yoder and sophomore running back Jaden Green, are back in 2025. Jones, Burke, Spatny, Peltekian, Palmer and Yoder were named to the Preseason All-Patriot League team along with senior linebacker Brycen Edwards.

FROM COAST TO COAST

The Lehigh coaching staff prides itself in bringing in student-athletes from across the nation. This season, 18 states are represented on the Mountain Hawks roster, including California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Texas and Virginia. Twenty-eight Mountain Hawks hail from Pennsylvania while 14 are from New Jersey.

PENNSYLVANIA PROUD

The Mountain Hawks' roster features 28 student-athletes from the state of Pennsylvania. In recent years, Lehigh has had a handful of Lehigh Valley products on its roster. The Mountain Hawks' 2025 roster includes eight players who played their high school football in the East Penn Conference or the Colonial League. Senior kicker Nick Garrido is from Easton and attended Notre Dame Green Pond. Lehigh has two local junior defensive linemen in Broc Bender (Nazareth) and Andrew Sharga (Northampton). The sophomore class includes four local products: offensive lineman Sammy Ayache (Bethlehem Catholic), safety Nolan Coen (Parkland), quarterback Matt Machalik (Palmerton) and offensive lineman Colby Reph (Northampton). Junior tight end Jake Stalsitz grew up on Center Valley and attended Southern Lehigh before ultimately graduating from Fairview near Erie, Pa.

LAST TIME OUT

LEHIGH AT No. 8 IDAHO

MOSCOW, Idaho (12/7/24) – Lehigh's run through the FCS playoffs came to an end with a 34-13 loss to No. 8 Idaho at the PIFCU Kibbie Dome. The Vandals' passing attack posted 318 yards against Lehigh's top 10-ranked pass defense to advance to the quarterfinals against No. 1 seed Montana State.

The Mountain Hawks fell behind 12-0 in the second quarter and trailed 19-6 at halftime and didn't reach the end zone until the game's final minutes.

Lehigh racked up 371 yards of its own but struggled to have its drives end in touchdowns. The Mountain Hawks converted just 5-of-15 third downs and were 0-for-3 on fourth downs, while Idaho (10-3) was 7-for-12 on third downs and converted its only fourth down attempt.

Sophomores Luke Yoder and Mason Humphrey paced Lehigh offensively, with Yoder gaining 74 yards on 11 carries to eclipse the 1,000-yard mark for the season. Humphrey was targeted 14 times in the passing game and had six receptions for 98 yards.

In the first half, Idaho got a pair of touchdown passes from Jack Lane to Jordan Dwyer and a third to Mark Hamper, with Lehigh answering with two Nick Garrido field goals in the first 30 minutes.

Idaho scored on its first drive of the third quarter and then got a 74-yard interception return touchdown by Zach Johnson on fourth down on Lehigh's first drive of the second half.

Graduate student Dante Perri scored Lehigh's lone touchdown with a one-yard run in the final minute.

Hayden Johnson completed 13-of-27 for 143 yards and an interception and also ran for 69 yards on 12 carries. Perri was 4-for-4 for 59 yards and rushed twice for five yards.

Defensively, sophomore William Parton led the way with nine tackles, including a tackle-for-loss. Junior Brycen Edwards added eight tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss. Junior TJ Burke had Lehigh's lone sack.

STANDOUT SPATNY

Defensive lineman Matt Spatny was a standout on one of the nation's top defensive units in 2024. Spatny made 36 tackles from his defensive end position and contributed a Patriot League-leading 11.5 sacks, ranking third in the FCS in sacks per game and fifth in overall sacks. Along with center George Padezanin, Spatny was named an honorable mention Associated Press All-American last season, the first All-Americans for Lehigh since 2019. Spatny's 2024 season included five multi-sack games, including a seven-tackle, 2.5-sack effort in a win over Princeton. Over the summer, Spatny was named a first team Preseason All-American by Stats Perform and was voted the Patriot League's Preseason Defensive Player of the Year by the league's coaches and SIDs.

YODER CARRIES THE LOAD

Junior running back Luke Yoder was the senior member of a devastating 1-2 punch in the backfield for the Mountain Hawks in 2024. Yoder rushed for 1,014 yards and 10 touchdowns last season, averaging 5.3 yards per carry. A second team All-Patriot League honoree, Yoder was Lehigh's first 1,000-yard rusher since Dom Bragalone in 2017. Yoder scored at least one touchdown in each of Lehigh's first six games last season and had a pair of 100-yard rushing games, giving him five for his career. He rushed for a season-best 137 yards and scored a career-high three touchdowns against Bucknell last September.

GREEN IS MONEY

Running back Jaden Green enjoyed an outstanding first-year season that culminated in the San Francisco native earning second team All-Patriot League honors while being named a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award. Green was a two-time Patriot League Rookie of the Week, rushing for 82 yards and two touchdowns against Princeton, and a career-high 147 yards in the win over Fordham. He also eclipsed the 100-yard mark against Colgate and scored a touchdown in six of Lehigh's last eight games in 2024, finishing with 10. At Richmond, Green's 65-yard touchdown rush helped spur Lehigh's fourth-quarter comeback. For the season, Green rushed for 777 yards and averaged 5.4 yards per carry. He was also Lehigh's primary kickoff returner and averaged 25.1 yards on 22 returns, with a long of 49 yards against Wagner.

GROUND GAME IN GEAR

Lehigh has now eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in 20 straight games dating back to the 2023 season, with the Mountain Hawks having eclipsed 200 rushing yards in six of their last nine games in 2024. Lehigh's 310 rushing yards at Georgetown were its most since gaining 306 at Fordham in 2017. Prior to last season, the last time Lehigh rushed for 200 or more yards in four straight games was in 2015, when the Mountain Hawks eclipsed the 200-yard mark in their final four contests. Lehigh led the Patriot League in rushing and ranked 12th nationally, averaging 201.8 yards per game. Luke Yoder led the way with 1,014 yards on 193 carries, a 5.3 yard per carry average. Yoder had 10 rushing touchdowns and scored at least one in each of Lehigh's first six games. Behind Yoder, Lehigh's next four leading rushers were all first-years, with running backs Jaden Green and Aaron Crossley and quarterbacks Hayden Johnson and Matt Machalik combining for 1,503 yards and 18 rushing touchdowns while averaging 5.3 yards per rush.

STARTING BLOCK

Last year, Lehigh had 61 players on its roster that claimed either first or second-year eligibility. With many of those players gaining valuable experience, only two Mountain Hawks are projected to make their first career starts against Richmond. Based on Lehigh's depth chart (page 10), sophomore Charles Soska is expected to make his Lehigh debut at left tackle and sophomore Matt D'Avino is a projected starter at wide receiver. D'Avino had four receptions, including a touchdown over 12 games, while Soska did not see any game action in 2024.

HEY-HEY HAYDEN!

While he contributed in all 13 games in 2024, quarterback Hayden Johnson really turned things on late in the season. Johnson started Lehigh's final four games, including the playoff victory at Richmond. In his first career start, Johnson completed 16-of-21 passes for 204 yards with three touchdowns in a win against Colgate. He went on to complete 10-of-13 passes for 115 yards and a touchdown while rushing for 25 yards and a score to earn the Most Valuable Player award of Lehigh's 38-14 Patriot League title-clinching win over Lafayette in Rivalry 160. The Lancaster, Pa., native became the first first-year player to earn Rivalry game MVP honors since Lafayette's Drew Reed in 2013, and the first Lehigh player to accomplish the feat since Phil Stambaugh in 1996. Johnson completed 14-of-18 for 199 yards and two touchdowns in the playoff win against Richmond. For the season, Johnson completed 67 percent of his passes for 1372 yards and 10 touchdowns. He also rushed 70 times for 307 yards and four touchdowns in 2024.

GROWING UP FAST

The Mountain Hawks won the 2024 Patriot League title with a roster that included 36 first-years and 25 sophomores, many of who made valuable contributions to Lehigh's championship season. With Lehigh's roster now featuring more of a veteran presence, the Mountain Hawks have brought in just 15 newcomers for 2025, with 13 first-years and a pair of sophomore transfers. The only newcomers that appear on Lehigh's depth chart (page 10) are first-year long snapper Ridgely Ritter and sophomore transfer Giacomo Macce, who is listed as the backup right tackle. Twenty-three of Lehigh's 39 sophomores appeared in at least one game last season, with eight seeing time in all 13 games.

PROFESSIONAL PEDIGREES

Lehigh's roster features a quartet of student-athletes whose fathers played in the NFL. Senior offensive lineman Langston Jones' father Keith was a running back for the Atlanta Falcons from 1989-92. Junior running back Luke Yoder's father Todd played nine seasons as a tight end for Tampa Bay, Jacksonville and Washington, winning a Super Bowl with the Bucs in 2002. Junior safety Mason Moore's father Marty played eight seasons as a linebacker, seven of which came with the New England Patriots, and won a Super Bowl in 2001. First-year offensive lineman Jake Thomas' father Tra played 12 years and made three Pro Bowls playing primarily for the Philadelphia Eagles.

WORKING OVERTIME

The Mountain Hawks have played 14 overtime games since overtime rules were established prior to the 1995 season. Lehigh is 8-6 in overtime games, with its most recent overtime game being last September against Bucknell. Two of Lehigh's overtime games have been season openers. The Mountain Hawks lost at Fordham in 1997 and beat Central Connecticut State in double overtime at Goodman Stadium in 2013.

SETTING THE TONE EARLY

Lehigh benefitted from some outstanding first-half performances on the way to its 9-4 season in 2024. The Mountain Hawks outscored opponents 227-125 in first halves in 2024, including a 190-43 advantage in the first halves of their nine victories. Lehigh was especially tough in the second quarter, outscoring foes 161-68 in the second period last season. In Lehigh's nine wins, the Mountain Hawks outscored opponents 141-13 in the second quarter, with Holy Cross (seven) and Richmond (six) scoring the only opponent second-quarter points in a game won by the Mountain Hawks.

SACK ATTACK

One of Lehigh's defensive strengths in recent years has been its ability to get to opposing quarterbacks. After finishing second in the Patriot League in sacks the previous three seasons, Lehigh led the league with 34 sacks in 2024 and ranked 19th nationally averaging 2.62 sacks per game. The Mountain Hawks had six sacks in home wins over Princeton and Fordham and totaled 20 during their six-game late-season winning streak. Defensive lineman Matt Spatny had a team-best 11.5 last season, including 3.5 in Lehigh's last two regular season games. Nose tackle TJ Burke finished with seven. Both Spatny and Burke were named first team All-Patriot League. In all, Lehigh returns 28.5 of its 34 sacks from a season ago.

HOME IS WHERE THE SACKS WERE

Lehigh led the Patriot League lead with 34 sacks in 2024. Prior to the Georgetown game, all of Lehigh's sacks had come at Goodman Stadium. Lehigh has 27 sacks in six home games last year, with six against both Princeton and Fordham and five against Bucknell and Lafayette.

TURNOVERS TELL THE TALE

In Lehigh's 13 games last season, the statistics showed that when the Mountain Hawks took care of the football, they had success. In nine victories in 2024, Lehigh was plus-6 in turnover margin with 15 takeaways and nine giveaways. In four losses, the Mountain Hawks were minus-8 with just two takeaways and 10 turnovers.

GROWTH ON THE O-LINE

The growth of a young offensive line helped the Mountain Hawks find success in the second half of 2023, a trend that has continued through last season. Highlighted by a streak of four consecutive 200-yard games, Lehigh has eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in 20 consecutive games dating back to 2023. The Mountain Hawks have also allowed just 17 sacks in that 20-game span. Lehigh utilized the same five-man starting line in its first 10 games last year with two first-years rotating in regularly. Six of those seven linemen are back, led by All-Patriot League guards Langston Jones and Aidan Palmer, who moves inside from tackle. Sophomore Colby Reph moves from guard to center to replace All-American George Padezanin, while the newcomer to the projected starting lineup is sophomore Charles Soska, who could start at left tackle.

JAMIEL CATCHES ON

The elder statesman of Lehigh's wide receiver room, senior Geoffrey Jamiel has established himself as a leader on and off the field for the Mountain Hawks. Jamiel was Lehigh's top receiver in 2024, hauling in 60 receptions for 768 yards and eight touchdowns on the way to earning second team All-Patriot League honors. Jamiel had a huge day in the playoff win at Richmond, setting career highs with 10 catches for 137 yards, with his 54-yard touchdown catch in the fourth quarter giving the Mountain Hawks the lead for good. He had three 100-yard receiving games last season and had two-touchdown efforts against Bucknell and Colgate. Jamiel led Lehigh with 53 catches as a first-year in 2022 and was named Patriot League Rookie of the Year. He followed that up with 43 catches and a team high-tying four receiving touchdowns in 2023.

TURNING AROUND THE TURNOVER STORY

Lehigh has finished with a negative turnover margin in 10 of the last 11 seasons, a trend the Mountain Hawks look to reverse this fall. The Mountain Hawks were minus-10 in 2023 with 12 takeaways including just three interceptions. Lehigh corralled a Patriot League-leading 14 interceptions in 2024 but still finished the year with a minus-2 turnover margin. Lehigh matched its interception total from the 2023 season in the first half against Wagner. The Mountain Hawks had four takeaways and zero giveaways against Wagner and added three more interceptions against Princeton, for a strong start in the turnover department. Prior to the Wagner game, the last three-interception game for Lehigh was at Bucknell in 2021. The last four-takeaway game was also at Bucknell, in 2017. The last time Lehigh was plus-4 or better in turnover margin was in 2016 when the Mountain Hawks were plus-5 in a 46-14 win at Holy Cross.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

The 2024 season saw senior cornerback Jordan Adderley and sophomore defensive back DJ Brown earn Academic All-Patriot League honors, with Brown also landing on the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team. Among players on the 2025 roster, 43 Mountain Hawks own a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, with 25 over a 3.2 and nine over a 3.5. Senior defensive back CJ Wood leads the team with a 3.87 GPA in accounting, followed by sophomore running back Sam Spector, who holds a 3.85 and sophomore Matt D'Avino, who owns a 3.78. Spector and D'Avino are undeclared in Lehigh's College of Business and Economics.

SCOUTING RICHMOND

Champions of the CAA in 2024, Richmond makes its debut as an associate Patriot League member in football. The Spiders went 10-3 last season, including an 8-0 conference mark. Richmond opens the new season against a Lehigh team that ended its 2024 campaign in the playoffs at Robins Stadium. Five Spiders earned Preseason All-Patriot League honors: offensive linemen Gabriel Carbajal and Scott Hummel, tight end Sean Clarke, linebacker Carter Glassmeyer and defensive end Camden Byrd. Richmond was picked second in the Patriot League Preseason Poll. Senior Kyle Wickersham is expected to start at quarterback for Richmond.

TV/STREAMING VIDEO SCHEDULE

With the Patriot League entering year six of its digital rights agreement with ESPN and the Ivy League's continuing agreement with ESPN, 11 of Lehigh's 12 games are scheduled to be streamed on ESPN+. Lehigh's trip to Duquesne on Sept. 13 will be broadcast on NEC Front Row.

Senior defensive lineman Matt Spatny was voted the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-league team by seniors Langston Jones, Aidan Palmer, TJ Burke, Brycen Edwards, Nick Peltekian and junior Luke Yoder.

HEAD COACH KEVIN CAHILL



A fiery competitor who is widely regarded as a strong teacher and mentor, Kevin Cahill is in his third season as Lehigh's head coach. Cahill and his staff have worked tirelessly to build "The Nest" at Lehigh, an endeavor that paid off in

Lehigh's league-leading 13th Patriot League title in 2024.

The Mountain Hawks enjoyed the second-largest turnaround in FCS football in 2024, posting a 9-4 record, a nine-win improvement over Cahill's first season. Lehigh won its final five regular season games, clinching its 13th Patriot League title and the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. From there, Lehigh went on the road and defeated Richmond 20-16 for Lehigh's first playoff win since 2011.

Ten Mountain Hawks garnered All-Patriot League recognition, with Cahill selected as the Dick Biddle Patriot League Coach of the Year and a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award. Lehigh featured a top-15 rushing offense while the defensive unit ranked among the FCS leaders in pass defense and total defense.

Center George Padezanin and defensive lineman Matt Spatny earned All-America honors from the Associated Press, becoming Lehigh's first football All-Americans in five years.

In his first season as a head coach Cahill saw three of his players earn All-Patriot League recognition: defensive lineman Dean Colton, linebacker Mike DeNucci and safety Nick Peltekian. Cahill picked up his first victory as a head coach on Sept. 9, 2023 at Merrimack and his first Patriot League win Oct. 21 at Bucknell.

Cahill was named the 30th head coach in Lehigh football history on Dec. 19, 2022. A coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience, Cahill came to Lehigh following 10 seasons at Yale University, where he was a member of the coaching staff for three Ivy League championship teams and oversaw one of the nation's top offensive units.

From 2018-22 Cahill served as Yale's Associate Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator, working directly with the quarterbacks. In 2022, the

Bulldogs went 8-2 overall and 6-1 in Ivy League play to capture their third Ivy crown in the last five seasons. Yale boasted the top-ranked offense in the Ivy League and ranked in the top 25 in the FCS in total offense for the fourth time in the last five seasons.

Under Cahill's guidance, Yale quarterback Nolan Grooms thrived in his first full season as a starter. Grooms threw for 1,660 yards and 14 touchdowns and added 745 yards and six touchdowns on the ground on the way to winning the Asa S. Bushnell Cup as the Ivy League's Offensive Player of the Year.

Cahill initially came to Yale as Special Teams Coordinator and Wide Receivers Coach in 2012 and took over the quarterbacks in 2014 while also serving as Assistant Head Coach and Passing Game Coordinator. His highly-touted offense helped Yale capture Ivy League titles in 2017 and 2019 in addition to the 2022 championship.

Cahill moved on to Yale following four seasons on the staff at the University of Maine, including three as Special Teams Coordinator, while also coaching the wide receivers and running backs during his tenure. He helped the Black Bears to a pair of FCS playoff appearances and mentored six all-conference performers including All-Americans Jared Turcotte and Jhamal Fluellen.

During the 2006 and 2007 campaigns, Cahill coached at Murray State University, where coached the wide receivers and was the Racers' Recruiting Coordinator. He mentored two all-conference student-athletes.

Cahill's first Division I experience was at the University of Tennessee-Martin in 2004 and 2005, where he helped the program record its first winning season in 13 years. He began his coaching career at Maine Maritime Academy in 2001 before returning to his alma mater, Springfield College for two seasons.

As a student-athlete, Cahill was a three-year starter at quarterback and a three-year starting pitcher on the baseball team at Springfield College. He helped lead Springfield College to a pair of NCAA playoff appearances and was twice recognized as the ECAC Division III New England Player of the Year.

A native of New York Mills, N.Y., Cahill graduated from Springfield College in 2001 with a degree in physical education. He added a masters in athletic administration from Springfield in 2004.

Cahill and his wife Carah have three children: sons Patrick and Thomas and a daughter Elizabeth.
