» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- » Lenoir-Rhyne went ice cold in a 75-40 loss at Limestone on Monday afternoon to drop to 0-2 on the season. The Bears converted on just 23.7 percent of their field goals, going 14-for-59 on the day. LR went just 4-for-23 from long range and were held to 20 points through the first three quarters.
- » The 40-point output was LR's lowest scoring game since being held to 39 against Lubbock Christian on Nov. 26, 2016
- » Olivia Nunn recorded a career-high 10 rebounds against the Saints

<u>UNDEFEATED</u>

- » Tusculum enters Saturday's contest with a perfect 5-0 record, earning wins over Wingate, UVA Wise, Lincoln Memorial, Newberry and Limestone.
- » Over their past two victories, Tusculum is winning by an average of 23 points per game and holding opponents to just 48 points per game.

DOUBLE OT

- » The last time Lenoir-Rhyne and Tusculum met, the game ended up going 50 minutes before Tusculum came away with an 88-84 win inside of Shuford Gymnasium.
- » Kasey Johnson scored 34 for Tusculum and added nine boards.
- » Ashley Woodroffe had a career-high 27 points in the loss and went 10-for-15 from the field
- » Karlie Bearden (41 mins) and Kennedy Weigt (46) played nearly the entire contest for the Bears.

LR DEBUTS

» On Monday, a pair of Bears made their LR debuts. Freshman Taylor Cullen saw her first action and scored five points, while redshirt freshman Mallory Sherrill played 12 minutes in her first career game and grabbed three boards and scored three points.

NEW-LOOK BEARS

» In total, Lenoir-Rhyne has eight new players added to the roster for the 2020-21 campaign. Grahm Smith hit the recruiting trail hard when he arrived in Hickory in Mach and added talented freshmen Emily Hartman, Josie Hise and Blaikley Crooks.

SHOOTING WOES

» The last time a Lenoir-Rhyne team shot below 25 percent as a team like they did on Monday against Limestone was back on Nov. 24, 2015. In an 84-34 loss at the hands of Wingate, the Bears wtn 11-for-66 from the field, converting on just 16.7 percent of their attempts.

THE SERIES

- » Tusculum holds a 26-23 advantage all-time aganist Lenoir-Rhyne and have won the last six head-to-head battles. With one more loss to the Pioneers, LR would equal the longest losing streak to Tusculum in matchup history.
- » The last time LR lost seven straight to the Pioneers was from February 2010 to January 2013.

ROAD WARRIORS

» The Bears newly updated schedule has them starting the season with three straight road games before finally opening up at home on Saturday, December 16. The Bears will travel to Anderson, Limestone and Tusculum before hosting Queens.

NUNN RETURNS

- » Senior Olivia Nunn missed over a year due to an injury and saw her first game action since Nov. 20, 2019. The center scored nine points and grabbed three boards in her 27 minutes and went 3-for-4 from the field.
- » In her second game back, Nunn grabbed a career-high 10 boards against Limestone in the Bears loss.

GRAHM SMITH ERA

- » Last Saturday marked the first game at Lenoir-Rhyne for first-year head coach Grahm Smith who inherited an 11-win program and became the 13th head coach in program history. Smith surely didn't think he would start his tenure in an empty gym minus his top three returning scorers but the team battled against one of the toughest teams in the league and had the lead for the majority of the first three quarters before finally running out of steam.
- » Smith owned a 135-53 record in his previous stops at Dean and William Peace before coming to Lenoir-Rhyne. This is Smith's eighth season as a head coach in his career.
- » Smith is still looking to coach his first home game which is set to be played Wednesday as Queens comes to town.

LATE DEBUT

» Heading into last Saturday's season opener, Lenoir-Rhyne was one of just three teams in the South Atlantic Conference who had yet to play a game. The opener on December 5 was the latest the team started a season in team history.

TEAM LEADER

» Junior Tatum McBride led the Bears in scoring for the first time in her career on Monday and the combo guard leads LR with five made 3-pointers on the season (on 10 attempts).

MILESTONE WATCH

- » Hannah McClung is just 16 assists shy of hitting 100 for her career.
- » Kiara Moore needs six more blocks to reach 30 for her career.
- » Grahm Smith is in search of his first career victory in his LR coaching career.


