» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » Saturday marked the beginning of a historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just 9 wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

THE OPENER

- » It took until Dec. 12 for the 100th season to officially tip off but it was worth the wait. Lenoir-Rhyne defeated Catawba 93-86 inside Shuford Gym to improve to 66-34 all-time in season openers.
- » R.J. Gunn poured in 22 points and added seven boards while going 8-for-15 from the field and 4-for-8 from long range.
- » Darius Simmons took over late, scoring nine points in the final five minutes of the contest to give the Bears a late win.
- » LR had a 12-point second half lead but Catawba would come back and take a 4-point advantage with 7 minutes to play before the Bears reclaimed the advantage and defeated the Indians.

LR DOMINANCE

- » The Bears have dominated the all-time series between these two programs. Lenoir-Rhyne holds a 69-33 edge in the head-tohead series which dates back to 1923.
- » In the SAC era (1989-now), Lenoir-Rhyne holds a 48-19 advantage in the series and has won 27 of the 32 matchups inside Shuford Gym.
- » The Bears are 19-12 in the SAC era at Mars Hill and have won six straight against the Lions and nine of the last 10.
- » In the last 10 matchups with MHU, the Bears have topped the 90-point mark in six of them with LR reaching triple digits on two separate occasions including 107 in the most recent matchup.

BALANCED BEARS

- » Five Lenoir-Rhyne players scored in double figures in the season-opening win over Catawba. On top of Gunn's 22, Darius Simmons (18), Mason Hawks (14), Zim Fields (12) and Davion Bradford (10) all were in double figures.
- » It's actually two straight games with five players scoring in double digits for LR. In the SAC Tournament Quarterfinal at Queens to end last season, Gunn (21), Simmons (21), Hawks (20), Tyson McClain (12) and Cooper Fowler (10) all scored in double figures.

JOHN LENTZ COURT

» The playing surface at Shuford Gym was dedicated to John Lentz on Feb. 8, 2020 and Lenoir-Rhyne is 4-1 on Lentz Court.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 286 all-time win in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

CHASING 1K

- » Teammates Darius Simmons and R.J. Gunn each entered the season with 917 career points. After the season opener, Gunn is up to 939 career points and Simmons is sitting on 935.
- » The last time a Lenoir-Rhyne player reached the 1,000 point mark for his career came back in 2018 when Reed Lucas reached the milestone.
- » 53 players in the history of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball have scored 1,000 points and the duo of Gunn and Simmons have a strong chance to push that number to 55.

LEAGUE LEADERS

» The Bears are tied with Lincoln Memorial for the most regular season championships in conference history with eight. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

VETERAN CORE

» The veteran Lenoir-Rhyne squad is returning 2,297 of the 2,306 points scored from a season ago. The only player lost since last season was Khaileel Dailey who averaged under seven minutes a game and scored nine points for LR in 17 games played.

» All four all-conference selections from a season ago are back with Gunn (First Team) and Simmons (Honorable Mention) being joined by All-Freshman Team members Zim Fields and Cooper Fowler.

DEBUTING BEARS

- » Talented freshmen Armon Muldrew and Tim Steele each made their Lenoir-Rhyne debuts on Saturday. Muldrew played 21 minutes and had six points to go with two rebounds and two steals.
- » Steele played six minuets and had a blocked shot.

LATE STARTERS

- » Both Lenoir-Rhyne and Mars Hill had to wait until December 12 to start their 2020-21 seasons due to rescheduling and COVID conflicts. The Bears and Lions were the last two SAC programs to open their seasons.
- » Mars Hill debuted with a 89-69 loss at the hands of Wingate on Saturday. Reggie Wright led the Lions with 16 points and Jeremy Peck had 15 on 6-of-7 shooting. Jamal Bryant had four points and 11 boards.
- » Mars Hill had trouble containing Francis Sio on Saturday as the gaurd went off for 29 points on 11-of-20 shooting and added four assits and three rebounds in 26 minutes of game action.

Stats of the Game:

The Bears shot 55.9 percent from the field which represents their second-highest shooting percentage in a game this season. On January 18 at Catawba, LR hit 57.1 percent of their field goal attempts. The Bears also converted 51.9 percent (14-for-27) from long range which is also their second-best mark of the season.

- Both teams caught fire in the opening half with LR knocking down 61.2 percent and MHU converting at a 54.5 percent clip. LR went into the break with a 51-44 advantage.

- Eight players combined to score in double figures led by a game-high 31 points from Darius Simmons. Simmons went 10-for-16 from the field and 5-of-9 from 3-point range as he topped the 30-point mark for the third time this season.

 R.J. Gunn (20 points) and Mason Hawks (12 points) also scored in double digits. Mars Hill was led by a 28-point performance from Javonte Cooke and 22 from Ja'Shawn Brooks. Nassyr Daniel had a doubledouble with 13 points and 12 boards.

- Gunn also added a career-high 13 rebounds for a double-double and Davion Bradford paced the Bears with five assists.

Beyond the Box Score:

- This is the third game this season that LR has gone over 100 points. The Bears' season high was 110 points against Young Harris on November 9.

With this victory, LR and Mars Hill are tied for sixth place in the conference standings with one game to play. The Bears currently hold the No. 6 seed in the conference tournament thanks to their sweep of the Lions.

LR moves to 13-0 on the season when scoring at least 80 points in a game.
 The Bears have won six straight over Mars Hill and nine of the last 10.






