### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne dropped its third straight to open the 2020-21 campaign, falling to undefeated Tusculum by a final score of 67-44.
- » In that contest, freshman Emily Harman notched her first career double-double in just her third career game. Harman had 12 points and grabbed 10 boards on the afternoon.
- » For the second straight contest, the Bears were held below 45 points and LR is averaging just 52 points per contest.

### IN SEARCH OF NUMBER ONE

» The Bears are looking for their first win of the season after dropping the first three to start the 2020-21 campaign.

### **THE SERIES**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne holds a 44-40 all-time edge in the head-to-head matchup with Catawba in a series that dates back to 1979.
- » Over the last 10 matchups, seven have been determined by less than 10 points, including five that have been decided by five points or less.

### **HISTORY ON THIS DATE**

- » This will be the second LR/Catawba matchup to take place on January 2 and the first was a memorable one. On Jan. 2, 2016, the Bears handed Catawba an 80-79 defeat in overtime.
- » Five players scored in double figures for LR on that day, led by Jordan Hiatt's 15 including the game-winning free throws with 14 seconds to play.

### **NEW-LOOK BEARS**

» In total, Lenoir-Rhyne has eight new players added to the roster for the 2020-21 campaign. Grahm Smith hit the recruiting trail hard when he arrived in Hickory in Mach and added talented freshmen Emily Hartman, Josie Hise and Blaikley Crooks.

### **SHOOTING WOES**

» The last time a Lenoir-Rhyne team shot below 25 percent as a team like they did earlier this season against Limestone was back on Nov. 24, 2015. In an 84-34 loss at the hands of Wingate, the Bears went 11for-66 from the field, converting on just 16.7 percent of their attempts.

### **ROAD WARRIORS**

» The Bears newly updated schedule has them starting the season with three straight road games before finally opening up at home on Saturday, December 16. The Bears will travel to Anderson, Limestone and Tusculum before hosting Queens.

### **UNDEFEATED OPPONENT**

- » The Indians roll into Hickory with a perfect 3-0 mark, including victories over Anderson, Coker and Mars Hill. Catawba has been consistent in their scoring output this season, totaling 77, 74 and 78 points in their three victories.
- » Catawba is one of just three unbeaten teams left in the South Atlantic Conference. Tusculum (6-0) and Carson-Newman (3-0) are the only other teams with a zero in the loss column.

### **SCHEDULE CHANGES**

- » The ever-changing nature of the 2020-21 basketball landscape has made a number of adjustments to the Lenoir-Rhyne women's basketball schedule.
- » Due to a bunch of re-scheduled games, today will serve as the 2020-21 home opener for the Bears. The two previously scheduled home games have been postponed.

### **GRAHM SMITH ERA**

- » December 5th marked the first game at Lenoir-Rhyne for first-year head coach Grahm Smith who inherited an 11-win program and became the 13th head coach in program history. Smith surely didn't think he would start his tenure in an empty gym minus his top three returning scorers but the team battled against one of the toughest teams in the league and had the lead for the majority of the first three quarters before finally running out of steam.
- » Smith owned a 135-53 record in his previous stops at Dean and William Peace before coming to Lenoir-Rhyne. This is Smith's eighth season as a head coach in his career.
- » This will be the first home game coached by Smith.

### **LATE DEBUT**

» Heading into their season-opener, Lenoir-Rhyne was one of just three teams in the South Atlantic Conference who had yet to play a game. The opener on December 5 was the latest the team started a season in team history.

### **TEAM LEADER**

» Emily Harman has led the team in scoring twice in the first three games of the season. Harman is averaging 13 points per game through the first three which has her inside the top 20 in the South Atlantic Conference scoring list.

### **MILESTONE WATCH**

- » Hannah McClung is just 14 assists shy of hitting 100 for her career.
- » Kiara Moore needs six more blocks to reach 30 for her career.
- » Grahm Smith is in search of his first career victory in his LR coaching career.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne needs three South Atlantic Conference victories to reach 230 as a program.
- » The Bears are four wins away from hitting 720 as a team.
