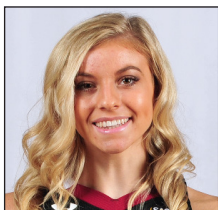

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SEASON OPENER

» It may have looked like a mismatch on paper but the Bears battled Anderson in the season opener on Saturday before falling 70-64. Anderson entered the season off a 26-win campaign and NCAA Tournament appearance last year and were picked to finish second in the preseason SAC coaches' poll. However, the Bears ran out to a 26-11 advantage after one quarter before the Trojans came storming back and eventually snuck out a victory.

UNDERMANNED? OH WELL

» The Bears had 10 active players for the season-opener with the Trojans and only seven saw action. Three of those players were freshmen but the Bears played stride for stride with Anderson who had won four of the past six SAC Regular Season Championships.

BUDDING RIVALRY

» This marks the first ever matchup between these two teams as conference foes. Limestone enters its first season as a member of the South Atlantic Conference after an extended run in Conference Carolinas.

TRAVEL TIME

» Limestone and Lenoir-Rhyne are separated by just 67 miles which is closer than any SAC opponent other than Queens (59 miles) and Catawba (55 miles).

RAINING THREES

» The Bears hit 11 3-pointers in the season-opening loss to Anderson on 21 attempts,

good for a 52.4 percentage. The last time LR shot over 50 percent from three in a game was Jan. 18, 2018 when they went 4-for-7 (57.1 percent).

» The last time LR hit 11 threes in a game came back on Nov. 9, 2019 when LR connected on 14 triples including a program-record eight from Kennedy Weigt.

ABOUT THE SAINTS

» Reagan McCray posted a game-high 18 points, including two free throws with less than a second left in regulation as Limestone picked up its first South Atlantic Conference win in program history by holding off Coker 63-61 on Saturday.

» The win was historic for Limestone who is entered South Atlantic Conference play for the first time after switching to the SAC from Conference Carolinas this season.

» Monday will mark the first league matchup between Lenoir-Rhyne and Limestone in series history.

THE SERIES

» In 11 previous matchups, Lenoir-Rhyne has come out victorious six times. The first all-time matchup came back in 1983 and the last time the two programs met was almost exactly two years ago (12-19-18). Limestone has won three straight head-to-head with the Bears including a four-point victory in Hickory back in the winter of '18.

» Madi Suddreth led the way for LR with a 16-point performance in that 77-73 set back but that loss broke a five-game winning streak for LR over the Saints.

ROAD WARRIORS

» The Bears newly updated schedule has them starting the season with three straight road games before finally opening up at home on Saturday, December 16. The Bears will travel to Anderson, Limestone and Tusculum before hosting Queens.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

» Emily Harman led the Bears with 20 points in the season opener and Josie Hise added nine off the bench. The freshmen duo contributed 29 of LR's 64 points and fellow freshman Blaikley Crooks saw 26 minutes of game action. Of course, the trio was forced into an expanded role due to roster size limitations.

NUNN RETURNS

» Senior Olivia Nunn missed over a year due to an injury and saw her first game action since Nov. 20, 2019. The center scored nine points and grabbed three boards in her 27 minutes and went 3-for-4 from the field.

GRAHM SMITH ERA

» Saturday marked the first game at Lenoir-Rhyne for first-year head coach Graham Smith who inherited an 11-win program and became the 13th head coach in program history. Smith surely didn't think he would start his tenure in an empty gym minus his top three returning scorers but the team battled against one of the toughest teams in the league and had the lead for the majority of the first three quarters before finally running out of steam.

» Smith owned a 135-53 record in his

previous stops at Dean and William Peace before coming to Lenoir-Rhyne. This is Smith's eighth season as a head coach in his career.

LATE DEBUT

» Heading into Saturday's season opener, Lenoir-Rhyne was one of just three teams in the South Atlantic Conference who had yet to play a game. The opener on December 5 was the latest the team started a season in team history.

GAME OF RUNS

» In Lenoir-Rhyne's opener against Anderson, the Bears jumped out to a 26-11 lead after one quarter. However, the Trojans would answer with a 27-10 advantage in the second quarter and went into the break with a slim 38-36 advantage.

TROJANS VS. SAINTS

» Anderson defeated Limestone on Wednesday, December 2 by a final score of 67-61 which means both LR and Limestone came up six points short of Anderson. Jalyn Spurlin led the Trojans with 24 points but the Bears were able to limit her to just nine points on 3-of-6 shooting.

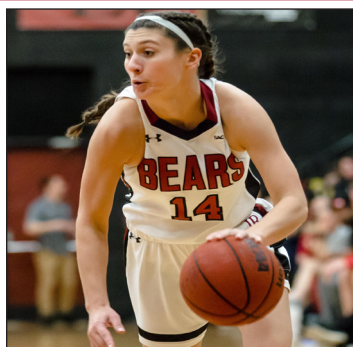

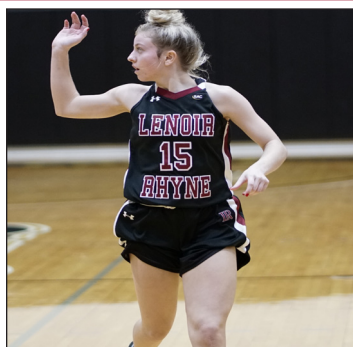
