» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » Saturday will mark the beginning of a historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just 10 wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

- » The Bears were predicted to finish third in the preseason South Atlantic Conference Coaches' Poll and earned one first-place vote.
- » Catawba was voted to finish fifth in the conference after a 20-10 season a year ago.

STORIED RIVALRY

» Lenoir-Rhyne and Catawba will be meeting for the 210th time on Saturday in a rivalry that dates back to 1926. Catawba is the opponent that LR has played the most and beaten the most (114). Behind the 210 matchups with Catawba, the most played rival is Elon with 165 matchups and the secon-most beaten opponent with 88 Bear wins.

65 IN THE SHU

» 2020-21 will mark the 65th season inside Shuford Memorial Gymnasium for the Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball program. The Bears went a perfect 6-0 in the first season at the Shu (1956-57) and have had two other undefeated seasons at home since then. The Bears have won 71.8 percent of their home games at Shuford Gym with winning season in 50 of the first 64 years at home.

JOHN LENTZ COURT

» The playing surface at Shuford Gym was dedicated to John Lentz on Feb. 8, 2020 and Lenoir-Rhyne is 3-1 on Lentz Court. Lentz coached Lenoir-Rhyne for 29 years and had a distinguished four-year playing career at LR. Lentz owns a 432-374 all-time record and is the program's record holder for most career assists (524). His record of 19 assists in a game still stands today.

DYNAMIC DUO

- » Seniors R.J. Gunn and Darius Simmons enter the 2020-21 season as First Team Preseason All-Conference selections as voted on by league coaches giving the Bears a dynamic 1-2 punch.
- » The duo also enter the season with the exact same career point total (917). They each have a chance to become the 54th and 55th members of the 1,000 point club at Lenoir-Rhyne.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the season with 285 all-time win in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

PRIME TIME MATCHUP

- » A season ago, Lenoir-Rhyne and Catawba met in the NCAA Division II National Showcase game on ESPN3. The Bears came away with a 91-85 victory in front of a national audience.
- » During the 2019-20 season, the Bears and Indians met in the South Atlantic Conference Tournament Championship game with Catawba coming away with a 71-67 victory. Each team would advance to the NCAA Tournament that season.

LEAGUE LEADERS

» The Bears are tied with Lincoln Memorial for the most regular season championships in conference history with eight. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

VETERAN CORE

- » The veteran Lenoir-Rhyne squad is returning 2,297 of the 2,306 points scored from a season ago. The only player lost since last season was Khaileel Dailey who averaged under seven minutes a game and scored nine points for LR in 17 games played.
- » All four all-conference selections from a

season ago are back with Gunn (First Team) and Simmons (Honorable Mention) being joined by All-Freshman Team members Zim Fields and Cooper Fowler.

RAINING TREYS

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranked second in the South Atlantic Conference with 293 made 3-pointers a season ago, trailing only Lincoln Memorial (372). The Bears also ranked second in the league with 844 attempts from long range.

DIME DROPPERS

» Lenoir-Rhyne was also second in the league in assists at 15.5 per game while turning the ball over just 12.4 times which was the second-lowest number in the entire conference.

STRUGGLES ON THE BOARDS

» With the lack of interior depth, the Bears were 11th out of 12 SAC team in rebounds per game during the 2019-20 season. LR's 33.3 rebounds per game were only better than Coker (32.5) on the season.

732

» This will be the 732nd all-time men's basketball game played inside Shuford Gymnasium. The Bears own a 525-206 alltime record and .718 winning percentage on their home floor.

BEARS MEN'S BASKETBALL

SEASON OPENERS

- » The Bears own a 65-34 all-time mark in season openers but have gone just 5-5 over the past 10 years.
- » The Bears have two eight-game winning streaks in openers. Once in 1969-1976 and again from 2002-09.
- » The most points scored in a seasonopening game is 112 in 1993 in a 112-97 victory over Concord.
- » The most points allowed in an opener was 100 which happened twice. Once in 1965 (a 100-79 loss to Guilford) and again in 1992 (a 100-94 loss to High Point).
- » LR's largest margin of victory in the first game of the season was 47 back in 1951 when they defeated Charleston Naval 81-34.
- » The least points allowed in a seasonopening game was four in the first-ever LR game, a 16-4 win over Hickory Town in 1919.
- » The largest margin of defeat in a season opener came in 1998 when the Bears lost by 35 (72-37) to Henderson State.
- » Only one season opener has gone to overtime. The 1996 opener featured a 70-67 overtime victory for the Bears over Clark-Atlanta.

» This will be the second time that Catawba and Lenoir-Rhyne have squared off in game one of the season. The Bears and Indians squared off to open the 1947-48 season with Catawba coming away with a 51-43 victory.

CHANGE OF PLANS

- » The Bears were slated to open the year with the SAC/Peach Belt Conference crossover. Emmanuel was set to host this year as the Bears were slated to open with Young Harris and Emmanuel on back-to-back days.
- » The SAC/Peach Belt Conference crossover had been the Bears' season-opening weekend for the past six years. Prior to that, it was the SAC and Conference Carolinas that held a crossover weekend to open the season.
