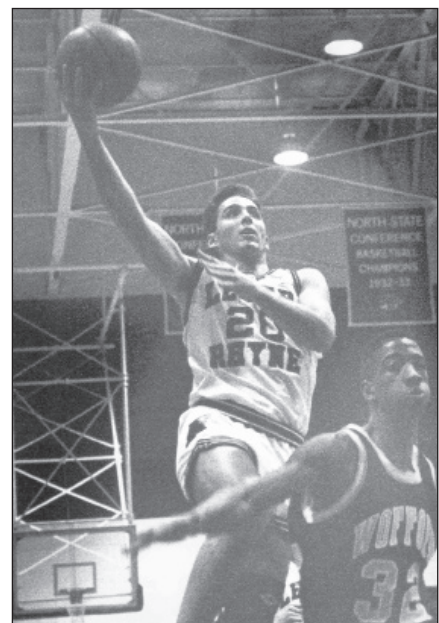

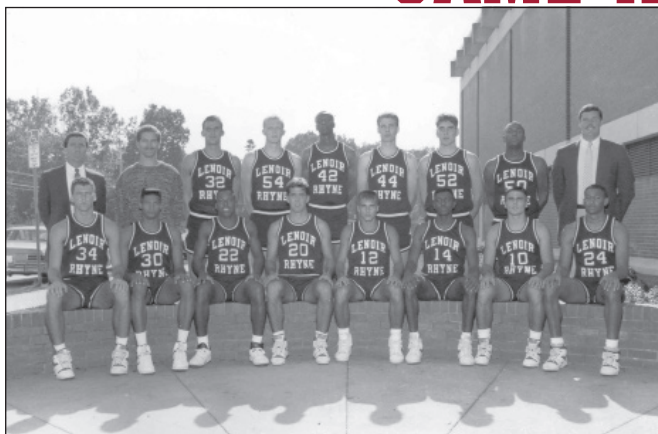

ABOUT

During the 2020-21 season, Lenoir-Rhyne will be celebrating the 65th year in the friendly and warm confines of Shuford Memorial Gymnasium. Shuford Gym, which is the home to men's and women's basketball and the volleyball program, has a capacity of 3,200 and has been the home of the Bears since the 1956-57 season.

The building was erected in the memory of the late A. Alex Shuford Sr., and was officially dedicated on Feb. 16, 1957, with a near-capacity crowd in attendance as the Bears defeated Catawba 87-66. The Bears won all six home contests during the inaugural season and fittingly, it was Raeford Wells, LR's all-time leading scorer and there-time All-American, who scored the first points in the new facility.

On Feb. 8, 2020, the court was officially dedicated to John Lentz. Lentz coached the Bears for 29 seasons and was a standout during his time as a student-athlete. Lentz is first all-time in coaching victories and owns the program record for assists. The Bears won the first-ever game on John Lentz court with an 89-85 win over Anderson that same evening.

One of the best home court advantages in the region, Shuford Gym and John Lentz Court have continued to be a fit for visiting teams. In the first 64 years of the facility, LR has posted 50 winning seasons and four .500 seasons. In total, the Bears have won 71.8 percent of their home games and earned the 500th all-time win on Nov. 25, 2017 in a 71-60 win over Limestone. Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, the Bears will look to build on the 525 all-time victories in "The Shu".
