### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- » The Bears got in the win column for the first time in the Grahm Smith Era Saturday afternoon in the Shu. Emily Harman lead the Bears with 20 points and 7 rebounds and Hanna McClung added 15 points, five assists and five rebounds for the Bears in a 63-54 win over Lincoln Memorial.
- » Freshman Blaikley Crooks came off the bench for the Bears and scored 11 points and added 5 rebounds in 25 minutes of action.
- » The Bears used a red-hot fourth quarter to put the game away. The Bears shot 63% from the floor in the last quarter to pull away from Lincoln Memorial.

#### **NEW FIVE**

- » For the first time this season, the Bears had a different starting lineup for Saturday's contest against Lincoln Memorial. Alyssa Wagner and Mallory Sherrill started for the first time this season replacing Tatum McBride and Kiara Moore, who both missed the contest due to injuries.
- » All the starters played at least 27 minutes on Saturday including 38 minutes from Wagner and all 40 minutes for Hanna McClung.

#### **ABOUT THE OPPONENT**

- » UVA-Wise has started the season with a 4-1 record in the SAC. The Cavaliers have won four straight since falling to Tusculum (7-0) in their season opener.
- » The Cavaliers have averaged 92 points per game during their 4 game winning streak. Nia Vanzant leads the Cavaliers in scoring at

- 16.8 points per game, one of five Cavs that average double figures per game.
- » UVA Wise ranks third in the nation in assists per game at 21.2 and fifth in Division II in assist-turnover ratio. They also rank eighth in the nation in blocked shots and fifth in scoring offense.
- » Hanna Oliver's 4.0 made 3-pointers per game ranks fifth in the nation and Caitlyn Ross is fifth in DII with 7.2 assists per game. On the interior, Meg Crawford's 3.2 blocks per game is fourth in the nation.

#### **BRIEF HISTORY**

- » With UVA-Wise joining the SAC last year, this marks only the third meeting between the teams. LR took both games last year, a 68-64 win in Wise on 1/15/20 and an 86-70 victory in Hickory on 2/19/20.
- » The 86 points scored by the Bears in the last game against UVA-Wise was the most points the Bears have scored in a game since scoring 90 points on 12/13/2017 in a game at Mars Hill.

#### **ENTERING THE TOP 10**

» After posting a 20 point-7 rebound game Saturday afternoon, freshman Emily Harman has cracked the top 10th in both scoring and rebounds per game in the conference. Harman is currently 9th in the SAC in scoring with a 14.4 points per game average and 10th in rebounding averaging 7.0 rebounds per game.

#### **SCORING SLUMP**

» Lenoir-Rhyne's 53.2 points per game rank 148th in the nation out of 163 qualifying teams which is an increase after a 63-point showing at home against the Railsplitters on Saturday.

#### **DISCIPLINED**

» LR ranks fourth in the South Atlantic Conference in fewest fouls (95) and fewest turnovers (82). The Bears are fifth in the league in fewest turnovers per game at 16.4.

#### **MAJOR MINUTES**

- » The trio of Emily Harman, Hanna McClung and Alyssa Wagner all rank inside the top 10 in the nation in minutes played.
- » Harman is sixth in the land in minutes/ game at 35.4.
- » McClung comes in at 17th with 31.9 minutes and Wagner has played 31.7 in her two games this year, which ranks 18th.

#### **NUMBER TWO FROM THREE**

» Hanna McClung ranks eighth in the league in 3-point field goals made with 12 and fifth in 3-pointers per game at 2.40. Her 34.3 percentage from long range places her just outside the top 10 in the conference at twelfth.

#### **LATE LEADERS**

- » The Bears have led heading into the fourth quarter in each of their previous two contests.
- » Against Catawba, LR took a 44-42 lead into the final frame and held a 42-40 lead

against Lincoln Memorial on Saturday afternoon.

#### **SEVEN DEEP**

- » The Bears played just seven players in a victory over the Railsplitters, including four freshmen.
- » Because of injuries and being shorthanded, Lenoir-Rhyne rarely subbed and Josie Hise only recorded eight minutes.
- » The other six players recorded 192 of the possible 200 minutes in the contest.

#### **WAGNER FACTOR**

- » Alyssa Wagner returned to the lineup against Catawba and has played a major role in her two games.
- » Wagner routinely matches up with the opponents top scorer and the junior did a great job on Catawba's Taisha DeShazo in her season debut.
- » Wagner then filled the stat sheet in her second contest of the year, going for five points, six rebounds and two assists in the win over LMU.

#### **CROOKS EMERGING**

» Freshman Blaikley Crooks poured in a career-high 11 points off the bench in the Bears win over LMU and has scored in double figures in each of Lenoir-Rhyne's two games since the calendar flipped to 2021.


