» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

» This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.

» The Bears are just 8 wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.

» 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

LAST TIME OUT

» In one of the biggest wins in the history of the program, Lenoir-Rhyne ended #2 Lincoln Memorial's 39-game winning streak with an 89-83 win on Saturday afternoon. The win also served as the highest-ranked opponent LR has ever beaten.

» It was just the second time since 2010 that Lenoir-Rhyne had defeated Lincoln Memorial with both of those wins coming under Everick Sullivan.

» The loss to the Bears was LMU's first loss since Nov. 1, 2019, a stretch of 435 days and the winning streak was the longest streak at any level.

» LR hit 25-of-26 from the free throw line and went a perfect 20-for-20 in the second half. Darius Simmons went 12-for-12 from the charity stripe to lead the Bears to the upset win.

NEW CONFERENCE OPPONENT

» UVA Wise entered the South Atlantic Conference at the start of the 2019-20 season and tonight is the third all-time matchup between the two programs.

» The Bears earned a sweep of last year's contests against the Cavaliers.

CHASING 1,000

» Heading into Monday's game, the duo of Darius Simmons and R.J. Gunn each have a chance to eclipse the 1,000 point mark for their careers.

» Simmons needs just five points to reach 1,000 and Gunn needs to go off for 25 for the duo to each reach the 1K mark in the same contest.

» The last time a Lenoir-Rhyne player reached the 1,000 point mark for his career came back in 2018 when Reed Lucas reached the milestone.

» 53 players in the history of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball have scored 1,000 points and the duo of Gunn and Simmons have a strong chance to push that number to 55.

ANOTHER POSTPONMENT

» The Bears were slated to travel to Anderson on Monday afternoon but that game was postponed due to COVID-19 protocols.

» Lenoir-Rhyne has had nine games rescheduled due to postponements. Only Saturday's game against LMU and tonight's matchup at Wise are being played on the day that they were originally scheduled.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 288 all-time win in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

MORE LMU TIDBITS

- » The win over Lincoln Memorial was the 12th all-time win over a ranked team in the South Atlantic Conference era (1989-present).
- » Five of those wins have been orchestrated by current head coach Everick Sullivan.
- » Two of Lincoln Memorial's last four losses have come courtesy of the Bears, dating back to the end of the 2018-19 seasons.
- » The trio of Simmons, Gunn and Mason Hawks combined for 62 points on the night.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne led for 34:01 of the game and never trailed by less than four points in the game.
- » LMU came into the game winning by an average of 27.7 points per game before the Bears handed them a loss. They also entered the game as the nation's leader in field goal percentage (57.7) heading into the contest and were held to just 29.6 percent shooting in the first half.

LEAGUE LEADERS

» The Bears are tied with Lincoln Memorial for the most regular season championships in conference history with eight. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

VETERAN CORE

- » The veteran Lenoir-Rhyne squad is returning 2,297 of the 2,306 points scored from a season ago. The only player lost since last season was Khaileel Dailey who averaged under seven minutes a game and scored nine points for LR in 17 games played.
- » All four all-conference selections from a season ago are back with Gunn (First Team) and Simmons (Honorable Mention) being joined by All-Freshman Team members Zim Fields and Cooper Fowler.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- » UVA Wise has dropped five straight to open the 2020-21 campaign and has struggled to slow opponents.
- » The Cavs give up 97.2 points per game and allow opponents to shoot 51.3 percent from the field.
- » The 97.2 points per game allowed ranks UVA Wise 163rd out of 167 Division II teams and the opposing field goal percentage is 157th in the nation.
- » UVA Wise struggles on the boards and are being outrebounded by an average of 10 boards per night.
- » Individually, Cameron Whiteside leads the South Atlantic Conference in double-doubles and is second in the league in free throws made and free throws attempted. He also leads the SAC in scoring at 29.0 points per game.

» Lenoir-Rhyne has trotted out three different starting lineups in the first four games.

MUL-DREW A TOUGH ASSIGNMENT

» In his first career start, Armon Muldrew had a tough task. The freshman from California was tasked with covering Devon Whitfield who came into the game averaging 21.7 points per game and is a South Atlantic Conference Player of the Year candidate.

» In the first 20 minutes, Whitfield was held to just four points but he erupted for 17 in the second half.

» Muldrew's 30 minutes were a career-high.
