### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

» This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.

» The Bears are just 6 wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.

» 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

#### LAST TIME OUT

» Darius Simmons became the 54th player in Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Basketball history to reach 1,000 career points as the Bears thumped UVA Wise 98-63 on Wednesday night.

» The Bears posted their first 30-point win since 2018 and nearly broke the single game record for assists with 29, coming just short of the mark of 31 set in 2000.

» 17 different players saw action in the blowout win and 13 different players found the scoring column.

» Simmons finished with 21 points in just 19 minutes, the 14th 20-point game of his career.

» The win was the 60th in the LR Head Coaching career of Everick Sullivan.

#### TAKIN' CHARITY

» Lenoir-Rhyne is 32-of-34 from the charity stripe over the previous two games, connecting at a 94.1 percent clip as a team.

» The Bears went a perfect 20-for-20 from the free throw line in the second half of their upset win over Lincoln Memorial on Saturday.

» Darius Simmons has connected on 16 straight free throws and Mason Hawks has hit 12 straight.

#### CHASING 1,000

» After teammate Darius Simmons topped 1,000 career points, R.J. Gunn is poised to be the 55th player in team history to reach that threshold.

» Gunn enters Saturday's contest needing just 13 points to reach 1,000 as the duo of Simmons and Gunn entered the season with exactly 917 points.

» Prior to Simmons topping 1,000 career points, the last member of the 1K club was Reed Lucas in 2018.

#### DROPPIN' DIMES

» After dishing out 29 assists against UVA Wise on Wednesday, the Bears rank 14th in the nation in assists per game at 17.6 and trail only Lincoln Memorial in the South Atlantic Conference.

#### FORCING TO'S

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 21st in the nation and first in the South Atlantic Conference in turnovers forced per game at 17.4.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

#### CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 289 all-time win in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

#### NATIONAL POLLS

» Lenoir-Rhyne is receiving votes in the NABC poll.

» The last time Lenoir-Rhyne was nationally ranked was during the 2018-19 season when they were No. 17 in the media poll. After a loss to Queens, the Bears fell from the top 25 and haven't returned since.

» The highest national ranking in program history is 11 back on February 26, 2008.

#### STEELE STEPPING UP

» Over his last four games, freshman Tim Steele has been emerging as a scoring threat for the Bears.

» Steele was held scoreless in his LR debut but has scored 32 points over the past four games including a career-high 14 against UVA Wise on Wednesday.

» Steele went 6-of-8 from the field against the Cavaliers and has played at least 20 minutes twice this year.

#### NOT JUST A SHOOTER

» Mason Hawks tied a career-high with eight assists (in just 19 minutes) on Wednesday at UVA Wise and only turned the ball over once.

#### ABOUT THE EAGLES

» Carson-Newman had a great showing against No. 15/12 Queens on Wednesday and had two chances to win the game in the final moments.

» A late turnover and a missed shot at the buzzer sent the Eagles to a tough 63-62 loss against the Royals at home.

» The Eagles held Queens to its lowest scoring output in more than a year in that contest and the Royals went the final 4:09 without a made field goal.

#### 3-POINT LINE

» Carson-Newman has struggled to defend the 3-point line so far in the 2020-21 season.

» The Eagles allow opponents to convert 41.7 percent from long range, a figure that ranks 162nd out of 177 Division II teams.

» Lenoir-Rhyne hits on 36.5 percent of their 3-point attempts but have been hot in recent games.

» Over the past two contests, Lenoir-Rhyne has converted from long range at a 43.8 percent clip, hitting 21-of-48 from deep against Lincoln Memorial and UVA Wise.

» There has been three games this season that the Bears have shot above 40 percent from long range. However, in the other two games, the Bears have hit just 29.4 percent.

» LR opponents are hitting just 32.8 percent of their 3-point attempts.

- » Hawks hit his first seven 3-point attempts en route to a 7-of-8 showing from long range and a career-high 25 point performance.

### GUNN, 2K - 1K

- » Senior forward R.J. Gunn can top a pair of milestones on Saturday.
- » In addition to his pursuit of 1,000 career points, Gunn needs 25 minutes played to reach 2,000 for his career.
- » Currently, Gunn's 1,975 career minutes played ranks fifth in the SAC era.

### MUL-DREW A TOUGH ASSIGNMENT

- » In his first career start, Armon Muldrew had a tough task. The freshman from California was tasked with covering Devon Whitfield who came into the game averaging 21.7 points per game and is a South Atlantic Conference Player of the Year candidate.
- » In the first 20 minutes, Whitfield was held to just four points but he erupted for 17 in the second half.
- » Muldrew's 30 minutes were a career-high.
