» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just 6 wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Lenoir-Rhyne was held to its lowest scoring output in four years during a 73-54 loss at Carson-Newman on Saturday afternoon. The Bears were held to 29 percent shooting and were outscored 31-14 in the final 14:41 after taking a brief 41-39 lead in the second half.
- » R.J. Gunn scored 14 points to become the 55th player in Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Basketball team history to join the 1,000 point club.
- » On the defensive end, the Bears allowed Carson-Newman to shoot 64 percent from the field in the final 20 minutes and the Eagles hit 62.5 percent from long range in the second half.
- $\,$ $\,$ EJ Bush scored a game-high 20 points to lead the Eagles to the upset victory.
- » LR dropped to 11-22 all-time in the SAC era at Carson-Newman.

TAKIN' CHARITY

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is 39-of-43 from the charity stripe over the previous three games, connecting at a 90.1 percent clip as a team.
- » The Bears went a perfect 20-for-20 from the free throw line in the second half of their upset win over Lincoln Memorial on Saturday.
- » Mason Hawks has connected on 12 straight free throws and Darius Simmons has hit 19 out of his past 20 attempts.

RJ, DK - 1K

- » Teammates R.J. Gunn and Darius (DK)
 Simmons became the 54th and 55th players
 in team history to join the 1,000 point club.
 Each player did it last week with Simmons
 netting his 1,000th point against UVA Wise
 on Wednesday and Gunn joining the club with
 a second half dunk at Carson-Newman.
- The duo entered the season with exactly 917 points apiece.
- » The last player to join the 1k club was Reed Lucas in 2018.

DROP IN THE STANDINGS

- » With the loss to Carson-Newman on Saturday, the Bears fell out of a first-place tie with Queens and Lincoln Memorial. All three programs had one loss going into the weekend but the Bears dropped to fifth according to winning percentage.
- » Overall, the Bears join Tusculum and Newberry as teams in the conference with only two losses but with teams all playing a different amount of games, the standings are pretty much a jumbled mess.

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 289 all-time win in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

NATIONAL POLLS

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is receiving votes in the NABC poll.
- » The last time Lenoir-Rhyne was nationally ranked was during the 2018-19 season when they were No. 17 in the media poll. After a loss to Queens, the Bears fell from the top 25 and haven't returned since.
- » The highest national ranking in program history is 11 back on February 26, 2008.

STREAK STOPPED

- » R.J. Gunn had hit at least one 3-pointer in 21 straight games but his 0-for-3 against Carson-Newman ended that streak.
- » Darius Simmons had hit 16 straight free throw attempts before missing his first attempt on Saturday.
- » Gunn had also never fouled out of a game in his career but was disqualified on Saturday for the first time in his 83-game career.

NOT JUST A SHOOTER

- » Mason Hawks tied a career-high with eight assists (in just 19 minutes) on Wednesday at UVA Wise and only turned the ball over once.
- » Hawks also dished out a team-high five

assists against the Eagles.

ABOUT THE ROYALS

- » Queens was tabbed to finish second in the South Atlantic Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll. They were picked behind Lincoln Memorial and one spot ahead of Lenoir-Rhyne.
- » The Royals opened their 2020-21 campaign at the DC Paradise Jam against three Division I opponents.
- » Queens opened with a 1-point loss against George Mason, 66-65. The next afternoon, Queens defeated Howard, 85-71. Playing against Makur Maker, a consensus five-star recruit and top 20 freshman in the nation, Queens held the big man to 12 points and four rebounds.
- » In the last game of the DC Paradise Jam, Queens dropped a 73-61 decision to a Belmont program that went 26-7 a season ago and is 9-1 this year. Belmont was slated to be an NCAA Tournament team in 2019-20 as OVC Conference Champions before the NCAA Tournament was cancelled.
- » The Royals are riding a 6-game winning streak and defeated UVA Wise 91-67 on Saturday.
- » Queens hasn't loss since an upset defeat at the hands of Wingate back on December 5.
- » In the previous matchup with LR this season, Queens handed the Bears an 88-68 loss on January 2nd.
- » The Royals are ranked 15th in the NABC poll and 12th in the D2SIDA poll.




