### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- » On Saturday afternoon, the Bears dropped a road contest against #23 Carson-Newman 91-73. Carson-Newman scored 30 seconds into the game and lead for the remaining 39 minutes.
- » The Bears did make a big push in the third quarter. After the Eagles opened up a 23 point lead with 4:08 left to go in the third quarter, the Bears went on to score 15 out of the last 17 points in the quarter, including an 11-0 run to end the quarter.

#### **SECOND QUARTER WOES**

» The Bears have only shot 29.8% (31-104) in the second quarter this year so far which has lead the Bears to be outscored by 49 points. LR has only scored 83 points in their seven games in the second quarter, their lowest scoring quarter of the year. On the other hand, their opponents have scored 132 points in the second quarter.

#### **LR DEBUT**

» Syndey Wilson made her Bears debut on Saturday. The sophomore from Henderson, Tenn. played 13 minutues for the Bears and scored four points and added four rebounds for LR.

#### **ABOUT THE OPPONENT**

» Wingate comes to the Shu with a 3-5 record and a 3-4 record in the SAC. The Bulldogs are a deep team with at least 13 players averaging eight minutes a game this year. No one is averaging more then 29 minutes per game for the Bulldogs.

» Wingate is led by Grad Transfer Haleigh Hatfield. Hatfield, a grad transfer from UC-San Deigo, is averaging a double-double this year with 14.4 points and 10.6 rebounds.

» Despite a 3-5 record, the Bulldogs have a point difference of zero so far this year. Wingate has scored 568 points so far and have given up exactly 568 points.

#### **HARMAN DOES IT ALL**

Freshman Emily Harman continued to stuff the box score this week. In the Bears two games this week. Harman averaged 15.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists for LR.
 Harman is the only player in the SAC conference to be averaging at least 14.0 points, 7 rebounds and at least 3.5 assists
