» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just five wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Lenoir-Rhyne won its second straight home game over a nationally ranked opponent with a 71-66 win over No. 12 Queens on Monday afternoon. The Bears defeated No. 2 Lincoln Memorial in the previous home game and have won three straight inside Shuford Gymnasium.
- » It was the second time in three years that LR beat both Queens and LMU in the same season.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne erased a 49-37 deficit with 11:44 to play and ended the game outscoring the Royals 34-17 down the stretch.
- » The Bears used a 16-0 scoring run to take the upperhand and defeat Queens for the fourth time in the past three seasons.
- $\,\,$ » It was also the second straight home win over Queens for LR.

TAKIN' CHARITY

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is 53-of-61 from the charity stripe over the previous three games, connecting at a 86.9 percent clip as a team.
- » The Bears went a perfect 20-for-20 from the free throw line in the second half of their upset win over Lincoln Memorial on Saturday.
- » Mason Hawks has connected on 12 straight free throws and Darius Simmons has hit 25 out of his past 27 attempts.
- » Simmons ranks 16th in the nation in free throws made on the year at 42.

RJ. DK - 1K

- » Teammates R.J. Gunn and Darius (DK)
 Simmons became the 54th and 55th players
 in team history to join the 1,000 point club.
 Each player did it last week with Simmons
 netting his 1,000th point against UVA Wise
 on Wednesday and Gunn joining the club with
 a second half dunk at Carson-Newman.
- » The duo entered the season with exactly 917 points apiece.
- » The last player to join the 1k club was Reed Lucas in 2018.

UPSET SULLY

- » Of the 13 wins over ranked teams since 1989-90, head coach Everick Sullivan has engineered six of those upsets.
- » Four of the ranked wins have come over Queens including twice when the Royals were in the top 10 in the nation.
- » The win over #2 LMU was the highest ranked opponent Lenoir-Rhyne has ever beaten.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 290 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.

CHERISH THE ROCK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne hasn't turned the ball over more than their opponents in any game this season.
- » The 12.6 turnovers per game by the Bears is the third-best mark in the South Atlantic Conference.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 14th in the nation in turnover margin. The Bears are +4.3 in turnover margin and the 16.86 turnovers forced per game ranks 24th in Division II.

BALANCED ATTACK

- » For the second time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne had five players score in double figures in the win over Queens.
- Gunn (14), Fowler (13), Simmons (11),
 Muldrew (10) and Bradford (10) all reached double figures for the Bears in the win.
- » The other time this year that five Bears reached double figures came back in the season-opening win over Catawba. Gunn (22), Simmons (18), Hawks (14), Fields (12) and Bradford (10) all scored at least 10 in the victory.

ABOUT THE BULLDOGS

- » The Bears and Bulldogs have something in common, each have comeback wins over Wingate.
- Wingate erased a 17-point second half deficit at Queens and came away with an 80-71 victory. Meanwhile, the Bears trailed by 12 in the second half.
- » Most recently, Wingate lost an exhibition contest at Maryland on Friday by a final score of 100-58.
- » In their most recent SAC game, the Bulldogs defeated Coker 86-74 on January 13. Andreas Wilson poured in 16 of his career-high 26 points in the second half to lead Wingate to victory.
- » LR owns a 53-39 all-time edge in the headto-head series with Wingate but the Bulldogs have won 6 of the last 10 matchups.
- » Wingate is just 11-23 in the SAC Era inside Shuford Gymnasium but have three of the last four games in Hickory.
- » After starting the season 0-2, the Bulldogs have battled back by winning six of seven.
- » Wingate isn't afraid to pull from deep as they rank 21st in the nation in 3-point field goal attempts at 228.
- » The Bulldogs also get to the line a bunch. WU ranks eighth in the nation in free throws attempted (226) and ninth in the land in free throw makes (164).

- » Sophomore center Cooper Fowler returned from missing Saturday's game at Carson-Newman in a huge way on Monday.
- The big man posted season highs in minutes played, points, field goals made,
 3-pointers made and blocked shots to help the Bears past the Royals.
- Fowler finished with 13 points, seven boards and three blocks and hit four 3-pointers.

PUTTING THE '0' IN ARMON

- » For the first time in his brief LR career, freshman Armon Muldrew reached double digits in scoring.
- » Muldrew finished with 10 points, including a personal 6-0 run, in the win over the Royals.
- » Both of Muldrew's made 3-pointers on the season came against Queens and he averages 9.5 points per game against the Royals.

2 IN THE L-COLUMN

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is one of three teams with two losses in SAC play. LR, Queens and Newberry all trail Lincoln Memorial (one loss) in the conference standings.
- » However, four teams are currently sitting at three losses. Tusculum, Wingate, Anderson and Mars Hill have all lost a trio of times so far this season.




