» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just four wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

SHOT HEARD ROUND THE SHU

- » Cooper Fowler hit one of the most memorable shots in the 65 years at Shuford Gymnasium on Wednesday evening.
- » Trailing Wingate by one with 6.1 seconds left, Darius Simmons took the in-bounds pass and raced up court. He launched a 35-footer that front-rimmed and Fowler was in the right place at the right time.
- » The big man grabbed the rebound with under 1 second remaining at the free throw line and in one motion double-pumped and hit a 15-footer at the buzzer that gave LR an 86-85 victory.
- » The play earned the No. 8 top play on SportsCenter's top 10 plays.
- » It was also picked up and posted by @ NCAADII

WINGATE WIN

- » Outside of Fowler's heroics, the Bears earned a huge win on Wednesday. For the second straight home game, Lenoir-Rhyne erased a double-digit deficit in the second half and came away with a win.
- » The Bears trailed Wingate by 10 with just under six minutes to go before the dynamic duo of RJ Gunn and Darius Simmons took over.
- » Simmons scored nine straight points for LR to cut the lead to one before Gunn scored six straight.
- » In total, six different players scored in double figures for Lenoir-Rhyne.
- » The Bears won despite going just 6-for-25 from long range as Mason Hawks had 16 points, seven assists and five rebounds on the evening.

RJ, DK - 1K

- » Teammates R.J. Gunn and Darius (DK)
 Simmons became the 54th and 55th players
 in team history to join the 1,000 point club.
 Each player did it last week with Simmons
 netting his 1,000th point against UVA Wise
 on Wednesday and Gunn joining the club with
 a second half dunk at Carson-Newman.
- » The duo entered the season with exactly 917 points apiece.
- » The last player to join the 1k club was Reed Lucas in 2018.
- » The duo were each recognized before the Wingate game and presented with basketballs.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

UPSET SULLY

- » Of the 13 wins over ranked teams since 1989-90, head coach Everick Sullivan has engineered six of those upsets.
- » Four of the ranked wins have come over Queens including twice when the Royals were in the top 10 in the nation.
- » The win over #2 LMU was the highest ranked opponent Lenoir-Rhyne has ever beaten.

CHASING MILESTONES

- » Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 291 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.
- » The Bears are now just four wins shy of 1,400 as a program. Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 1,396-1,128 all-time record in the first 99 and-a-half years of hoops.

CHERISH THE ROCK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne hasn't turned the ball over more than their opponents in any game this season.
- » The 11.9 turnovers per game by the Bears is the second-best mark in the South Atlantic Conference.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 14th in the nation in turnover margin. The Bears are +4.8 in turnover margin and the 16.62 turnovers forced per game ranks 26th in Division II.

ABOUT THE COBRAS

- » The Cobras are looking to surpass the .500 mark as they enter with identical 4-4 overall and conference records.
- » Coker has struggled to score, averaging just 67.6 points per game which ranks 156 out of 186 qualifying teams. That figure also ranks 13th out of 13 teams in the South Atlantic Conference.
- » Coker is disciplined on defense as the Cobras commit just 14.8 fouls per game, a figure that ranks 17th in the nation and first in the SAC.
- The 15.8 assists per game for Coker is the 32nd-best mark in the nation.
- » Individually, Malcolm Kennedy ranks 17th in the nation with 67 three-point field goal attempts. Kennedy converts at a 32.8 percent clip from deep.
- » Coker looks to snap a 2-game losing streak. The Cobras lost by 12 at Wingate and eight at Tusculum heading into Saturday's contest.

3-GAMER

- » This marks the first week this season that Lenoir-Rhyne will compete in three games in a calendar week.
- » With a win on Saturday, the Bears will finish the week with a 3-0 mark.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne is scheduled to have a second-straight 3-game slate next week with a road trip at Limestone on Monday followed by home games against Mars Hill and Tusculum.

- » With the unbalanced schedule this season, this will be the only meeting between Lenoir-Rhyne and Coker this season.
- » A win would keep Lenoir-Rhyne tied with Queens in the loss column with two losses. The Royals are off this weekend and sit at 8-2 in the league standings but the Bears hold the head-to-head tiebreaker.






