» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- » In their 2020-21 home opener, the Lenoir-Rhyne women's basketball team dropped a tough 60-55 contest against undefeated Catawba on Saturday afternoon.
- Hanna McClung led the Bears with 16 points and tied a career-high with four made 3-pointers on the afternoon.
- » Emily Harman netted 13 points for LR and Blaikley Crooks added a career-high 10 points.
- » Kiara Moore and Harman each pulled down 10 rebounds.
- » The Bears led entering the fourth quarter but were outscored by seven in the final 10 minutes and came up short in their search for win number one on the season.

IN SEARCH OF NUMBER ONE

» The Bears are looking for their first win of the season after dropping the first four to start the 2020-21 campaign.

THE LAST MEETING

- » The last time Lenoir-Rhyne and Lincoln Memorial met in Shuford Gymnasium, the Bears came away with a 56-52 victory in February 2020.
- » Nakia Hooks and Karlie Bearden each dropped 13 points for the Bears who improved to 7-8 in SAC play and swept the regular season series from the Railsplitters.
- » Sydney Newsome scored 15 points off the bench for LMU and added seven rebounds but also turned the ball over eight times in the contest.

NEW-LOOK BEARS

» In total, Lenoir-Rhyne has eight new players added to the roster for the 2020-21 campaign. Grahm Smith hit the recruiting trail hard when he arrived in Hickory in Mach and added talented freshmen Emily Hartman, Josie Hise and Blaikley Crooks.

HOME STRETCH

» After playing their first three on the road, the Bears will play their second straight home contest against Lincoln Memorial.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- » In a scheduling quirk, Tusculum will play two consecutive games against Lenoir-Rhyne. The Pioneers are 6-0 but haven't played since defeating Lenoir-Rhyne 67-44 on December 12.
- » At 6-0, the Pioneers are one of four teams in NCAA Division II with at least six wins and no losses.
- » As winners of the 2019-20 South Atlantic Conference Tournament, the Pioneers have actually won nine straight games dating back to last season. Only two of those nine wins have come by single digits as the Pioneers have had little trouble putting away opponents.

GRAHM SMITH ERA

- » December 5th marked the first game at Lenoir-Rhyne for first-year head coach Grahm Smith who inherited an 11-win program and became the 13th head coach in program history. Smith surely didn't think he would start his tenure in an empty gym minus his top three returning scorers but the team battled against one of the toughest teams in the league and had the lead for the majority of the first three quarters before finally running out of steam.
- » Smith owned a 135-53 record in his previous stops at Dean and William Peace before coming to Lenoir-Rhyne. This is Smith's eighth season as a head coach in his career.

LATE DEBUT

» Heading into their season-opener, Lenoir-Rhyne was one of just three teams in the South Atlantic Conference who had yet to play a game. The opener on December 5 was the latest the team started a season in team history.

RUNNIN' WITH TEN

» Due to roster issues and injuries, Lenoir-Rhyne has been playing with just 10 active players for the majority of the season. Recently, the Bears welcomed back junior Alyssa Wagner to the rotation but lost a pair of players to injury over the break.


