### » RECAP

**HICKORY, N.C. -** The Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team advanced to the Super Region 2 Final for the second straight season with a 49-21 thumping of Carson-Newman on Saturday afternoon. The Bears started hot, scoring the first 28 points of the game and finished strongly by scoring 21 straight to close it out. The Bears move to 8-1 all-time in home NCAA Playoff games and broke the program record for longest home winning streak at 15. The previous record of 14 stood since 1961.

#### STATS OF THE GAME:

- The Bears forced a three-and-out on Carson-Newman's opening possession. On the ensuing punt, Preston Joseph broke through to record one of his two blocked punts on the game which Tre Luttrell scooped and returned 10 yards to put the Bears on top. For LR, it was the second straight week with a punt block returned for a touchdown with Luttrell finding the end zone both times.
- Tre Luttrell score was one of four first quarter touchdowns for LR. Drake Starks caught a pair of touchdowns from Grayson Willingham and Ameen Stevens closed out the quarter with a 30-yard touchdown run.
- Carson-Newman was resilient, storming back with an opportunistic second quarter. Taking advantage of two LR turnovers, the Eagles scored three times to cut the LR lead to 28-21. Derrick Evans ran in a 1-yarder and Braxton Westfield hauled in a pair of touchdown passes. Westfield was unstoppable, finishing with 10 catches for 139 and two touchdowns and had a pair of touchdowns called back due to penalty.
- It was all Bears the rest of the way with Stevens recording three second half touchdowns. The sophomore RB finished with 128 yards for a second straight playoff game and added two catches for seven yards. The four TDs in a game are a career high for the Savannah, Ga. native who has 17 touchdowns on the year and 28 in 26 career games.
- The defense held Carson-Newman to 117 yards

rushing and just 2.4 yards per carry. The Eagles did account for 200 yards passing and outgained LR 317-291. However, CN turned the ball over twice on downs and lost four fumbles to go with having two punts blocked and allowing six sacks. On top of that, the visitors were flagged for 15 penalties accounting for 144 yards with two players being ejected.

- Freshman WR Deondre Lester finished with a career-high 38 yards receiving on three catches. QB Grayson Willingham went 11-for-17 for 104 yards with a pair of TD strikes and one interception.
- Jaquan Artis registered eight tackles, 2.5 sacks and 1.5 tackles for loss and a forced fumble to continue a standout senior season. On the year, the DE from Kingston, N.C. and SAC Defensive Player of the Year has 23 TFL and 14.5 sacks.
- Quentin Hayes added 1.5 sacks to go with a forced fumble and Sherrod Williams tallied seven tackles and a tackle for loss.

#### BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- The 13 wins matches the program record for most wins in a season.
- This was the most points scored by the Bears in an NCAA Playoff game. The previous high was 43 against Florida Tech in 2018.
- Lenoir-Rhyne improves to 25-2 over the past two seasons under head coach Drew Cronin. In that stretch, LR is outscoring opponents 1124-526.
- Lenoir-Rhyne is now 8-4 all-time in the NCAA Playoffs. All five of the Bears NCAA appearances have come since 2012.
- This is the third Regional Final appearance in team history. The Bears earned the right to host the Regional Final for the second time ever thanks to a last-second upset of top-seeded Valdosta St. by West Florida.
- The Bears have won eight of the last nine matchups against Carson-Newman and are 2-1 against the Eagles in the NCAA Playoffs.
- In the first meeting, LR jumped out to a 16-0 lead over Carson-Newman and outscored the Eagles 44-0 in the first quarter of their two matchups this season.
- The win assures LR two straight seasons without a loss to a conference foe. The Bears own a 17-0 mark against league rivals since the start of 2018.



## » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### HELLO, NEWMAN

» Looking to break a two-game road losing streak, the Bears head to Jefferson City, Tenn. to take on rival Carson-Newman. This is the first meeting between the two longtime SAC rivals since 2019 when they met twice, both Bear victories at Moretz Stadium. The latter of the two wins was in the second round of the NCAA playoffs.

» The last meeting between these two, the aforementioned NCAA Playoff matchup on November 30, 2019, was one to remember. The Bears jumped out to a 28-0 lead after the first quarter, blocking two punts in the opening frame, including one for a touchdown. C-N then scored 21 unanswered in the second quarter to make it 28-21 at halftime, and then the Bears shut out the Eagles in the second half, scoring the final 21 points to secure a 49-21 win in the 2nd round playoff matchup. There were 8 combined turnovers in the game, 7 of them lost fumbles.

» The Bears have won three straight against C-N and eight of the last nine. The Eagles lead the overall series 44-19. LR has also won three straight on the road at Carson-Newman. The last Eagle win at home over the Bears was 2012, a year when C-N beat LR in the playoffs in addition to the regular season.

### ABOUT THE EAGLES

» Carson-Newman is 0-5 this season, the first time they've started with five straight losses since 1959. That year, they won their week six game against Appalachian State. The Eagles have played the 9th toughest schedule in Division II so far this season.

» The Eagles are led by second-year head coach Mike Clowney. Clowney is a 1997

graduate of C-N and spent 15 seasons as an assistant in the Eagle program in three different stints before taking over as head coach in January of 2020.

» Carson-Newman has struggled mightily on offense this year. Their 206 total yards per game ranks last in the SAC, exactly 100 yards per game behind 8th-place Limestone. They have only scored 12.2 points per game this year, and are minus-15 in turnover margin, which is second worst in the country.

» C-N has two of the top three tacklers in the SAC, linebacker Alonzo Houston leads the league with 10.8 stops/game, and Rondrow Peebles is third with 10 tackles/game.

### STU-DUDLEY PERFORMANCE

» C-N is coming off a 33-27 home loss to Catawba in which they turned the ball over four times. The Eagles scored three special teams touchdowns in the game, including two 100-yard kickoff returns by DeQuan Dudley. Dudley won National Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his efforts, and his 41.6 yards per return ranks 2nd in the nation. C-N scored their third special teams touchdown on a blocked punt.

### FAST STARTS FOR THE BEARS

» Prior to the Tusculum game, the Bears had scored first in all four of their games. LR had the first possession against TU but fumbled deep in Tusculum territory after a promising start to the drive. Opponents have scored first in all five of Carson-Newman's games this year.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### RECORDS IN SIGHT FOR QB1

» QB Grayson Willingham is just 25 passing yards shy of becoming the all-time leader in career passing yards at Lenoir-Rhyne. Willingham trails Brian Bryson (6,583 career yards) for the first spot, a mark that he has held since finishing his career in 1987.

» With his 11 completions on Saturday, Willingham moved into second place in program history with 439 career completions. Willingham sits 70 away from breaking the Willingham needs just five completions to all-time mark of career completions, also owned by Bryson.

» Additionally, Willingham is 83 yards away from breaking Bryson's career record for total offense. Bryson finished with 6,645 total yards while Willingham is at 6,563.

#### MONSTER MCGEE

» Freshman RB Dwayne McGee is the first player in the history of Lenoir-Rhyne football to have seven 100-yard rushing games in his first nine contests. So far this season, McGee averages 153.8 yards per game and his seven 100-yard rushing games is tied for the seventh most in a career during the NCAA Era.

» McGee ranks 4th in the nation in rushing yards per game (154.4), eighth in rushing touchdowns (8) and 14th in yards per carry (6.66).

#### O-LINE SHAKEUP

» For the first time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne had to shuffle its offensive line. Ryan Frans

and Shane Wells garnered their first career starts for the Bears in a 38-31 win over Tusculum.

» In fact, it was the first time since the end of 2019 that LR had to deviate from its normal starting five on the o-line. Xavier Jennings, Bryce Heidinger, Blake Jefferson, Isaac Chapman and Ian Brinson had started eight straight as a unit prior to Saturday.

#### DAVIS STEPS UP

» Getting his first career start, RB Jadus Davis finished the Tusculum game with six carries for a career-high 65 yards. Davis had to overcome a fumble on his third carry of the day which came one play after a career-best run of 33 yards.

#### THIRD EFFICIENCY

» Lenoir-Rhyne went into the Tusculum game ranked 11th in the nation in third down conversion percentage but the Pioneers held LR to just 6-of-16 to drop LR to 23rd in the nation.

» The Bears convert at a 48.8 percent clip.

#### THE TRENCES

» When it comes to running the ball and stopping the run, few are better than the Bears. LR ranks 23rd in the nation in rushing offense (202.6 yards per game) and place 29th in the nation in stopping the run (102.2 yards per game allowed).

» Safety Jimmy Palmer III grabbed his third interception of the season against Tusculum, returning it 29 yards and setting the Bears up in Pioneer territory in the 2nd half. Palmer is 2nd in the SAC and 15th nationally with his three takeaways.

### HOUSTON, WE HAVE A PROBLEM

» Graduate DT Amari Houston racked up a season-high 11 tackles against Tusculum, eight of which were solo tackles. He also had 1.5 tackles-for-loss and a sack, and earned SAC Defensive Player of the Week honors. Houston, a captain and native of Hillcrest, S.C., was also named the team's Ronnie Lott Heavy Hitter of the Week.

### GET OFF THE FIELD

» The Bears are only allowing opponents to convert 3rd downs 30% of the time this year, good for 2nd in the SAC and 27th in the nation. Opponents are also only 5-16 on 4th down against the Bears which is 3rd in the SAC and 25th in the country.

### TOUGH SLEDDING

» The Bears are 3rd in the SAC and 29th in the country in rush defense, and have only allowed one 100-yard rusher this year (Newberry's Mario Anderson). The last time an opposing rusher ran for more than 100 yards at Moretz Stadium was Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans in 2017.

### D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

» Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne has a 15-1 record when the defense scores a touchdown in a game.  
» The last defensive TD in a game came on a Preston Joseph fumble recovery against Wingate in a 44-21 blowout win on April 2, 2021.

### BLANDING BREAKOUT

» In his first time seeing significant action for the Bears, R-So DB T.J. Blanding had 9 tackles, good for second on the team. The sophomore from Blythwood, S.C. saw action in two games for the Bears in the spring, and this was his first action of the 2021 season.

### YOUNG CONSISTENCY

» For the second week in a row, senior Donte Young matched his career-high with eight tackles against Tusculum. Young also had 1.5 sacks for a combined loss of 16 yards, and a QB Hurry. A native of Weeki Wachee, Fla., Young transferred to LR from UTEP and is seeing more consistent time in the defensive rotation.

## » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 48 straight games and multiple sacks in 30 of their last 34 games.

In the 48-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 144 sacks.

## » LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

### RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » With his second made extra point, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 131 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

### ONE MORE RECORD

- » Allbaugh hit his record-breaking 49th field goal in LR's win over Tusculum on Saturday. Allbaugh now owns the South Atlantic Conference record for most career field goals.

### PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.

### SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.

» Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

### RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.

### FAIR CATCHES

- » The Bears special teams unit didn't register a single tackle against UVA Wise because the Cavaliers fair caught every LR kick.
- » The unit did force a turnover when the Wise punter bobbled the snap deep in their own territory and Jakobe Lane made the tackle to set up the Bear offense.

### BE LIKE MIKE

- » Senior punter Michael Owen had the best game of his season on Saturday. Owen had three punts inside the 20 and two punts of 50+ yards.
