#### » RECAP

GAFFNEY, S.C. – Junior QB Grayson Willingham broke the Lenoir-Rhyne all-time record for most career touchdown passes as the Bears survived an upset bid in a 28-20 victory at Limestone on Saturday afternoon. Willingham needed just one TD to break the record of 39 set by Brian Bryson in 1987 and finished with a trio of touchdown passes on the day.

#### STATS OF THE GAME:

 Coming into the game, the Bears had only trailed for nine minutes of game action all season. However, the Bears never led until the 9:39 mark on the third quarter in this one. Limestone connected on a 57-yard TD pass just 44 seconds into the game.

 Jaquay Mitchell capped off the Bears longest drive on the season to tie the game at seven. Mitchell's three-yard plunge completed a 14play, 75-yard drive that took five minutes.

However, the Saints would answer to start the second quarter as D.J. Phillips hit Juwan Scott for another touchdown pass, this one spanning 49 yards. LC would add a field goal before Willingham's record-breaking strike. With 1:29 left in the half, Willingham hit Drake Starks for an 18-yard touchdown. However, the Bears would go into the half trailing for the first time all season.

 Willingham hit Ryan Carter (37 yards) and Dareke Young (41 yards) to give LR a 28-17 advantage in the fourth quarter. The Saints would cut it to a one possession game with a 29-yard field goal with 6:23 to go but a pair of fourth down stops from the LR defense gave the Bears their 18th straight regular season victory.

 Willingham finished the day with 211 yards on 12-of-23 passing and three touchdowns to go with one interception. Mitchell had 149 yards on 19 carries and added a pair of catches for 23 yards.

 Dareke Young erupted for a career-high 120 yards on seven catches. This marks the second time on the season that LR featured a 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game.

 Phillips finished with 244 yards and a pair of touchdowns for the Saints and Scott had six grabs for 154 yards. On the ground, the Saints Jerko'ya Patton had 12 carries for 147 yards and is the first individual to run for more than 100 yards on the Bears since the last game of the 2017 season -- a span of 21 games.

Once again, DE Jaquan Artis was unblockable. The senior registered 10 tackles, three tackles for loss, two sacks and a forced fumble. Artis has now recorded at least 0.5 sack in every game this season and has 10 on the year. Dan Louba added a pair of sacks and Sherrod Williams had an interception.

#### **BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:**

- This is the first regular season game decided by single-digits since a 30-22 LR victory over Fort Valley St. on Oct. 20, 2018. LR had won 10 straight regular season games by double figures prior to today.
- The Bears tied a season-high with six sacks. LR also had six sacks in a season-opening win over St. Augustine's.
- The 23 attempts from Willingham is a seasonhigh.

# » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### **WELCOME HOME**

- » Looking to win their 3rd straight, LR comes back Between the Bricks for Homecoming 2021 against Limestone. This is the 80th homecoming football game in school history. The Bears trounced rival Carson-Newman 59-0 last week, and have put themselves back in the middle of the SAC Championship picture.
- » This is only the sixth all-time meeting between the Bears and Saints, and LR leads the all-time series 5-1. Limestone joined the SAC fully in 2020, but were football members in 2019. The last meeting between the two was 2019, when the Bears earned a hardfought 28-20 win in Gaffney, S.C. en route to an undefeated regular season and SAC Championship.
- » The last time the two met in Hickory was also homecoming in 2018. The Bears smoked the Saints 63-17 that day.
- » Limestone's only win in the series came at Moretz Stadium in 2016, a 31-13 victory.

#### **RECORDS SHATTERED**

- » Last week's 59-0 thumping of Carson-Newman saw the Bears break multiple records. Quarterback Grayson Willingham became the all-time leading passer in program history with his 359 yards passing (also his career-high for a game), breaking Brian Bryson's mark of 6,583 yards that stood since 1987.
- » Dwayne McGee ran for 200 yards and five touchdowns, tying the school record for most rushing touchdowns in a game. McGee was named SAC Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts.
- » The Bears finished with 750 total yards, the most total yards by a team in Division II this season. Also, the 40 first downs are a SAC record for one game.
- » This was the most yards Carson-Newman has ever allowed, and the most yards per play the Eagles ever allowed. The 59 points scored

were the second-most by an opposing team at C-N.

#### LAST TIME THEY MET

- » The aforementioned 2019 game with Limestone was another record-breaker for Willingham. In that game, the junior QB at the time broke Bryson's school record of 39 career touchdown passes. Willingham threw for three scores that day.
- » LR trailed the entire first half, and then took the lead for good at the 9:39 mark of the 3rd quarter. Limestone had a 57-yard TD pass just 44 seconds into the game to start their upset bid, but Willingham touchdown passes to Ryan Carter and Dareke Young in the second half propelled the Bears to an eight point road win.

#### **SAINTS MARCHING IN**

- » Limestone is winless on the year, and they have also had two games canceled due to opponents having COVID issues. The Saints' non-conference game with St. Augustine's in early September got canceled, as did their game with Catawba on Oct. 2.
- » The Saints are coming off a 32-3 loss to Mars Hill where they saw their first two quarterbacks on the depth chart go down with injuries. They were also competitive with Wingate (35-17), and lost a close game to Tusculum (24-21).
- » Limestone has struggled mightily on offense this year, averaging only 271 yards per game. That number is second worst in the SAC to Carson-Newman.
- » LU is led by third-year Head Coach Brian Turk. Turk was named head coach after the 2018 season, a promotion from offensive coordinator/QB coach. He also served as interim head coach for the final two games of the 2018 season. Prior to coming to Limestone, Turk was the QB coach for Steve Spurrier at South Carolina, and then was retained as assistant director of recruiting on Will Muschamp's staff for the Gamecocks.

#### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### **RECORD-BREAKING QB**

- » QB Grayson Willingham broke the Lenoir-Rhyne record for most career passing yards in Saturday's blowout of Carson-Newman. On his TD strike to Kelin Parsons, Willingham became the leader in passing yards and set a career-high with 359 yards passing against the Eagles.
- » With his 28 completions on Saturday, Willingham has 467 career completions which is second all-time. Brian Bryson owns the career record for completions with 502, meaning Willingham is just 36 away from that record as well.
- » Additionally, Willingham broke Bryson's career record for total offense. Bryson finished with 6,645 total yards and Willingham now sits a 6,928 total yards.
- » Willingham can also set the mark for most career 200-yard passing yard games in the NCAA Era (1993-current). Willingham and Brett Meunier each have 15 career 200-yard passing games

#### **MONSTER MCGEE**

- » Dwayne McGee joined Harold Bullard and Leonard Davis as the only three players in Lenoir-Rhyne history to have five rushing touchdowns in a game. Additionally, McGee was the only back to ever run for five TDs against a Carson-Newman defense.
- » McGee ranks fifth in Division II in rushing touchdowns (13) despite having one less game played thanks to a week two bye. McGee is fourth in the nation in rushing yards (972) and eighth in yards per carry (7.20).

#### **RECORD DAY**

- » In the Bears 59-0 win over Carson-Newman, numerous records fell. LR's 40 first downs was a new South Atlantic Conference record.
- » The 750 total yards were the most by a Division II team this season. Also, that yardage total was the most ever given up by a Carson-Newman defense and the mot yards per play ever allowed by the Eagles.
- » The 59 points scored were the second-most by an opposing team at Burke-Tarr Stadium.
- » The 59-point victory was the largest win by the Bears in the history of the head-to-head matchup.

#### **LEADERS OF THE SAC**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne paces the South Atlantic Conference with 487.2 yards per game, nearly 74 yards per game more than secondplace Tusculum.
- » LR also leads the league in first downs per game at 25.5, 2.5 more than second-place Wingate.

#### **CAREER DAY FOR KELIN**

- » For the first time in his young career, WR Kelin Parsons recorded a 100-yard game. The RS-Freshman had five grabs for 101 yards against the Eagles, including a 40-yard touchdown reception.
- » Parsons is the third different player (Dareke Young, Deondre Lester) to reach 100 yards receiving in a single game for the Bears this season.

#### **SACK STREAK REACHES 49**

» The Bears continued their record-breaking sack streak against C-N. Amari Houston, the reigning Ronnie Lott Heavy Hitter Award Winner, had a sack and four different Bears had half a sack. LR will try to extend the streak to an even 50 games on Homecoming against Limestone.

#### **BIG OL' GOOSE EGG**

- » Against the Eagles, The Bears recorded their first shutout since they blanked Brevard in 2015. They also handed Carson-Newman their first shutout since 1992, the thirdlongest streak in DII history.
- » Carson-Newman only had 156 yards of offense on Saturday, the second lowest total LR has allowed this year. Virginia State only had 148 yards of offense in the season opener.

#### **TOUGH SLEDDING**

- » LR only allowed 71 rushing yards against C-N and has moved into the top 20 nationally in rushing defense, allowing 97.0 yards per game. That is also good for second in the SAC behind Mars Hill.
- » The Bears haven't allowed a 100-yard rusher in Moretz Stadium since November of 2017.

#### **3RD DOWN D**

» Carson-Newman was 1 for 13 on 3rd down on Saturday. On the season, the Bears are only allowing opponents to convert 26% on 3rd down, 1st in the SAC and 9th in the nation.

#### **ANOTHER PICK FOR J.P.**

» Jimmy Palmer III grabbed his fourth interception of the season against Carson-Newman, picking off a pass in the end zone to preserve the Bears shutout. Palmer's four picks is good for 12th in the nation and 2nd in the SAC, one INT behind UVA Wise's Markel Dailey.

#### **HOUSTON IS A BIG PROBLEM**

» For the second week in a row, DT Amari Houston was named the team's Ronnie Lott Heavy Hitter of the Week. Houston led the Bears in tackles at C-N with eight, including 3.0 tackles-for-loss and a sack. Houston is 4th in the SAC in tackles-for-loss this season with 7.5, one behind teammate Dan Louba.

#### **GEORGIA BOYS**

- » Senior LB Preston Joseph is 5th in the SAC in tackles per game with 7. He also has 1.5 tackles-for-loss. Joseph is a native of Brunswick, Ga.
- » Freshman LB Jon Ross Maye returned from injury against C-N with a solid six-tackle performance. Maye is from Johns Creek, Ga.

#### D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

- » Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne has a 15-1 record when the defense scores a touchdown in the game.
- » The last defensive TD in a game came on a Preston Joseph fumble recovery against Wingate in a 44-21 blowout win on April 2, 2021.

#### **RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH**

- » With his second made extra point against Tusculum, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 131 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

#### ONE MORE RECORD

» Allbaugh hit his record-breaking 49th field goal in LR's win over Tusculum on Saturday. Allbaugh now owns the South Atlantic Conference record for most career field goals.

#### **PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES**

» In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS**

» Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.

» Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

#### **RETURN STREAK**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
