#### **RECAP**

WINGATE, N.C. – The Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team dominated Wingate in a 44-21 victory on Friday night. The Bears held Wingate to -43 rushing yards on the game and closed out the regular season undefeated.

#### INSIDE THE MATCHUP:

#### STATS OF THE GAME:

- Lenoir-Rhyne held Wingate to zero first downs in the first half and -32 total yards as they built a 30-0 lead going into the break.

  • After a pair of Chase Allbaugh field goals to
- open the scoring, a strip sack by Quentin Hayes was scooped by Preston Joseph and returned five yards for the first touchdown of the game.
- Grayson Willingham hit Deondre Lester for a 34-yard touchdown on the Bears next possession and then scrambled for a 9-yard TD
- to put LR up 27.

   After a Chris Brown interception and return, Allbaugh buried his third field goal of the half as
- Dareke Young scored his first TD of the season and Dwayne McGee found the end zone for the Bears in the second half.
- Willingham went 16-for-30 for 288 yards and a pair of touchdowns and McGee finished with 94 yards on 30 carries.
- Lester had four catches for 77 yards and Ryan Carter went for 72 yards on four grabs.
- Lenoir-Rhyne had five sacks and two interceptions and recovered a pair of fumbles on the game.

#### **BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:**

- With another sack today, Lenoir-Rhyne extends its streak with at least one sack to 42 straight
- Lenoir-Rhyne has won four straight head-tohead against Wingate and owns a 23-13 lead in the all-time series.
- LR is 11-7 in games at Wingate.
- The Bears have now won 20 straight games against South Atlantic Conference opponents.

# » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### THE BIG ONE

» Looking to win their 4th straight, Lenoir-Rhyne hits the road again to face off against rival Wingate. The Bulldogs have only one loss and are ranked No. 16 in the nation. The two teams have played every year since 1986 (other than 2020, when the game got postponed to the spring).

» LR leads the all-time series 23-13 and has won four straight, including the last two at Irwin Belk Stadium in Wingate. LR holds the longest winning streak in the series with 11 straight victories from 1986 to 1997.

» This is the Bears' second straight trip to Wingate They took down the Bulldogs 44-21 in the spring season and haven't lost at Wingate since 2016.

#### RECORD-BREAKING STRETCH

» In LR's last two wins over Carson-Newman and Limestone, the Bears have outscored the opponents 104-3. The three points allowed in the past two games are the fewest points allowed in a two-game stretch since 1962, when the Bears posted back-to-back shutouts.

» After 174 yards and two rushing touchdowns against Limestone, Dwayne McGee won his second straight SAC Offensive Player of the Week. He is 4th in the nation in rushing yards with 1,146 in only seven games, and the three backs ahead of him on the list have all played eight games.

#### **RECENT HISTORY**

Catawba

» Prior to the 44-21 win over Wingate in the spring, each of the Bears' previous three wins over the Bulldogs came by one score. In that spring game, LR jumped out to a 30-0 lead at halftime before the Bulldogs scored two late touchdowns in the fourth quarter to make it closer. In the first half of that game, Wingate did not register a first down and had -32 total yards. LR also scored a defensive touchdown in the game when Preston Joseph picked up a fumble forced by Quentin Hayes.

» In that win, Grayson Willingham threw for 288 yards and two touchdowns, and also ran for a score. Dwayne McGee ran for 94 yards and a touchdown as well. That game was the last game McGee failed to reach 100 yards rushing.

#### **ABOUT THE BULLDOGS**

» Wingate is 6-1 on the season and 4-0 in SAC conference play, the only undefeated team in the conference. Their lone loss came out of conference play to Barton 26-20 in overtime on Oct. 16. The Bulldogs bounced back last week with a 48-21 thumping of UVA Wise on the road. Linebacker Jaquan Edwards and placekicker McLean Robertson were named SAC Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week respectively. Edwards had 10 tackles and an interception against Wise, and Robertson made all seven of his kicks - two field goals and five extra points.

» Wingate is led by fourth-year starting QB Shaw Crocker. The junior from Greenville, S.C. redshirted his first year in 2017, and has been the starting QB since the 2018 season. He is completing 63% of his passes for 1558 yards and 16 TD, including four TD passes against UVA Wise.

» Head coach Joe Reich is coaching his 21st season at Wingate. He has compiled a record of 137-84, and is the all-time winningest coach in Bulldog history. Reich is 11-10 against Lenoir-Rhyne as the Wingate head coach, including 0-1 in the NCAA Playoffs (2018 "Miracle at Moretz" game). Reich's brother Frank is the head coach of the Indianapolis Colts.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### **RECORD-BREAKING QB**

- » QB Grayson Willingham owns the program record for most passing yards, most touchdown passes and most total yards. He also owns the record for most 200-yard passing games with his 16th last week against Limestone.
- » With his 19 completions on Saturday, Willingham has 486 career completions which is second all-time. Brian Bryson owns the career record for completions with 502, meaning Willingham is just 17 away from that record as well.

#### **MONSTER MCGEE**

- » Dwayne McGee joined Harold Bullard and Leonard Davis as the only three players in Lenoir-Rhyne history to have five rushing touchdowns in a game when he did so against Carson-Newman. Additionally, McGee was the only back to ever run for five TDs against a Carson-Newman defense.
- » McGee ranks fifth in Division II in all purpose yards per game (170.0), and fifth in rushing touchdowns (15). McGee comes in at No. 4 in rushing yards and third in rushing yards per game.
- » His 15 rushing touchdowns this year is tied for 8th in program history and is seven shy from an LR record.

#### **MOVING THE STICKS**

Lenoir-Rhyne ranks eighth in Division
 II in third down conversion percentage,
 converting at a 52.3 percent clip. Against
 Limestone on Saturday, LR converted 8-of-13

on third down.

#### **RUSHING OFFENSE**

- $\,^{\rm w}$  Lenoir-Rhyne is 10th in the nation in rushing offense, averaging 238.9 yards per game.
- » The Bears are no stranger near the top of the NCAA rushing rankings as they led Division II for three straight years from 2013-15 and also led DII on the ground in 2010.

#### **PUT IT ON THE BOARD**

» LR ranks fifth in the nation in total offense at 492.1 yards per game and the 38.6 points per game ranks 14th.

#### **LEADERS OF THE SAC**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne paces the South Atlantic Conference with 492.1 yards per game, nearly 70 yards per game more than secondplace Mars Hill.
- » LR also leads the league in first downs per game at 26.0, 3 more than second-place Wingate.

#### **POUND THE ROCK**

- » LR has ran at least 40 rushing plays in four of seven games this year, led by a 47-rush game against Carson-Newman.
- » Wingate actually runs more than the Bears, rushing 301 times in seven games compared to LR's 275 rushes.

#### **HALF-CENTURY MARK**

» Lenoir-Rhyne's record-breaking sack streak has reached an even 50 games after the Homecoming win over Limestone. The Bears had four sacks against the Saints to keep the streak alive.

#### 1.5 PPG

- » In the last two games, LR has given up a combined three points, the lowest total in a two-game stretch since 1962, when the Bears recorded four shutouts in five games.
- » Last week, Limestone rushed for -12 yards, the first time the Bears have held an opponent to negative rushing yards since the last meeting with Wingate, when the Bulldogs rushed for -43 yards in the game.

#### **BRICK WALL**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has one of the best rushing defenses in the nation, and has been steadily moving up the national charts throughout the year. LR is allowing 81.4 rushing yards per game, which ranks 9th in the nation and second in the SAC behind Mars Hill, who the Bears themselves rushed for 164 yards against.
- » LR has only allowed four 100-yard rushers since 2017, and only one running back has eclipsed the century mark against the Bears this season (Newberry's Mario Anderson).

#### **CLUTCH D**

» In the two wins over Carson-Newman and Limestone, the Bears held the Eagles and Saints to a combined 5 for 28 on 3rd down. For the season, LR is only allowing allowing opponents to convert 26.7% on 3rd down, 1st in the SAC and 9th in the nation.

» The Bears have been even better on 4th down this year, only allowing opponents to convert 22% of the time (5 for 22), which is 3rd in the SAC and 7th in the country.

#### **D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD**

- » Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne is 16-1 when the defense scores a touchdown in the game. LR added to that record last week against Limestone as Preston Joseph had a scoop and score early in the 2nd half to put the game out of reach.
- » Joseph has the last two defensive scores for the Bears, and before the Limestone game, the most recent one was another scoop and score for the Brunswick, Ga. native against Wingate in the spring.

#### **HOUSTON IS A BIG PROBLEM**

- » For the 3rd week in a row, NT Amari Houston was named LR's defensive player of the week. He shared the honor with Joseph for the Limestone game after leading the team with seven tackles, 4.0 tackles-for-loss and two sacks for a loss of 15 yards.
- » Houston is first in the SAC and 18th in the nation in tackles-for-loss with 11.5, and ranks 3rd in the SAC and 42nd in the country with 5.5 sacks.

#### **TURNOVERS GALORE**

» The Bears have a +6 turnover margin on the year, which is 2nd in the SAC and 29th in the country. The Bears have picked off six passes and recovered nine fumbles this season.

#### » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 50 straight games and multiple sacks in 32 of their last 36 games.

In the 50-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 151 sacks.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

#### **RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH**

- » With his second made extra point against Tusculum, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 140 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

### **ONE MORE RECORD**

 Allbaugh hit his record-breaking 49th field goal in LR's win over Tusculum on Oct.
 Allbaugh now owns the South Atlantic Conference record for most career field goals.

### **PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES**

» In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.

#### **BLANDING BLOCK**

» For the first time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne blocked a field goal as TJ Blanding got his hand on a Limestone field goal attempt in Saturday's 45-3 victory.

### **SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS**

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

#### **RETURN STREAK**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.

#### **BE LIKE MIKE**

- » Senior punter Michael Owen had the best game of his season against Tusculum two weeks ago. Owen had three punts inside the 20 and two punts of 50+ yards.
