RECAP

HICKORY, N.C. - A late comeback attempt fell short as Lenoir-Rhyne lost to a South Atlantic Conference opponent for the first time in 20 games on Saturday, falling to Tusculum in the SAC Championship. The Bears had two possessions inside Tusculum's 35-yard line in the fourth quarter but couldn't capitalize in a 5-point loss.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP:

STATS OF THE GAME:

- QB Grayson Willingham threw for a careerhigh 353 yards and three touchdowns and moved into second place in program history in passing yards for his career.
- Willingham hit three different receivers for touchdowns, connecting with Dareke Young, Hakeem Meggett and Dwayne McGee.
- Young exploded for nine catches and 166 yards to go with his touchdown. The 166 yards is the most in a game since T.J. Smith had 142 against Tusculum in September of 2018 and ranks as the fourth-most receiving yards in a game during the NCAA Era.
- Tusculum's Rogan Wells threw for 438 yards, including 287 in the first half.
- The Pioneers had a pair of 100-yard receivers on the day as Tory Ponder had seven grabs for

123 yards and Justice Parham had six catches for 114 yards.

- · The Pioneers put up 28 points in the span of 17:31 of game action but the LR defense would hold the powerful TU offense scoreless for the final 28:03 of the game.
- Down 28-14, the Bears answered with a 32-yard field goal and then an 11-yard TD pass on the first play of the fourth quarter to cut the lead to 28-23 after a two-point conversion failed.
- · The Bears had a turnover inside the five with 7:51 to play and Tusculum marched all the way to the LR 12 with 1:50 to play. However, a Percy King interception and return to the LR 45 gave the Bears a chance to score and win the game.
- LR drove to the Tusculum 31 but a fourth and 10 pass fell incomplete and gave the Pioneers the 2020-21 SAC Championship.

BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- · Willingham's 355 yards were the fifth-most in a game in the 101 years of Lenoir-Rhyne Football.
- Young's 166 yards receiving is the 10th-best total in a single game in LR Football history.
- LR had an eight-game winning streak over Tusculum coming into today.
- The Bears had a chance to complete the 3-peat with a win today.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SECOND TIME IN '21

- » For the second time in 2021, Tusculum travels to Moretz Stadium to take on the Bears. The Pioneers came to Hickory on April 10 in the Spring season SAC Championship game and took down LR 28-23.
- » Grayson Willingham threw for a careerhigh 353 yards in the loss to Tusculum in the spring.
- » Prior to that game, the Bears had won eight straight and ten of the last eleven in the series. Before the spring season, the last Tusculum win over LR came in 2011 by one point in Greeneville, Tenn.

OUT OF TOP 25

» For the first time in 23 weeks, LR is not ranked in this week's AFCA Poll. The streak of 23 weeks in a row being ranked was the second longest in program history.

ABOUT THE PIONEERS

- » Tusculum leads the SAC in points per game (34.8). Wide receiver Justice Parham is 3rd in the SAC in receiving yards per game (81.6), and 2nd in receiving touchdowns (4). He had a six-game touchdown streak broken at Wingate, but still hauled in six passes for 94 yards in the loss.
- » Quarterback Ivan Corbin is 5th in the SAC with 210.4 passing yards per game and has six passing touchdowns. The graduate student transferred to Tusculum from Georgia Southern, and before GSU, he started for two years at SAC rival Limestone.
- » Tusculum running back Maurice Gomillion needs 157 career rushing yards to become the 13th pioneer to reach 1,000 career yards.

» With the loss at Wingate, Tusculum head coach Jerry Odom is now 17-17 in SAC Conference games as the Pioneer head coach. He is 1-4 against Lenoir-Rhyne, with the lone win coming in the spring season.

HEARTBREAK IN THRILLING FASHION

- » Tusculum came very close to taking down undefeated Wingate on the road last week. Down two points in the waning seconds of the game, the Pioneers drove the ball down to the Bulldog 18-yard line. On the game's final play, Tusculum threw a pick-six and Wingate held on to win 43-35. Prior to that game, the Pioneers had a four-game road winning streak.
- » All three of Tusculum's losses have come in very close fashion. In addition to the Wingate game, the Pioneers lost 46-38 in double overtime to Chowan, and also fell 24-19 to Newberry. The Pioneers also defeated Limestone 24-21 in another close game.

- » Saturday will mark the 1,017th game in the history of Lenoir-Rhyne Football. The 1,000th game came at Tusculum in 2019.
- » The Bears are in search of the 523rd alltime victory in program history and the 139th SAC win.

AFTER AN 'L'

» For just the 38th time since 2010, the Bears will be coming off a loss heading into Saturday. LR is 2-0 so far this season after a loss and 23-14 since the start of the 2010 campaign.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

RECORDS IN SIGHT FOR QB1

- » QB Grayson Willingham is just 147 passing yards shy of becoming the all-time leader in career passing yards at Lenoir-Rhyne. Willingham trails Brian Bryson (6,583 career yards) for the first spot, a mark that he has held since finishing his career in 1987.
- » Willingham needs just five completions to pass Brett Meunier for second place in career completions. Willingham has 428 career completions and is 81 away from breaking the all-time mark of career completions, also owned by Bryson.
- » Additionally, Willingham is 221 yards away from breaking Bryson's career record for total offense. Bryson finished with 6,645 total yards while Willingham is at 6,425.

DEONDRE GOES OFF

- » In last weeks loss at UVA Wise, sophomore WR Deondre Lester finished the game with 14 catches for 122 yards.
- » The 14 grabs were the second-most in a single game in program history, trailing only Terrence Steward who had 18 catches in a game back in 1986.
- » The 14-grab game gave Lester 60 career receptions in just 22 career games played. He already has a career-high with 329 yards receiving.
- » Lester is 11th in the nation, and first in the league, in receptions per game at 7.5

DEEWEE

» Freshman RB Dwayne McGee has topped 100 yards rushing in all four LR games this season and has hit the century mark in six of eight career games.

» McGee is ninth in the nation in rushing yards with 584 and his 6.71 yards per carry ranks 15th in the nation.

FAST STARTS

» Lenoir-Rhyne has scored first in all four games this season and have scored touchdowns on their first possession of the game twice this year. In total, LR has scored on their first drive in three of their first four games.

THIRD EFFICIENCY

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 11th in Division II in third down conversion percentage, converting at a 51.5 percent clip.

WILLINGHAM CAN TIE ANOTHER MARK

» After throwing for 282 yards against UVA, Grayson Willingham topped 200 yards passing for the 14th time in his career. The only player in LR history to have more 200 yard passing games than Willingham is Brett Meunier who had 15.

FRESHMAN STEPS UP

- » True freshman RB Jadus Davis saw his role expand in the Bears loss at UVA Wise Saturday. Davis had 78 total yards on just seven touches against the Cavs.
- $\,$ » Davis finished with five carries for 27 yards and two grabs for 51 yards.

» LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

SACK STREAK REACHES 47

» The Bears continue to live in opposing backfields, extending the sack streak to 47 consecutive games at UVA Wise. Quentin Hayes was the man that extended the streak on Saturday with an eight yard sack.

E-JACK ATTACK

» With his 13th career interception at UVA Wise, senior safety Eric Jackson is now tied for 7th in school history in picks. He also added a 25-yard return after Saturday's interception.

LOUBA ON A MISSION

- » After picking up a school-record four sacks in the win over Mars Hill and being named SAC and National Defensive Player of the Week, Dan Louba followed that performance up with a 7 tackle, 2.0 TFL game at UVA Wise.
- » Louba hurt his foot in the spring season and did not play in the SAC Championship Game against Tusculum. So far this season, the graduate student from Harrisburg, N.C. has 14 tackles, 7.5 TFL and 4 sacks.

BRICK CURTAIN

- » The Bears are third in the SAC and 29th in the country in rushing defense, and have only allowed one 100-yard rusher this season (Newberry's Mario Anderson), and only three 100-yard rushers in the last 35 games.
- » The last time an opposing rusher ran for more than 100 yards at Moretz Stadium was November 4, 2017 when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran for 108 yards on 18 carries.

CAREER-BEST PERFORMANCES

- » Middle linebacker Preston Joseph had a career-high 13 tackles against UVA Wise last Saturday, including 10 solo tackles. His previous career-high was eight tackles, which he achieved in each of the previous two games against Newberry and Mars Hill.
- » In the spring SAC Championship Game against Tusculum, Joseph recorded his only career sack.
- » Senior Donte Young also matched his career-high in tackles against UVA Wise, racking up eight stops. He also had eight tackles one time before in 2019 in the season opener against St. Augustine's.
- » Freshman Andre Jefferson finished with six tackles on Saturday, one stop short of his career high. The new starter at defensive end also had a tackle-for-loss.

D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

- » Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne has a 15-1 record when the defense scores a touchdown in a game.
- » The last defensive TD in a game came on a Preston Joseph fumble recovery against Wingate in a 44-21 blowout win on April 2, 2021.

MAKINS GETS THE NOD

- » CB KJ Makins earned his first career start on Saturday at UVA Wise, replacing Chris Brown at corner.
- » Makins finished with a pair of solo tackles on the game and had a pass breakup.

» SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 47 straight games and multiple sacks in 29 of their last 33 games.

In the 47-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 141 sacks.

RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 126 straight extra points which is just two shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record in those games.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

RETURN STREAK

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.

FAIR CATCHES

- » The Bears special teams unit didn't register a single tackle against UVA Wise because the Cavaliers fair caught every LR kick.
- » The unit did force a turnover when the Wise punter bobbled the snap deep in their own territory and Jakobe Lane made the tackle to set up the Bear offense.
