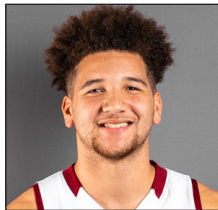

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SEASON 101

» Saturday's exhibition game at Tennessee will mark the beginning of the 101st season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but was shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.

» The Bears are just one win shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .553 in the first 100 years of basketball. The 1,399 all-time wins ranks 29th in all of NCAA Division II.

» 63 of the first 100 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 9-7 and made it to the SAC Tournament semifinals before falling to Queens.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

» After losing 80% of their scoring from last season, the Bears had to completely reshape its roster. LR was picked 9th in the preseason SAC poll, and the Bears brought in five new transfers for the 2021-22 season.

» Lenoir-Rhyne will have to replace double-digit scorers in Darius Simmons (18.6 ppg) and R.J. Gunn (16.6 ppg). Both players graduated after the 2020-21 season and were 1,000 point scorers in their four seasons with the Bears. LR also lost last season's SAC Defensive Player of the Year Davion Bradford to graduation.

HISTORIC WIN

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the weekend in search of win number 1,400 in program history. The Bears have averaged 14 wins per year in the first 100 seasons of the program.

SAC/PEACH BELT CHALLENGE

» This is the third straight season (excluding 2020-21) that LR has matched up with Emmanuel and Young Harris. The Bears are 4-0 all-time in the first two years of the conference crossover.

» LR actually took on Young Harris in current head coach Jeremy Currier's debut with the Mountain Lions back in November of 2018.

TRANSFER TEA

» Lenoir-Rhyne has five new transfers on the roster this season, including three from the Division I level. PJ Joseph and Kevin Kanju both came to Hickory from Oakland University (Mich.) of the Horizon League, and Malik LeGania came from Coastal Carolina. TJ Nesmith is from Cape Fear Community College, and Jalen Johnson returns to Hickory after a two-year stint at Brunswick Community College. Johnson started his collegiate career at LR back in 2018-19 before leaving following that season.

NEW SHU SMELL

» 2021-22 marks the 66th season inside Shuford Memorial Gymnasium for the Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball program. This season, a brand new floor has been installed and the lighting has been updated as part of Phase 1 of the LR Campaign.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

» Phase 2 of the Campaign will take place after the 2021-22 school year. Shuford Gymnasium will be getting new bleachers and a new video board that will be ready for the 2022-23 season, in addition to the new floor that has been added for this year.

LAST YEAR

» The 2020-21 season was a roller coaster for the Bears. Due to the pandemic, the SAC played a conference-only schedule that started in December. LR started the year 7-2, with wins over No. 2 Lincoln Memorial, No. 12 Queens, and a buzzer-beating victory over rival Wingate.

» The Bears sputtered to the finish line in the regular season, dropping four of their last five. Lenoir-Rhyne did qualify for the SAC Conference Tournament, and traveled to Newberry for the first round, taking an 81-70 win over the Wolves to move onto the semifinal round, where they fell to top-seeded Queens 88-67.

THEY'RE BACK

» Despite losing over 80% of the scoring from last year's team, Lenoir-Rhyne does have two large contributors back this season. 6-11 center Cooper Fowler returns after starting 13 of the 14 games he appeared in last season, in addition to sophomore forward Tim Steele, who averaged just under 14 minutes per game. Both players shot over 40% from the floor last season.

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the season with 293 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in SAC history, over 15 wins ahead of the second place team since the SAC was formed in 1989-90.

PROTECT THE ROCK

» Last year, LR was second in the SAC in turnovers per game, averaging only 11.9 giveaways per game. That number was second only to Newberry's 11.4 turnovers per game.

THE CHARITY STRIPE

» The Bears were also 4th in the SAC last year in free throw percentage, shooting 73.8%. That number was only 1.2 percentage points behind second place Lincoln Memorial. The Bears also attempted the fourth fewest amount of free throws in the league last season.

DROPPING DIMES

» The Bears were also 4th in the SAC last season in assists per game with 14.9. The team's assist to turnover ratio was +3.0.

REBOUNDING STRUGGLES

» With a guard-heavy lineup a year ago, the Bears struggled on the glass against some bigger teams. LR was 10th in the SAC in both rebounding and rebounding margin last season. With the new transfers, LR

LEAGUE LEADERS

» The Bears are second in SAC history with eight regular season conference championships, one behind Lincoln Memorial, who just won its 9th regular season title last season. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

SEASON OPENERS

» The Bears own a 66-34 all-time mark in season openers and have gone 6-4 in the last 10, including a 93-86 victory over Catawba last season. The Bears are second in SAC history with eight regular season conference championships, one behind Lincoln Memorial, who just won its 9th regular season title last season. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

» The Bears have two eight-game winning streaks in openers. Once in 1969-1976 and again from 2002-09.

» The most points scored in a season opening game is 112 in 1993 in a 112-97 victory over Concord.

» The most points allowed in an opener was 100 which happened twice. Once in 1965 (a 100-79 loss to Guilford) and again in 1992 (a 100-94 loss to High Point).

» LR's largest margin of victory in the first game of the season was 47 back in 1951 when they defeated Charleston Naval 81-34.

» The least points allowed in a season opening game was four in the first-ever LR game, a 16-4 win over Hickory Town in 1919.

» The largest margin of defeat in a season opener came in 1998 when the Bears lost by 35 (72-37) to Henderson State.
