» RECAP

SALISBURY, N.C. - The Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team scored the final 42 points of the game in a 49-3 thrashing of Catawba on Saturday afternoon. With the win, the Bears closed out the regular season unblemished and ran their South Atlantic Conference winning streak to 15 games. In addition, LR claimed back-to-back SAC Championships.

STATS OF THE GAME:

- Seven different players found the end zone for the Bears with five of those scores coming on the ground. On the day, LR ran for 300 yards and grinded out 57 rushing attempts.
- Grayson Willingham continued his efficient play, going 8-for-11 for 129 yards and two touchdowns. Over the past two games, Willingham has thrown 5 TDs and zero interceptions while going 20-for-27.
- Ameen Stevens led the Bears in rushing, finishing with 71 yards on 15 carries and his 12th rushing score of the year. Ryan Carter, Tre Luttrell, Joshua Stewart and Willingham all found the end zone on the ground.
- Drake Starks hauled in a 43-yard touchdown pass and Demarius Hampton had three catches

for 46 yards. Deondre Lester caught an 18-yard touchdown pass, his first career touchdown reception.

- Jaquan Artis had two tackles for loss and a sack on the day and Clayton Horn had a sack and a forced fumble. Javoris Smith and Yannis N'Guetta had interceptions for LR with N'Guetta recording a 35-yard return on his pick.
- The Bears allowed just eight first downs on the day and held Catawba to 44 yards rushing on 21 attempts. In the passing game, the Indians went just 15-for-26 for 130 yards. LR outgained Catawba 451-174.
- The Bears dominated time of possession, controlling the ball for 36 minutes.

BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- This was the 99th all-time meeting between the two programs which is the fifth most-played rivalry in all of Division II. The first game took place in 1907.
- The only other team to post back-to-back undefeated seasons in SAC play was Lenoir-Rhyne in 2013 and 2014. No other team in the league has been able to accomplish that feat since Carson-Newman did so in 1998 and 1999.
- Catawba finished winless in league play and ended the season on a nine-game losing streak.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

GAME 100

» Lenoir-Rhyne and Catawba will meet for the 100th time on Saturday afternoon Between the Bricks. The Bears and Indians have played in the final week of the regular season every year since 1973 other than the spring season when the game got canceled. Catawba leads the all-time series 49-46-4.

» Lenoir-Rhyne and Catawba have combined for nine outright SAC Championships and 16 total league titles including when they've shared with other teams. LR has won nine SAC titles since the league was formed in 1975, and Catawba has won seven.

» This rivalry is the sixth-most played rivalry game in Division II history. The last meeting was nearly two years ago on Nov. 16, 2019, a 49-3 LR victory. The Bears have won the last two and eight of the last 11 meetings in the series. The last two victories for LR over Catawba clinched outright SAC Championships for the Bears in both 2018 and 2019.

» Saturday is also senior day at Moretz Stadium. 25 seniors will be honored before the game for their time wearing the red and black.

» LR is ranked 9th in this week's NCAA Regional Rankings, and is still receiving votes in the AFCA Poll. The top seven make the NCAA Playoffs, with the number one overall seed receiving the first round bye.

DOMINATION

» In the five-game winning streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has outscored its opponents 229-60, winning by an average of 33.8 points per game. The last time the Bears had such a dominating stretch was the first five games of the 2019 season, when LR outscored the opponents by an average of 36 points per game.

» In the last four games, LR's defense has scored triple the amount of touchdowns (three) that they've given up (one), and the

defense has scored a touchdown in three consecutive games. The one TD the Bears allowed on defense last week was LR's second unit against Barton's first offense.

» Against Wingate two weeks ago, LR won their 13th game over a ranked opponent in the NCAA era, and the first since 2019.

NO LOSS NOVEMBER

» Since the 2018 season, Lenoir-Rhyne is 10-0 in the month of November, including both regular season and playoff games.

» In those games, LR's average margin of victory is 29 points.

DEFEND HOME TURF

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not lost a regular season home game since 2017, winning 14 straight games Between the Bricks.

» LR's last regular season home loss came on November 4, 2017 to Carson-Newman.

ABOUT CATAWBA

» The Indians are 5-3 overall and 2-3 in the SAC this season. They've had two games canceled due to Covid. They've lost three of their last four games, including falling 30-7 at home to UVA Wise last week. Their two SAC wins came over Carson-Newman (33-27) and Tusculum (31-28).

» Head coach Curtis Walker (Catawba '92) is in his 8th season at the helm. He was the 2015 SAC Coach of the Year when he led the Indians to a SAC Championship and NCAA Playoff berth. Prior to Catawba, he coached one year at Western Carolina and 10 years at Coastal Carolina, where he was the defensive coordinator and coached 44 All Big-South players.

» Walker holds a 3-5 record against Lenoir-Rhyne as the Catawba Head Coach, and all three wins came in a row from 2015 to 2017.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

RECORD-BREAKING QB

» QB Grayson Willingham owns the program record for most passing yards, most touchdown passes and most total yards.

He also owns the record for most 200-yard passing games with his 16th against Limestone.

» With a 47-yard touchdown strike to Deondre Lester against Wingate, Willingham broke the program record for most career completions.

» This season, Willingham has thrown for 18 touchdowns, which is 3rd in the SAC. His 238.6 yards per game is 2nd in the league, and he also has four games in which he's thrown for a 70% or better completion percentage. His 62.8% completion rate is good for 2nd in the SAC, and 27th in Division II.

MONSTER MCGEE

» Dwayne McGee joined Harold Bullard and Leonard Davis as the only three players in LR history to have five rushing touchdowns in a game when he did so against Carson-Newman.

» McGee ran for 152 yards last week against Barton, which is astonishingly only his fifth best rushing output of the season. He also failed to score a rushing touchdown against Barton for the first time all season, but did find paydirt through the air on a swing pass from Willingham.

» McGee's 1,391 rushing yards this season are the third-most in a single season in program history. McGee is only 27 yards behind second place Chris Robinson, and is 168 yards away from breaking Leonard Davis' record of 1,559 rushing yards in the 1994 season. The 1,391 yards rushing is first in the SAC and fifth in the nation, and McGee has played one fewer game than everyone ahead of him on the list.

» His 17 rushing touchdowns this year are tied for 3rd in program history and is five shy of the LR single-season record.

» McGee's 161.2 all-purpose yards per game is 1st in the SAC and 5th in the nation. McGee's 6.99 yards per carry is 6th in the nation.

SUPPORTING CAST

» With NFL Draft Prospect Dareke Young out due to injury, several Bears have picked up the slack in the receiving game. Deondre Lester, Ryan Carter and Kelin Parsons have combined for 1,364 yards and 11 receiving touchdowns, led by Lester's 590 yards and 6 TD. Lester has caught a touchdown pass in four consecutive games.

» Carter and Parsons have nearly identical numbers this year, Carter has 33 catches for 392 yards and 2 TD, while Parsons has 36 grabs for 382 yards and 3 TD. In total, 16 different Bears have caught a pass this year.

RUSHING OFFENSE

» Lenoir-Rhyne is 8th in the nation in rushing offense, averaging 243.7 yards per game.

» The Bears are no stranger near the top of the NCAA rushing rankings as they led Division II for three straight years from 2013-15 and also led DII on the ground in 2010.

MOVE THE STICKS

» After going 8 for 12 on 3rd down at Barton, Lenoir-Rhyne raised their season 3rd down percentage to a 51.5% conversion rate, which is 1st in the SAC and 9th in Division II.

» LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

SACK STREAK REACHES 52

» After three more sacks against Barton, Lenoir-Rhyne's record-breaking sack streak has reached 52 games. The Bears have 156 sacks during the streak, which averages exactly three per game.

» Andre Jefferson and Willie Lane both had sacks in the Barton game, and Jon Ross Maye and Preston Joseph each contributed a half sack.

5.5 PPG

» In the previous four wins, the LR defense has given up a combined 5.5 points per game - 0 against C-N, 3 against Limestone, 6 against Wingate and 13 against Barton. That is the fewest amount of points allowed in a four-game stretch since 1962 when the Bears had 3 shutouts in 4 games.

BRICK WALL

» Lenoir-Rhyne has one of the best rushing defenses in the conference, allowing 95.8 yards per game on the ground, which is also good for 22nd nationally. Barton RB Jordan Terrell - who was 2nd in the nation in rushing going into the game - was held to 107 yards, 54 of which came against LR's second defense.

CLUTCH D

» After holding Barton to a 35% 3rd down conversion rate last week, Lenoir-Rhyne continued to solidify themselves as one of the nation's best on the money down.

» In the past four games, Lenoir-Rhyne has held opponents to a 24% 3rd down conversion rate, while converting over 50% themselves. For the season, the Bears are only allowing a 27% conversion rate, good for 12th in the nation and first in the SAC.

» The Bears have been even better on 4th down this year. Opponents have converted 5 out of 23 on 4th down this season, and that

21% rate is 2nd in the SAC and 6th in the nation.

D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

» Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne is 18-1 when the defense scores a touchdown in the game. LR has scored a defensive touchdown in three straight games, and the defense has scored three fewer points (18) than they've given up (21) in that stretch.

» Preston Joseph had a scoop and score against Limestone, Jon Ross Maye had an epic pick-six against Wingate where he stole the ball out of the QB's hands, and Percy King had an 80-yard pick six against Barton. King jumped an out-route and ran down the Bear sideline for the TD.

TURNOVERS GALORE

» After Percy King's pick-six at Barton, Lenoir-Rhyne's turnover margin sits at +7 on the season, which is tied for tied in the SAC (with Catawba) and 29th in the nation. The Bears have nine interceptions and nine fumble recoveries in the 2021 season.

» Catawba's turnover margin is also +7 on the year. The Indians have also taken the ball away 18 times this season.

DOUBLE DIGITS FOR J.R.

» Fresh off winning SAC Defensive Player of the Week after the Wingate game, LB Jon Ross Maye continued his hot streak, racking up 11 tackles, 2.5 tackles-for-loss and half a sack against Barton. The Johns Creek, Ga. native also had the key pressure on the Barton quarterback that led to Percy King's pick-six.

» SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 52 straight games and multiple sacks in 34 of their last 38 games.

In the 52-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 156 sacks.

» LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » With his second made extra point against Tusculum, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 144 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

ONE MORE RECORD

- » Allbaugh hit his record-breaking 49th field goal in LR's win over Tusculum on Oct. 9. Allbaugh now owns the South Atlantic Conference record for most career field goals.

HARDWARE FOR 'DRE

- » In addition to catching a touchdown pass, WR Deondre Lester won SAC Special Teams Player of the Week after averaging 30.3 yards per kick return against Barton, including a season-long 51-yard return.
- » This was the 2nd time an LR player won SAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors, Allbaugh won the award after he broke the DII consecutive extra point record against Tusculum.

PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.

BLANDING BLOCK

- » For the first time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne blocked a field goal as TJ Blanding got his hand on a Limestone field goal attempt in Saturday's 45-3 victory.

SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
- » The Bears did allow a 94-yard kickoff return touchdown to Barton's Jacquez Durham last Saturday.

BE LIKE MIKE

- » Senior punter Michael Owen had the best game of his season against Tusculum. Owen had three punts inside the 20 and two punts of 50+ yards.
- » Against Barton, Owen was only called upon to punt twice, and he averaged 42 yards per kick, pinning Barton down inside their 10-yard line once.
