» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

DO OR DIE

» For the third straight year, the Lenoir-Rhyne Bears have earned a spot in the postseason. This is the sixth trip to the NCAA Playoffs in program history, all coming since 2012.

» LR owns an 8-5 all-time mark in NCAA Playoff games but this will be the first time LR has had to travel for a First Round game.

» LR has played eight of their 11 playoff games at home in program history.

FIRST BATTLE

» Lenoir-Rhyne and Bowie State have never met.

» In the 2019 playoffs, Bowie State lost to SAC foe Carson-Newman in the First Round with the Bears then handing Carson-Newman a 49-21 loss in Hickory the following weekend.

RIDING THE WAVE

» Lenoir-Rhyne has won six straight contests and completely dominated their past five foes. After narrowly beating Tusculum 38-31 on Oct. 9, the Bears have beaten their next five opponents by a combined score of 247-32.

» LR has dropped 56 points in back-to-back games and have allowed opponents to score in single digits in four of the past five matchups.

» In the last five games, LR's defense has scored triple the amount of touchdowns (three) that they've given up (one), but the defense saw its streak of consecutive games with a TD end at three.

» The Bears are in the top fifteen nationally in both scoring offense (41.3 ppg - 9th) and scoring defense (14.9 ppg, - 14th). They are one of two teams in Division II to be in the top 15 in both categories with Colorado School of Mines being the other.

NO LOSS NOVEMBER

» Since the 2018 season, Lenoir-Rhyne is 11-0 in the month of November, including both regular season and playoff games.

ABOUT BOWIE STATE

» The Bulldogs won the CIAA for the 3rd consecutive season beating Fayetteville State 17-7 in the championship game last Saturday, while LR finished 2nd in the SAC to fellow playoff qualifier Newberry, who will travel to West Florida on Saturday.

» The Bulldogs own a 10-1 mark on the season and have only lost to Delaware St. in a one possession contest.

» The Bulldogs have rattled off 10 straight wins since that set back, led by a strong defensive unit. Bowie St. allows just 13.1 points per game and permits opponents to rush for just 91.4 yards per game.

» This is the 4th consecutive year Bowie State has made the playoffs. They've hosted a first round game each of the previous three trips to playoffs, going 1-2 in those games.

» Bowie State's 3rd down defense is tops in the nation allowing opponents to convert just 22.9 percent of the time.

» Bowie State's seven defensive touchdowns on the season are the most by any team.

» The Bulldogs only allow 125.6 passing yards per game, a figure that ranks fourth in Division II.

» No team in the nation has more team tackles for loss than BSU's 10.3 per game.

» Jonathan Ross is second in the nation in forced fumbles and third in the land in tackles for loss.

» Head Coach Damon Wilson is in his 11th year at the helm of the Bowie State program. He has led the Bulldogs to all three of their CIAA Championships in school history (2018, 2019, 2021). He is in his second stint on the coaching staff at Bowie State; he served as Assistant Head Coach and Running Backs Coach from 1999-2003 and was an All-Conference tight end for the Bulldogs as a player in 1998.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

PASSING RECORDS FALLING

- » QB Grayson Willingham owns most of the LR individual and career passing records but the team is set to break some records this weekend.
- » LR needs 30 pass attempts to break the record of 374 which was set in 2001.
- » The 2,416 passing yards this season ranks fifth but just 155 away from breaking the program record which was set in 2018.
- » LR broke the mark for most completions in a season against Catawba. The mark of 216 was set in 2002 but the Bears are up to 220 this year.

MONSTER MCGEE

- » Dwayne McGee became the first LR player since 1994 to be named the SAC Offensive Player of the Year.
- » McGee was also named the conference's Offensive Freshman of the Year.
- » With 206 yards rushing against Catawba, McGee broke the single-season mark for rushing yards which stood since 1994. McGee sits at 1,594 rushing yards.
- » With one more touchdown, McGee will break the program record for touchdowns in season. Leonard Davis scored 21 total touchdowns in 1993.

O-LINE ACCOLADES

- » Lenoir-Rhyne had three offensive linemen named to the SAC All-Conference team led by center Blake Jefferson earning a First Team selection.
- » OT Ian Brinson and OG Bryce Heidinger were named to the Second Team All-Conference.
- » Brinson has started every game since the start of the 2018 season, running his streak to 42 straight games. He will start his 43rd straight on Saturday.

YOUNG PLAYMAKERS

- » McGee isn't the only underclassmen making an impact in LR's offense. Sophomore Deondre Lester (2nd Team All-Conf.) leads LR with 53 grabs for 669 yards and six touchdowns.
- » Freshman Kelin Parsons is second with 42 catches for 459 yards and four touchdowns.
- » True freshman RB Jadus Davis has 415 yards rushing and five touchdowns spelling McGee and found the end zone three times against Barton.
- » OT Xavier Jennings has started every game since arriving on campus last year.

RUSHING OFFENSE

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is 7th in the nation in rushing offense, averaging 251.4 yards per game.
- » McGee ranks fourth in the nation in rushing yards per game and third in the nation in total rushing yards.
- » The Bears are no stranger near the top of the NCAA rushing rankings as they led Division II for three straight years from 2013-15 and also led DII on the ground in 2010.

MOVE THE STICKS

- » Lenoir-Rhyne ranks fifth in the nation as a team on third downs. The Bears convert 54.7 percent of their third downs.

PLAYOFF HIGHS

- » The single game rushing record in a playoff game is 175 by Josh Justice in 2013.
- » Grayson Willingham has the mark for most passing yards in a playoff game with 247 against Florida Tech in 2018.
- » Jaquay Mitchell's 103 yard receiving against Florida Tech in that same game is the most in a playoff game.

» LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

SACK STREAK REACHES 52

» After two more sacks against Catawba, Lenoir-Rhyne's record-breaking sack streak has reached 53 games. The Bears have 158 sacks during the streak, averaging just under three sacks per game.

» The streak started back on Nov. 12, 2016 against Catawba. In last week's game against Catawba, Dan Louba and Josh Davis picked up sacks to extend the streak.

5.0 PPG

» In the previous five wins, the LR defense has given up a combined 5.0 points per game - 0 against C-N, 3 against Limestone, 6 against Wingate, 13 against Barton and 3 against Catawba. That is the fewest number of points in a stretch of games since the program had five shutouts in a span of six games in 1962.

STOP THE RUN

» Lenoir-Rhyne finished the regular season with the second best run defense in the SAC and the 21st best rushing defense in the country, allowing 96.9 yards on the ground per game.

» In 10 games, the Bears allowed two 100-yard rushers this season.

CLUTCH D

» After holding Catawba to 3 for 13 on 3rd down last Saturday, Lenoir-Rhyne continued to solidify themselves as one of the nation's best at getting off the field on 3rd down.

» In the past five games, the Bears held opponents to under 20% conversion rate, while converting over 60% themselves.

» The Bears led the SAC in 3rd down conversion defense by a wide margin, and finished the regular season 8th in the nation in the category (27.5%).

» LR has been even better on 4th down this year. During the regular season, opponents

converted only 5 for 25 on 4th down this year. The 20% success rate was 8th in Division II. Catawba went 0 for 2 on 4th down in the regular season finale.

D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

» Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne is 18-1 when the defense scores a touchdown in the game. LR has scored a defensive touchdown in three straight games, and the defense has scored three fewer points (18) than they've given up (21) in that stretch.

» Preston Joseph had a scoop and score against Limestone, Jon Ross Maye had an epic pick-six against Wingate where he stole the ball out of the QB's hands, and Percy King had an 80-yard pick six against Barton. King jumped an out-route and ran down the Bear sideline for the TD.

TAKE IT AWAY

» After forcing four turnovers against Catawba, LR finished the regular season with a +10 turnover margin, which was tops in the SAC and 13th in Division II. The Bears intercepted 11 passes and recovered seven fumbles during the regular season.

» Bowie State's turnover margin was +6 on the season. The Bulldogs turned the ball over 21 times during the regular season.

TEAM LEADERS

» Preston Joseph leads the Bears in total tackles with 61, and Jon Ross Maye leads LR in tackles per game with just over seven.

» Dan Louba had 6.5 sacks to lead Lenoir-Rhyne and tie for 3rd in the SAC. Amari Houston had 13.5 tackles-for-loss to pace the Bears, and Jimmy Palmer led the team in interceptions with four. Eric Jackson led the team in pass breakups with seven.

» SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 53 straight games and multiple sacks in 35 of their last 39 games.

In the 53-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 158 sacks.

» LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » With his second made extra point against Tusculum, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 160 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

ONE MORE RECORD

- » Allbaugh hit his record-breaking 49th field goal in LR's win over Tusculum on Oct. 9. Allbaugh now owns the South Atlantic Conference record for most career field goals.

HARDWARE FOR RC

- » Ryan Carter was named Second Team All-Conference in the return specialist category.
- » Carter averages 24.6 yards per kickoff return and 10.4 yards per punt return.
- » He broke a 40-yard punt return this season.
- » On kick return, Deondre Lester has broke a pair of kickoffs.
- » Against Barton, Lester returned on 51 yards and followed that up with a 62-yard return against Catawba.

PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre

Luttrell.

BLANDING BLOCK

- » For the first time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne blocked a field goal as TJ Blanding got his hand on a Limestone field goal attempt in Saturday's 45-3 victory.

SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
- » The Bears did allow a 94-yard kickoff return touchdown to Barton's Jacques Durham last Saturday.

BE LIKE MIKE

- » Senior punter Michael Owen had the best game of his season against Tusculum. Owen had three punts inside the 20 and two punts of 50+ yards.
- » Against Barton, Owen was only called upon to punt twice, and he averaged 42 yards per kick, pinning Barton down inside their 10-yard line once.
