### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### **SEASON 101**

- » This is the 101st season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but was shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » 63 of the first 100 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 9-7 and made it to the SAC Tournament semifinals before falling to Queens.

### **HISTORIC WIN**

- » In a 94-86 win over Young Harris, the program notched the 1,400th win in program history.
- » Only 29 other NCAA Division II programs have reached that accolade in their history.

### **PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS**

- » After losing 80% of their scoring from last season, the Bears had to completely reshape its roster. LR was picked 9th in the preseason SAC poll, and the Bears brought in five new transfers for the 2021-22 season.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne will have to replace doubledigit scorers in Darius Simmons (18.6 ppg) and R.J. Gunn (16.6 ppg). Both players graduated after the 2020-21 season and were 1,000 point scorers in their four seasons with the Bears. LR also lost last season's SAC Defensive Player of the Year Davion Bradford to graduation.

### **SAC START FOR LMC**

- » This is the third straight South Atlantic Conference opponent for Lees-McRae.
- » The Bobcats lost 108-75 to Carson-Newman in the season opener but rebounded to defeat UVA Wise 80-52 last Sunday.
- » Lees-McRae will also play Mars Hill later in the season.

### **SIMILAR STORIES**

- » Both the Bobcats and Bears had similar seasons in 2020-21. Each team started off really well but a late season COVID shutdown halted momentum.
- » The Bears went 2-5 in their final seven games after a late season shutdown while the Bobcats, who only were able to play 12 games all season, went 1-6 down the stretch.

### **TRANSFER TEA**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has five new transfers on the roster this season, including three from the Division I level. PJ Joseph and Kevin Kanju both came to Hickory from Oakland University (Mich.) of the Horizon League, and Malik LeGania came from Coastal Carolina. TJ Nesmith is from Cape Fear Community College, and Jalen Johnson returns to Hickory after a two-year stint at Brunswick Community College. Johnson started his collegiate career at LR back in 2018-19 before leaving following that season.

# » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

### **NEW SHU SMELL**

- » 2021-22 marks the 66th season inside Shuford Memorial Gymnasium for the Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball program. This season, a brand new floor has been installed and the lighting has been updated as part of Phase 1 of the LR Campaign.
- » Phase 2 of the Campaign will take place after the 2021-22 school year. Shuford Gymnasium will be getting new bleachers and a new video board that will be ready for the 2022-23 season, in addition to the new floor that has been added for this year.

### **HOME OPENER**

- » The Bears played at home on Wednesday night and survived a Wingate comeback to hang on for a 75-70 win.
- » The Bears were up as many as 14 with 14:34 left in the game but Wingate charged back and cut the deficit to 1.
- » A couple of late 3-pointers from Kevin Kangu and Tyson McClain sealed the victory for LR.
- » Kangu finished with 20 points in the victory and Jalen Johnson added 16 points. Cooper Fowler had 10 for LR and Nas Tyson grabbed a career-high eight boards.

### **THEY'RE BACK**

» Despite losing over 80% of the scoring from last year's team, Lenoir-Rhyne does have two large contributors back this season. 6-11 center Cooper Fowler returns after starting 13 of the 14 games he appeared in last season, in addition to sophomore forward Tim Steele, who averaged just under 14 minutes per game. Both players shot over 40% from the floor last season.

### **CHASING 300**

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the season with 294 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in SAC history, over 15 wins ahead of the second place team since the SAC was formed in 1989-90.

### PROTECT THE ROCK

» Last year, LR was second in the SAC in turnovers per game, averaging only 11.9 giveaways per game. That number was second only to Newberry's 11.4 turnovers per game.

### THE CHARITY STRIPE

» The Bears were also 4th in the SAC last year in free throw percentage, shooting 73.8%. That number was only 1.2 percentage points behind second place Lincoln Memorial. The Bears also attempted the fourth fewest amount of free throws in the league last season.

### **DROPPING DIMES**

» The Bears were also 4th in the SAC last season in assists per game with 14.9. The team's assist to turnover ratio was +3.0.

Salisbury, N.C. - The Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Basketball Team (1-1) suffered its first loss of the season Sunday afternoon to Lees-McRae (2-0), 74-64, on the final day of the Salisbury Roundball Classic at Goodman Gymnasium.

Lees-McRae's Darius Smith (Woodbridge, Va.) led all scorers with 26 points and was 15-of-17 from the free throw line in the victory.

The Bears were led by senior guard R.J. McClure (Canton, N.C.) with a team-high 18 points but was the lone player to score in double figures for Lenoir-Rhyne in the setback.

McClure's lay-up with 9:01 remaining in the contest cut Lees-McRae's lead to 48-45 but the Bobcats responded with a 20-6 run capped off by a Smith field goal to put the game away.

Mike Chambers (Winston-Salem, N.C.) added 15 points for the Bobcats, who connected on 34-of-43 free throw attempts (79 percent) in the victory.

The Bobcats also held a 36-24 advantage on the boards while senior guard Jarvis Perry (Willingboro, N.J.) added nine points for the Bears in the setback.

Lenoir-Rhyne next takes on Queens in its home and South Atlantic Conference opener on Wednesday, November 20, at 8:00 p.m., at Shuford Memorial Gymnasium. Lees-McRae, meanwhile, plays Brevard on the road Wednesday at 7:00 p.m.
