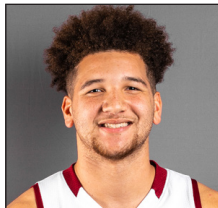

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SEASON 101

» This is the 101st season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but was shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.

» 63 of the first 100 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 9-7 and made it to the SAC Tournament semifinals before falling to Queens.

HISTORIC WIN

» In a 94-86 win over Young Harris, the program notched the 1,400th win in program history.

» Only 29 other NCAA Division II programs have reached that accolade in their history.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

» After losing 80% of their scoring from last season, the Bears had to completely reshape its roster. LR was picked 9th in the preseason SAC poll, and the Bears brought in five new transfers for the 2021-22 season.

» Lenoir-Rhyne will have to replace double-digit scorers in Darius Simmons (18.6 ppg) and R.J. Gunn (16.6 ppg). Both players graduated after the 2020-21 season and were 1,000 point scorers in their four seasons with the Bears. LR also lost last season's SAC Defensive Player of the Year Davion Bradford to graduation.

HANGING ON

» Lenoir-Rhyne led by as many as 11 in the second half on Tuesday night at Coker but the Cobras cut it to one with just over a minute to play.

» Jalen Johnson hit a clutch 3-pointer with 35 seconds to play and Johnson and Kangu went 4-for-4 from the line late to secure the victory.

LOOKING FOR 3-0 START

» The Bears haven't started 3-0 in league play since the 2007-08 season and have a chance to do just that on Saturday.

» Back in 2007-08, the Bears started 12-0 in league play before dropping the last two games of the regular season.

» The Bears have already defeated Wingate and Coker.

BUDDING RIVALRY

» This marks the first ever matchup between these two teams as conference foes. Limestone enters its second season as a member of the South Atlantic Conference after an extended run in Conference Carolinas. The teams were never able to get scheduled games in last year due to COVID shutdowns on each side.

TRAVEL TIME

» Limestone and Lenoir-Rhyne are separated by just 67 miles which is closer than any SAC opponent other than Queens (59 miles) and Catawba (55 miles).

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

NEW SHU SMELL

» 2021-22 marks the 66th season inside Shuford Memorial Gymnasium for the Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball program. This season, a brand new floor has been installed and the lighting has been updated as part of Phase 1 of the LR Campaign.

» Phase 2 of the Campaign will take place after the 2021-22 school year. Shuford Gymnasium will be getting new bleachers and a new video board that will be ready for the 2022-23 season, in addition to the new floor that has been added for this year.

ROAD WARRIORS EARLY

» Lenoir-Rhyne has played just two games at home so far this season and won't return to the confines of Shuford Gymnasium until December 15 when Anderson comes to town.

» The Bears are in the midst of a four game road swing (five if you include an exhibition game at East Tennessee St. on 12/4).

THEY'RE BACK

» Despite losing over 80% of the scoring from last year's team, Lenoir-Rhyne does have two large contributors back this season. 6-11 center Cooper Fowler returns after starting 13 of the 14 games he appeared in last season, in addition to sophomore forward Tim Steele, who averaged just under 14 minutes per game. Both players shot over 40% from the floor last season.

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the season with 295 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in SAC history, over 15 wins ahead of the second place team since the SAC was formed in 1989-90.

FROM DOWNTOWN

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 22nd in all of Division II in made 3-pointers per game. LR averages 11.2 makes from beyond the arc per game led by 16 made triples from point guard Jalen Johnson.

REBOUNDING STRUGGLES

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 266th in the nation -- out of 295 ranked teams -- in rebounds per game. LR pulls down just 31 boards per contest. That number ranks last in the South Atlantic Conference as well.

LEAGUE LEADERS

» The Bears are second in SAC history with eight regular season conference championships, one behind Lincoln Memorial, who just won its 9th regular season title last season. Catawba has six and Wingate has five.

NO FOULS

» Lenoir-Rhyne is 23rd in the nation in personal fouls per game. The Bears average just 13.5 fouls per contest, a figure that also is tops in the league.

NEW FIVE

- » For the first time this season, Everick Sullivan shuffled the starting five. The only starter that remained was C Cooper Fowler. Around the big man was four new starters including Damion Medwinter, Elijah Shabazz, Tyson McClain and Salle Wilson.
- » Medwinter, Shabazz and Wilson all earned their first career starts.
- » The starters only combined for seven points but the bench chipped in 60 points.

NAIL BITERS

- » The past three LR games have been decided by a combined 11 points with the last two being decided by three points each.

THE CHARITY STRIPE

- » The Bears were also 4th in the SAC last year in free throw percentage, shooting 73.8%. That number was only 1.2 percentage points behind second place Lincoln Memorial. The Bears also attempted the fourth fewest amount of free throws in the league last season.

PROTECT THE ROCK

- » Last year, LR was second in the SAC in turnovers per game, averaging only 11.9 giveaways per game. That number was second only to Newberry's 11.4 TO/gm.
