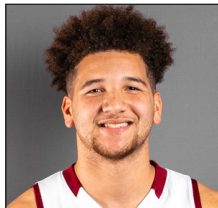

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SEASON 101

» This is the 101st season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The historic program began competition in 1919 but was shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.

» 63 of the first 100 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 9-7 and made it to the SAC Tournament semifinals before falling to Queens.

HISTORIC WIN

» In a 94-86 win over Young Harris, the program notched the 1,400th win in program history.

» Only 29 other NCAA Division II programs have reached that accolade in their history.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

» After losing 80% of their scoring from last season, the Bears had to completely reshape its roster. LR was picked 9th in the preseason SAC poll, and the Bears brought in five new transfers for the 2021-22 season.

» Lenoir-Rhyne will have to replace double-digit scorers in Darius Simmons (18.6 ppg) and R.J. Gunn (16.6 ppg). Both players graduated after the 2020-21 season and were 1,000 point scorers in their four seasons with the Bears. LR also lost last season's SAC Defensive Player of the Year Davion Bradford to graduation.

LAST TIME OUT

» After losing point guard Jalen Johnson to injury in the first half, Lenoir-Rhyne sputtered offensively and lost to Limestone 70-54 on the road on Saturday. Johnson hit a clutch 3-pointer late in the previous game against Coker to preserve that road win for the Bears.

» Against Limestone, Salle Wilson scored a career-high 16 points to pace the Bears.

» Nas Tyson (13 points) and Kevin Kangu (11 points) were also both in double figures for LR against the Saints.

» Johnson, Kangu and Tyson are all double-digit per game scorers for LR.

ABOUT THE EAGLES

» Wednesday's night's game between Lenoir-Rhyne and Carson-Newman is the 70th all-time meeting between the two longtime SAC rivals. LR leads the series 37-32.

» C-N has won the last two in the series, and LR had won the previous three meetings prior.

» This is the third meeting in a row that has taken place in Jefferson City. Last season, Carson-Newman defeated LR 73-54 behind 20 points from EJ Bush. On Feb 12, 2020, the Eagles grabbed a narrow 70-69 victory over the Bears on a putback from Bush with 0.6 seconds to go in the game.

» Last season, Carson-Newman went 16-6, winning the SAC Tournament and falling to Tusculum in the 1st round of the NCAA Tournament.

» The Eagles are 3-3 this year and 1-2 in the SAC, with losses to Queens and Tusculum and a win over Wingate on Saturday. Four

TAKE CARE OF THE ROCK

» After leading the SAC in fewest turnovers and assist to turnover ratio last season, Lenoir-Rhyne is off to a good start in those categories again this season.

» The Bears are third in the league in assist to turnover ratio behind Queens and Lincoln Memorial at 1.29.

» LR is also 2nd in the league in fewest turnovers, committing only 65 through six games.

REBOUNDING STRUGGLES

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 282nd in the nation -- out of 295 ranked teams -- in rebounds per game. LR pulls down just 30 boards per contest. That number ranks last in the South Atlantic Conference as well.

» Lenoir-Rhyne has been outrebounded in all six games this season and have been outrebounded in 18 of their past 22 games dating back to the start of the 2020-21 season.

ROAD WARRIORS EARLY

» Lenoir-Rhyne has played just two games at home so far this season and won't return to the confines of Shuford Gymnasium until December 15 when Anderson comes to town.

» The Bears are in the midst of a four game road swing (five if you include an exhibition game at East Tennessee St. on 12/4).

NO FOULS

» Lenoir-Rhyne is 13th in the nation in personal fouls per game. The Bears average just 13.5 fouls per contest, a figure that also is tops in the league.

STARTER SHUFFLE

» In the Coker game, Everick Sullivan shuffled the starting five for the first time this season. The only starter that remained was C Cooper Fowler. Around the big man was four new starters including Damion Medwinter, Elijah Shabazz, Tyson McClain and Salle Wilson.

» Medwinter, Shabazz and Wilson all earned their first career starts against Coker.

» In the Limestone game, Fowler, Johnson, Kangu, Tyson and Wilson got the start for the Bears.

CHASING 300

» Lenoir-Rhyne enters the season with 295 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in SAC history, over 15 wins ahead of the second place team since the SAC was formed in 1989-90.

FROM DOWNTOWN

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 22nd in all of Division II in 3-point field goal attempts at 178.

» The Bears are 35th in 3-pointers made after hitting a season-low five against Limestone on Saturday.
