### RECAP

HICKORY, N.C. – In the first home game since December 7, 2019, the Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team cruised past Barton in the first matchup between the two programs since 1950. The Bears extended their winning streak against SAC opponents to 19 straight and have won 23 straight regular season games.

### INSIDE THE MATCHUP:

### STATS OF THE GAME:

- Grayson Willingham threw for a career-high 309 yards, which is the 8th most yards in a single game in program history. Willingham finished the day 22-of-27 and added two touchdowns and no turnovers.
- After going for 160 yards on the ground in his debut, freshman RB Dwayne McGee toted the rock 29 times for 192 yards and scored three touchdowns.
- Deondre Lester finished the game with eight receptions for 144 yards and a touchdown.
- Lester's yardage total was the ninth highest in a single game in the NCAA Era.

   Jon Ross Maye had his second straight double-digit tackle game, finishing with 11 stops and three tackles for loss. Maye also added his first career sack.
- Percy King intercepted a pair of passes to give him three on the young season. The redshirt freshman had four tackles and one of his picks came in the end zone.
- Chase Allbaugh went 3-for-3 on field goals and hit all four of his extra points.

- · As a team, Lenoir-Rhyne finished with 511 yards of total offense with 310 coming through the air and 201 on the ground.
- The Bears were just 3-of-9 on third down conversions while Barton was 7-of-16 and went 2-of-2 on fourth down.
- After Barton's first touchdown of the game put them up 6-3, Lenoir-Rhyne outscored the Bulldogs 38-7 the rest of the way.

### **BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:**

- With another sack today, Lenoir-Rhyne extends its streak with at least one sack to 41 straight games.
- Lenoir-Rhyne has won 12 straight regular season games at Moretz Stadium.

- This is the third straight season LR has won its home opener and the Bears improve to 53-34-4 in home openers.

UP NEXT: LR will travel to Wingate after a bye week next week. The Bears and Bulldogs will tangle on Friday, April 2.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- » After beating Wingate 31-6, Lenoir-Rhyne hits the road again to Wilson, N.C. for a non-conference game with upstart Barton. The Bulldogs are in year two of their football program, and will be joining the SAC full-time in football starting in the 2022 season. This is the second straight year the Bears and Bulldogs are meeting.
- » In Barton's first year of football in the spring season, they traveled to Moretz Stadium and fell 44-13 to the Bears. That game marked the first home game and home win for Head Coach Mike Jacobs and the new LR coaching staff.
- » LR is receiving votes in the AFCA Poll for the first time since the UVA Wise loss on Oct. 2.

### **DOMINATION**

- » In LR's last three wins against Carson-Newman, Limestone and Wingate they've outscored the opponents 135-9. The nine points allowed in a 3-game stretch is the lowest since 1962, when the Bears recorded four shutouts in a five-game stretch, and in the one non-shutout, they only allowed six points.
- » LR's defense (12 points scored) has outscored the Bears' last three opponents combined.
- » Against Wingate, the Bears led 14-3 at halftime and scored the final 17 points of the game to get the statement win on the road at their rival. LR has now won five in a row against Wingate, and Grayson Willingham finished 5-0 as the Bear starting QB against the Bulldogs.
- » The Wingate win was LR's 13th win over a ranked opponent in the NCAA era and the first since defeating No. 25 Carson-Newman in the 2019 playoffs.

### **NO LOSS NOVEMBER**

» Since the 2018 season, Lenoir-Rhyne is

- 9-0 in the month of November, including both regular season and playoff games.
- » In those games, LR's average margin of victory is 24 points.

### **BEARS BEST BARTON**

- » In the first home game of the Mike Jacobs era of Lenoir-Rhyne football back on March 20, the Bears defeated Barton 44-13. In just his second career game, Dwayne McGee rushed for 192 yards.
- » Deondre Lester had the best game of his career that day, grabbing eights passes for 144 yards, the ninth highest single-game total in the NCAA era.
- » In that spring game, Grayson Willingham threw for 309 yards and two touchdowns, which was his career high at the time. His 81% completion percentage in that game is still his career high.
- » Percy King intercepted a pair of passes, Jon Ross Maye had a double-digit tackle day with 11 stops, and Chase Allbaugh hit all three of field goals and all four of his extra points.
- » Barton QB Jaquan Lynch threw for 242 yards, a touchdown and threw three interceptions in the loss for the Bulldogs.

### **ABOUT THE BULLDOGS**

- » In just their second season of football, Barton is 5-4 and has wins over SAC members Wingate (26-20 in OT) and Carson-Newman (31-17). They also lost to Mars Hill (40-32), Newberry (31-7), Tusculum (41-17) and Catawba (17-10). They finish the season up with a trip to UVA Wise next week.
- » Barton is led by head coach Chip Hester. Hester officially took over the program in 2018, and Barton was scheduled to play their first full season in the fall of 2020, and then the season was postponed until spring of 2021. Hester came to Wilson from North Carolina A&T State University, where he served the previous three seasons as the offensive coordinator.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

### **RECORD-BREAKING QB**

- » QB Grayson Willingham owns the program record for most passing yards, most touchdown passes and most total yards. He also owns the record for most 200-yard passing games with his 16th last week against Limestone.
- » With a 47-yard touchdown strike to Deondre Lester against Wingate, Willingham broke the program record for most career completions.

### **MONSTER MCGEE**

- » Dwayne McGee joined Harold Bullard and Leonard Davis as the only three players in Lenoir-Rhyne history to have five rushing touchdowns in a game when he did so against Carson-Newman. Additionally, McGee was the only back to ever run for five TDs against a Carson-Newman defense.
- » McGee ranks ninth in Division II in all purpose yards per game (160.6), and third in rushing touchdowns (17). McGee comes in at No. 5 in rushing yards and fourth in rushing yards per game.
- » His 17 rushing touchdowns this year are tied for 3rd in program history and is five shy from an LR record.
- » McGee's 1,239 rushing yards on the season are the eighth-most in a single season in program history. McGee needs 321 yards over the rest of the season to catch Leonard Davis' single-season mark of 1,559 set in 1994.

### **MOVING THE STICKS**

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks 13th in Division II in third down conversion percentage, converting at a 50 percent clip.

### **RUSHING OFFENSE**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is 9th in the nation in rushing offense, averaging 238.2 yards per game.
- » The Bears are no stranger near the top of the NCAA rushing rankings as they led Division II for three straight years from 2013-15 and also led DII on the ground in 2010.

### **PUT IT ON THE BOARD**

 $\,^{\rm w}$  LR ranks fifth in the nation in total offense at 486.2 yards per game and the 37.6 points per game ranks 18th.

### **LEADERS OF THE SAC**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne paces the South Atlantic Conference with 486.4 yards per game, 63 yards per game more than second-place Mars Hill.
- » LR also leads the league in first downs per game at 25.4, 3.4 more than second-place Wingate.

### **POUND THE ROCK**

» LR has ran at least 40 rushing plays in four of seven games this year, led by a 47-rush game against Carson-Newman.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### **SACK STREAK REACHES 51**

- » With three sacks against Wingate, Lenoir-Rhyne's record breaking sack streak has reached 51 games. The Bears have recorded 154 sacks in that stretch, which averages three per game.
- » Andre Jefferson led the Bears with two sacks for a combined loss of 13 yards against the Bulldogs.

### 3.0 PPG

» In the previous three wins, LR has given up a combined nine points, the fewest in a threegame stretch since 1962. In the previous two meetings with Wingate, the Bulldogs have averaged 35.5 yards rushing per game, and QB Shaw Crocker threw two interceptions on Saturday.

### **BRICK WALL**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has one of the best rushing defenses in the country, and has been steadily moving up the national charts throughout the year. Currently, the Bears are 13th in the nation in rushing defense, allowing 85.5 yards per game. That defense will be put to the test against Barton RB Jordan Terrell, who is 2nd in the nation in rushing yards and rushing yards per game.

### **CLUTCH D**

» In the last three games, Lenoir-Rhyne has held opponents to a 21% 3rd down conversion rate, while converting over 50% themselves. For the season, the Bears are only allowing a 27% conversion rate, good for 8th in the nation and first in the SAC. » The Bears have been even better on 4th down this year. Opponents have converted 4 out of 16 times on 4th down this season, and that 25% rate is 2nd in the SAC and 6th in the nation.

### **D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD**

» Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne is 17-1 when the defense scores a touchdown in the game. LR has scored a defensive touchdown in back-to-back games. Jon Ross Maye had an epic pick-six as he swiped the ball from Wingate's QB Crocker and took it to the house. In the Limestone game, Preston Joseph had a scoop and score right after halftime.

### HARDWARE FOR J.R

» After his pick-six against Wingate, LB Jon Ross Maye was named the SAC Defensive Player of the Week. It was the third time this year a Bear has earned that honor; Dan Louba and Amari Houston won the award in previous wins for LR.

### **TURNOVER CITY**

» After picking off two passes against Wingate, Lenoir-Rhyne's turnover margin grew to +8 on the season, which is 2nd in the SAC and 18th in the nation. The Bears have eight interceptions and nine fumble recoveries in the 2021 season.

### » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 51 straight games and multiple sacks in 33 of their last 37 games.

In the 51-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 154 sacks.

### RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » With his second made extra point against Tusculum, Chase Allbaugh put his name in the NCAA Division II record book for a second time.
- » Allbaugh, who already owns the record for most consecutive extra points made in a single season with 76, converted his 128th consecutive extra point to break Jack Ruggieri's record.
- » In total, Allbaugh has hit 144 straight extra points and hasn't missed since November 3, 2018 against this same Carson-Newman squad.
- » Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.

### **BLANDING BLOCK**

» For the first time this season, Lenoir-Rhyne blocked a field goal as TJ Blanding got his hand on a Limestone field goal attempt in Saturday's 45-3 victory.

### **SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS**

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears.
