» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just two wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

- » After seeing a four-game home winning streak come to an end against Anderson on Saturday, the Bears returned to the win column with a 71-65 victory over Mars Hill on Monday night.
- » Cooper Fowler had a game-high 18 points and added five blocks in the contest while shooting 6-of-10 from the field.
- » The five blocked shots by Fowler is the most in a game since Bertrand Awana had five rejections in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament against USC Aiken in March 2019.
- » After going 25-of-27 from the free throw line against Anderson on Saturday, the Bears hit 9-of-10 attempts from the charity stripe against the Lions.

BRADFORD TOPS THE LEAGUE

- » For the season, Davion Bradford is shooting 66.7 percent from the field, a figure which tops the entire South Atlantic Conference. The second place player is Xavier Bledson at 60.6 percent. No other player is above 58 percent from the field in the conference.
- » Over his past four games, Bradford has missed just three shots. Bradford is 17-for-20 from the floor, converting at a 85.0 percent clip.

TAKEAWAYS

- » Lenoir-Rhyne ranks first in the SAC in turnover margin, turnovers forced and turnovers per game.
- » The Bears are +5.1 turnovers per contest which ranks eighth in the nation.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne also ranks 18th in the land in assist:turnover ratio at 1.36.
- » The Bears 15.9 assists per game ranks them 27th in all of NCAA Division II.

UPSET SULLY

- » Of the 13 wins over ranked teams since 1989-90, head coach Everick Sullivan has engineered six of those upsets.
- » Four of the ranked wins have come over Queens including twice when the Royals were in the top 10 in the nation.
- » The win over #2 LMU was the highest ranked opponent Lenoir-Rhyne has ever beaten.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

CHASING MILESTONES

- » Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 293 all-time wins in South Atlantic Conference play. That number ranks as the most in the conference, more than 20 more than any other league foe since the SAC began in 1989-90.
- » The Bears are now just two wins shy of 1,400 as a program. Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 1,398-1,128 all-time record in the first 99 and-a-half years of hoops.

FIELD OF 13

- » For the first time in SAC history, 13 teams will advance to the conference tournament. The new format allows the top three seeds to earn a bye.
- » As of now, Lenoir-Rhyne is in third place in the league standings and in prime position for a bye but the criteria for conference seeding hasn't been released at this time.

NEW REGIONAL LAYOUT

- » Lincoln Memorial was selected as the host of the NCAA Southeast Regional last week. Additionally, the NCAA announced plans to host the winter championships.
- » With those announcements, the NCAA announced a new regional layout due to some conferences not playing basketball this winter.
- » The Southeast Region will now be made up of Conference Carolinas, South Atlantic Conference along with the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. However, the SIAC announced in December that they

won't be competing until March 1 which means that six teams from the SAC and Conference Carolinas will make up the NCAA Southeast Region in the Division II men's basketball tournament. five-point victory.

LAST TIME AGAINST WISE

- Back in January, Lenoir-Rhyne put a thumping on the Cavaliers, defeating them 98-63 on Jan. 13
- » The 35-point win was the largest margin of victory for the Bears this season and was their first 30-point win since 2018.
- » Darius Simmons topped the 1,000 career point mark against the Cavaliers and LR's 29 assists narrowly missed the program mark of 31 set back in 2000.

FOWLER FINDING FORM

- » After a slow start to the season, Cooper Fowler has been rounding into form as the season progressed.
- » The sophomore averaged just 1.0 points per game in December, a number that rose to 6.4 points per game in January.
- » So far in his two February games, Fowler is averaging 10.5 points and shooting 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from long range and hasn't missed from the free throw line.
- » Fowler is scoring 9.2 points per game at home but has yet to find the scoring column in any of his three road games this season.

- » Lenoir-Rhyne is a perfect 6-0 when leading going into the break.
- » They are 2-2 when trailing at the half, earning wins over Wingate and Queens.

BEATING THE SUPERPOWERS

- » Lincoln Memorial and Queens have been two of the best teams in the nation for the past handful of years.
- » However, in two of the past three seasons, Lenoir-Rhyne has defeated both teams in the same year.
- » The Bears own an 89-83 win over #2 Lincoln Memorial on Jan. 9 and a 71-66 win over #12/15 Queens on Jan. 18.
- » No other team in the South Atlantic Conference can make that same claim.

HEADING DOWN THE STRETCH

- » In the final eight days of the regular season, much is still to be determined in the conference standings.
- » The Bears currently sit in third place in the league with a half-game lead over Newberry. The Wolves are 7-3 in league play with each team owning a win over Lincoln Memorial on the year.
- » Three teams (LR, Queens and Newberry) each have three league losses. Tusculum is 9-4 in league play. Everyone is chasing Lincoln Memorial who is 14-2 in SAC action and 16-2 overall.




