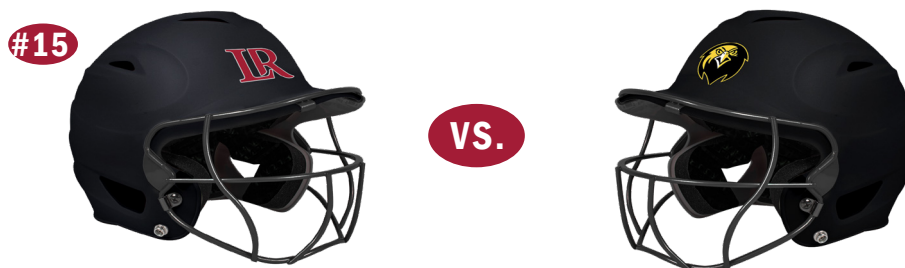

SEASON OPENING STORYLINES

- » After seeing the 2020 campaign get short and having the first two doubleheaders of the 2021 season postponed, Lenoir-Rhyne is set to host Pfeiffer in the season opener.
- » In the last game played before the season shut down in 2020, Morgan Beeler tossed a no-hitter as the Bears completed a sweep of Queens back on March 11, 2020.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne is ranked #15 in the season-opening NFCA national poll.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

- » The Bears were predicted to finish first in the preseason South Atlantic Conference Coaches' Poll and earned seven first-place votes.
- » Pfeiffer, who dropped from Division II to Division III in 2017, was 16-1 overall in 2020 and outscored opponents 151-32.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- » Lenoir-Rhyne and Pfeiffer renew a matchup that hasn't been played since the 2017 season. Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 49-13 advantage in the series which included a 32-game winning streak.
- » However, Pfeiffer earned a pair of NCAA Tournament wins over Lenoir-Rhyne in the 2016 NCAA Regionals.
- » Pfeiffer head coach Monte Sherrill and LR head coach Shena Hollar have combined for 1,789 career wins. 753 of Sherrill's 911 career wins have come at the high school level while all of Hollar's 878 wins are at the NCAA Division II level.
- » Sherrill also coached Hollar at Alexander Central High School for three years during Sherrill's first years in coaching.

In her 22nd season at LR, Shena Hollar is just 22 wins shy of 900 for her head coaching career. Hollar ranks 11th in NCAA Division II among active head coaches in career wins and 12th among all active head coaches who have coached at least five years in winning percentage.

Hollar has led the Bears to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances, including two NCAA Super Regionals. She owns 12 SAC Regular Season Championships and eight SAC Tournament Titles during her tenure at LR and has produced the program's only All-Americans.

Under her guidance, 101 players have earned all-conference accolades and 71 have been named All-Region performers. The Bears have finished in the top two of the conference standings in 14 of her 22 years.

Hollar has won 74.6 of her games as the head coach at Lenoir-Rhyne and is 252-86 against South Atlantic Conference competition. Hollar has earned league Coach of the Year honors seven times.
