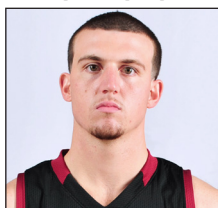

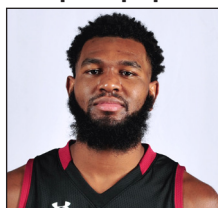

### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### HISTORIC 100TH SEASON

- » This is the historic 100th season of Lenoir-Rhyne men's basketball. The program began competition in 1919 but were shut down for two seasons due to World War II. The Bears have won 19 regular season championships and 12 conference tournaments in their history.
- » The Bears are just two wins shy of 1,400 as a program and own an all-time winning percentage of .552 in the first 99 years of basketball.
- » 62 of the first 99 seasons have been winning seasons for the Bears. Last year, the Bears went 14-14 which is only the third time in history that LR finished a season exactly at .500.

#### BUZZER-BEATERS BOTH WAYS

- » Cooper Fowler hit one of the most memorable shots in Shuford Gym history as his offensive rebound putback from the free throw line as the buzzer sounded gave LR an 86-85 win over Wingate on Jan. 20. The play earned a spot on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays.
- » However, the Bears have been on the losing end in two of their past three losses, both coming by one point.
- » On Monday, Feb. 13, Alex Keel's baseline jumper with under five seconds to go gave Anderson an 80-79 win.
- » Four days later, Cameron Whiteside sent UVA Wise to a 71-70 upset victory over the Bears with a driving basket with 2.9 seconds left.

#### SAC TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- » Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 25-22 all-time record in South Atlantic Conference Tournament games dating back to the first tournament in 1991.
- » Much of LR's conference tournament success came early. 12 of the 25 wins came from 1991-95, including three tournament titles.
- » Since winning their fourth, and most recent, SAC tourney title in 2003, the Bears own an 8-13 mark.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne enters the tournament as the number five seed and own an all-time record of 2-5 as the five seed. This is the sixth appearance as a five-seed in the tournament for the Bears.
- » The Bears are searching for their first SAC Tournament win over the Wolves. The Bears are 0-4 all-time in the tournament against Newberry with two losses coming in overtime. One of those two losses was in double overtime back in 2000 with the Wolves escaping with a 95-91 victory.
- » Coincidentally, all five of the SAC Tournament matchups between LR and Newberry have been a 4-seed vs. 5-seed. This will be the third time that Newberry enters as the four seed and hosts the game.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne has never won the SAC Tournament as a number five seed. In their four championships, they entered as a one seed once, a two seed twice and a three seed one time.
- » LR has been a five seed twice in the past three years. In 2019, the Bears made a run to the championship game before falling to Catawba 71-67.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES (CONTINUED)

#### HOUSE OF HORRORS

- » Eleazer Arena has been a nightmare for Lenoir-Rhyne in recent memory. The Bears have lost 12 straight games at Newberry with the last win coming way back on Feb. 7, 2009.
- » The last three road losses for the Bears have come by a combined eight points.

#### STOPPING THE SLIDE

- » Lenoir-Rhyne will be tasked with halting a three game losing streak heading into Monday's game. The Bears have fallen to UVA Wise, Catawba and Tusculum in the final week of the regular season.
- » The Bears are just 1-4 over their last five and the lone win came against a one-win Mars Hill team on Feb. 15.
- » This slide corresponds with the fourth two week shutdown of the season for Lenoir-Rhyne. Two of those shutdowns were in season for LR and have taken a toll mentally on the Bears.
- » LR went from Jan. 23 to Feb. 13 without a game and were stunned by Anderson in their first game back. The Bears trailed by four with the ball and 19 seconds remaining but Anderson shocked LR with a 5-0 run to end the game.

#### UPSET SULLY

- » Of the 13 wins over ranked teams since 1989-90, head coach Everick Sullivan has engineered six of those upsets.
- » Four of the ranked wins have come over

Queens including twice when the Royals were in the top 10 in the nation.

- » The win over #2 LMU was the highest ranked opponent Lenoir-Rhyne has ever beaten.

#### CHASING MILESTONES

- » The Bears are now just two wins shy of 1,400 as a program. Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 1,398-1,129 all-time record in the first 99 and-a-half years of hoops.

#### TOUGH ONE AT TUSCULUM

- » Lenoir-Rhyne held a 58-47 lead with 8:07 left to play but Tusculum used a 21-2 run to reclaim the lead and grab a late victory over Lenoir-Rhyne.
- » R.J. Gunn scored a season-high 28 points in the game and had 14 of LR's 31 first half points.
- » Davion Bradford stuffed the stat sheet with five points, eight rebounds and five assists.

#### HOME COOKING FOR COOP

- » Cooper Fowler has always found success at Shuford Gym in his young career. For his career, Fowler has averaged 10.9 points per game and has shot 50.3 percent from the field in the 'Shu' but has struggled away from home.
- » However, on the season Fowler has scored just 10 of his 72 points away from John Lentz Court this year.

### COLD FROM DEEP

» The Bears have struggled from long range over their past seven games. In that stretch, LR has converted 28 percent of their 3-point attempts in three games. Since a win over Queens on Jan. 18, the Bears are hitting 49 out of 178 attempts.

» R.J. Gunn is one of the few Bears who is hot from the 3-point line. Gunn has connected on 18 threes in that six-game stretch and is shooting 43.2 percent from deep during that time.

### CLIMBING THE SCORING CHARTS

» Teammates Darius Simmons and R.J. Gunn are separated by just two points in the scoring column during their four-year careers. Simmons has 1,154 points to Gunn's 1,152. The duo entered the season each sitting at 917 and check in at 32nd and 33rd on the all-time scoring list at Lenoir-Rhyne.

» It would take a 32-point effort from Simmons and a 34-point showing from Gunn in the SAC Tournament to move into the top 30 in scoring in the 100 years of Lenoir-Rhyne basketball.

» Will Perry is the most recent player to enter the top 30 in all-time scorer as the 2016 graduate is 21st all-time with 1,267 career points.

R.J. Gunn was one of three in double figures, scoring 17 points on 7-of-17 shooting. Mason Hawks had 14 (and went 4-of-8 from deep) and Darius Simmons had 11. Cooper Fowler and Davion Bradford each had nine.

Newberry held a 43-33 advantage on the boards and grabbed 11 offensive boards. The Wolves also turned the ball over just six times.

The lead changed hands 13 times in the contest and was tied on six occasions.

Newberry had four players in double figures, including three who scored 16 apiece.

The game was tied at 70 with 3:21 to play but LR had no field goals the rest of the way and a jumper by TJ Brown with 23 seconds to go proved to be the game-winner for Newberry.

#### Beyond the Box Score:

In the losing streak at Newberry, LR has lost games in double (2016) and triple (2014) overtime. A season ago, Newberry hit three free throws with less than a second on the clock to come away with a 103-101 victory.

The last LR win at Newberry came on Feb. 7, 2009, a 66-55 win.

Newberry swept the season series from LR, winning both games by a combined five points.

With one week left in the season, LR is currently the number eight seed in the conference tournament.

The Bears hold a one game lead over Wingate for the final spot in the league tourney.
