» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

» The Bears last played ten days ago against #21 Tusculum. LR was down 14 points early in the second quarter but battled back to take the lead into the 4th quarter. However, Tusculum was too much for the Bears as the upset bid fell short in the Pioneers 61-54 win.

 The Bears only had six players play against Tusculum. All six Bears scored between
 6-12 points on the afternoon led by Ashley Woodroffe 12 points.

ALL BEARS EARLIER

» These two teams just played on January 27th in Hickory. After Mars Hill jumped out to a 17-12 lead after the first quarter, the Bears outscored the Lions 69-30 the rest of the way for an 81-47 win.

» Mallory Sherrill had her self a night with 20 points, 15 rebounds and five assists, all career-high for the redshirt freshman from Statesville, N.C.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

» Since winning their season opener, the Lions have lost their next 10 games. All ten games have been decided by double-digits except for a nine point lost at Catawba earlier in the season.

» Mars Hill is led by De'Ja Marshall (20.1ppg) and Gabby Gianikos (13.4ppg). Marshall and Gianikos have combined for 17 of the Lions 23 double-figure scoring outputs of the year so far.

 Marshall enters the contest 27th in the nation in scoring and fifth in rebounds (13.3). The Bears did a great job keeping Marshall in check in the first meeting, holding her to 9 points and 7 rebounds, both well below her seasons averages.

ABOUT THE SERIES

The Bears are currently on a ten game winning streak vs. the Lions and own a 53-34 all-time record vs. Mars Hill but the series is all tied up 16-16 in Mars Hill in the SAC ERA.
 The Bears last loss in Mars Hill happened on January 16, 2016 but LR has won the last four games in Mars Hill by an average of 25 points.

A YEAR AGO TODAY

» Last February 8th, Karlie Bearden scored her 500th career point but the Bears fell to #19 Anderson inside the Shu.

CUTTING DOWN TURNOVERS

» The Bears had 18 turnovers in their last outing against Tusculum, including 11 in the first quarter alone. The 18 turnovers marks the third highest output so far on the season. The Bears have had at least 12 turnovers in every game but one this season.

GETTING TO THE LINE

» In the last three games, the Bears have gotten to the free-throw line 22.3 time per game and have outshot their opponents 67 to 45. The Bears went to the charity stripe a season-high 31 times in the first meeting with the Lions.

IN SEARCH OF NUMBER ONE

- » Lenoir-Rhyne heads into Mars Hill on Monday looking for the first win away from Shuford Gym this season. The Bears have gone 3-3 at home on the year but are winless in five games on the road. Only two of those road loses came by single digits.
- » This is the Bears' first road game since traveling to Carson-Newman on January 16.

EVERYONE PLAYS

- » Thanks to an ever-evolving roster, Lenoir-Rhyne has had to count on a bunch of different players in this one-of-a-kind season. Incredibly, Lenoir-Rhyne has 14 players who average at least 15 minutes per game.
- » Not a single player has played in all 11 games for Lenoir-Rhyne this year. The games played leader is Mallory Sherrill with 10.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne has dressed as few as seven players for a game and as many as 20.

IRON WOMEN

» Lenoir-Rhyne has had a player play all 40 minutes in a game on nine different occasions this season. Emily Harman played all 40 twice and Woodroffe and DeLucas played all 40 in three straight games. Additionally, Hanna McClung played all 40 against Lincoln Memorial and Ashley Woodroffe and Korbin Tipton played all 40 against Tusculum.

SAC TOURNEY EXPANSION

» For the first time in South Atlantic Conference history, all teams will qualify for the SAC Tournament. The first round is set for February 27 and the format gives the top three seeds a bye. Additionally, seeds four through eight will host a first round game at conference locations.

- » Currently, the Bears sit in 11th place but are just a game-and-a-half out of eighth place.
- » Mars Hill sits in 13th in the league standings and join Queens as the only teams with just one SAC win on the year.

COACH T

- » Stepping in for Head Coach Grahm Smith, Audrey Timmerman led the Bears to a 2-1 record. Timmerman coached the Bears to wins over Mars Hill and Queens and a narrow seven-point loss to nationally-ranked Tusculum.
- » Grahm Smith will return to the sidelines for Monday's tilt at Mars Hill.
