» RECAP

HICKORY, N.C. – The No. 8 Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team won its ninth straight home game and successfully defended the Bishops' Trophy with a 34-17 victory in the South Atlantic Conference opener over Newberry. Grayson Willingham went 15-for-20 for 176 yards and a touchdown to move into sole possession of third place with 32 career passing TDs.

STATS OF THE GAME:

- Lenoir-Rhyne held a 17-minute advantage in time of possession to overcome a pair of turnovers in tonight's 17-point victory. LR grinded out 363 yards rushing on 64 carries to impose their will on the Wolves.
- In his Lenoir-Rhyne debut, RB Jace Jordan had five carries for 96 yards (all in the first half) with his first touch going for 37 yards. Jordan added an 18-yard reception to his ledger.
- Demarius Hampton recorded a career-high with seven receptions which totaled 65 yards.

- Newberry's Bobby Irby made a highlight-reel
 20-yard TD catch in the second quarter to pull the
 Wolves within seven at 17-10 but LR answered with back-to-back TDs.
- Ameen Stevens' nine-yard TD plunge capped a 14-play, 66-yard drive that chewed up 5:48 to put the Bears ahead 24-10.
- Drake Starks added two catches for 61 yards and a 56-yard touchdown reception late in the third quarter to give the Bears a 31-10 advantage.
- Tate Beaver ran for 65 yards and scored his first career touchdown and Jaquay Mitchell added 10 carries for 75 yards.
- Defensively, Sherrod Williams led the way with six tackles, one tackle for loss, three quarterback hurries and a forced fumble. Dan Louba added 1.5 sacks and blocked a field goal for LR as well.

BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- LR has an 18-15 edge in the Battle for the Bishops Trophy. These two teams have played annually for the trophy since 1987.
- Newberry QB Dre Harris went 15-for-23 with a pair of touchdowns and is the first player this year to throw for more than one touchdown against the stingy LR defense.
- The Bears have not allowed a single player to rush for 100 yards since Drew Cronic took over prior to the 2018 season.

» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SPRING SEASON

- » The 101st season in Lenoir-Rhyne Football history is one like no other. For the first time ever, the Bears will compete in spring games. The four-game regular season slate features Newberry, Barton, Wingate and Catawba with a chance to advance to a SAC Championship game on April 17.
- » The conference is broken into two divisions and the best record in each division will play for a SAC title in April.

NEW FACES

- » Not only is the roster made up of a lot of new names, the coaching staff will be leading the LR program for the first time. Despite being hired at the end of December 2019, Head Coach Mike Jacobs will be coaching in his first game on Friday.
- » The two deep is made up of 14 players who will be making their Lenoir-Rhyne debuts on Friday.

SAC STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has won 17 straight games against South Atlantic Conference opponents with two of those wins coming in the NCAA Playoffs.
- The last loss to a South Atlantic
 Conference opponent came back on Nov.
 11, 2017 when the Bears dropped a 24-20 contest at Catawba.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne also went back-to-back with unbeaten conference seasons in 2013 and 2014. The Bears won 18 in a row from 2013-15 which is the longest winning streak against conference opponents in LR history.

BISHOPS TROPHY

» Since 1987, Lenoir-Rhyne and Newberry have battled for the Bishops Trophy. Lenoir-Rhyne is 18-15 against Newberry since the Bishops Trophy was awarded to the winners and has won each of the past two matchups.

STREAK PART II

» Lenoir-Rhyne hasn't lost a regular season game since a last-second loss at No. 12 West Alabama on August 30, 2018. The Bears have won 21 straight regular season games. As of gameday on Friday, the Bears will have gone 925 days without a regular season defeat.

TEACH 'EM HOW TO DUGGER

- » In the Bears last trip to Newberry, it was Kyle Dugger who was the biggest differencemaker in the game.
- » As a junior, Dugger returned two punts for touchdowns as the Bears defeated Newberry 34-21 on Oct. 6, 2018. Dugger returned punts 69 and 64 yards and Chase Allbaugh booted a pair of field goals to earn the victory.
- » For his performance, Kyle Dugger was named the National Special Teams Player of the Week.
- » The game was one of two times Dugger would return multiple punts for touchdowns in the same game. The following year, Dugger brought back two punts to the house against UVA Wise. The two punt returns were just over three minutes apart and spanned 68 and 67 yards. Lenoir-Rhyne would go on to beat UVA Wise 63-6 on that Homecoming day.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

RUSH ATTACK

- » After finishing seventh in the nation in rushing offense at 269.0 yards per game, the Bears have some new faces at the running back position. The Bears running back core is led by freshman Dwayne McGee who is set to make his LR debut on Saturday.
- » The Bears will be without their top four rushers from a season ago and the top returning rusher is actually WR Ryan Carter who ran for 298 yards on 48 attempts.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne ran for more than 200 yards in 12 of 14 games a season ago, including the first nine straight. Only Carson-Newman (190 yds) and UNC Pembroke (155 yds) were able to hold Lenoir-Rhyne under 200 yards on the ground.
- » In the last game against Newberry, Lenoir-Rhyne rushed for 363 yards on 64 carries and found the endzone three times. The Bears ran for 5.7 yards per carry and had a pair of 30-yard runs in the game.

G-MONEY

» Quarterback Grayson Willingham owns a record of 23-3 as a starting quarterback and owns the all-time record for most career touchdown passes. Willingham ranks fifth in program history in career completions (269) and is sixth all-time in career completion percentage (53.3).

O-LINE REPLACEMENTS

» Lenoir-Rhyne will be looking to replace two starters on the offensive line a season ago. The Bears lost Ronnie Clifton was lost to graduation and two-time Jacobs Blocking Trophy winner Jason Poe announced his transfer to Mercer.

» Ian Brinson returns as a three-year starter at right tackle and Blake Jefferson made double digit starts at center as a freshman in 2019. The left guard spot will be manned by a returner whether it be Kurtis Feanny or Bryce Heidinger.

LARGER ROLE

» WRs Ryan Carter and Deondre Lester will be counted on to shoulder more of the load in the passing game. The duo ranked fifth and sixth respectively in yards receiving in 2019 but are projected as starters this year. They combined for 24 catches and two touchdowns in a different offensive scheme a season ago.

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD

- » Lenoir-Rhyne ranked eighth in the nation and first in the league in points per game at 42.0. The Bears were only 5.5 points per game away from the nation's leaders who were Minnesota St.
- » The Bears scored at least 28 points in all but one game. Limestone was the only team to hold LR to less than four touchdowns and kept the Bears to just 20 points back on Nov. 2, 2019.

» LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

DOMINANT D-LINE

- » All-Conference performers Dan Louba (First Team) and Amari Houston (Second Team) along with Quentin Hayes combined for 24 sacks a season ago and all are back to get after the quarterback this spring.
- » Louba, a two-time First Team All-Conference performer, led the group with 11 sacks and had 16 tackles for loss. Louba ranks fifth in program history with 19 career sacks and need just 10 to tie former teammate Jaquan Artis.

NEW LOOK LB CORE

- » The Bears are slated to trot out three new starters at linebacker although Preston Joseph has seen a lot of time in a reserve role behind Clayton Horn and Sherrod Williams in prior seasons.
- » Joining Joseph on the first string are true freshmen Jon Ross Maye and Percy King who will be making their Lenoir-Rhyne debuts on Friday.

E-JACK IN THE BACK

- » The defensive backfield is anchored by First Team All-Conference safety Eric Jackson. Jackson finished third on the team with 67 tackles a season ago and added three interceptions, four pass breakups and a forced fumble. Jackson's three picks all came against Mars Hill and E-Jack earned the National Defensive Player of the Week award for his performance.
- » Joining Jackson are sophomores C'Darrius Kelly and J.P. Palmer along with true

freshman Chris Brown.

BRICK CURTAIN

- » Over the past two seasons, Lenoir-Rhyne has only allowed one player to rush for more than 100 yards against them. That comes out to just one 100-yard rusher in the last 28 games.
- » The last back to break the century mark was Jerko'ya Patton from Limestone who took 12 carries for 147 yards thanks in large part to an 85 yard run.
- » Prior to that, the last 100 yard rushing game for an opposing player came back on November 11, 2017 when Catawba's Kenyatta Greene ran 19 times for 142 yards.
- » The last 100-yard rusher at Moretz Stadium was the week prior (Nov. 4, 2017) when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran 18 times for 108 yards.

TURNOVER BATTLE

- » In all but two games a season ago, the Lenoir-Rhyne defense caused at least two turnovers.
- » The only games where teams didn't commit a turnover were Miles College in the NCAA Playoffs and UNC Pembroke. However, Lenoir-Rhyne won each of those games by 14 or more points.
- » The season-high in turnovers came in the Second Round of the NCAA Playoffs where LR forced Carson-Newman into four turnovers, all of them fumbles.

SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 39 straight games and multiple sacks in 25 consecutive games.

In the 39-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 122 sacks.

» LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh is tied for the program lead in scoring by a kicker. Allbaugh enters the game with 264 career points, tied with Zach Neumann.
- » Allbaugh is also fifth in program history with 34 field goals made and leads the Bears in field goal accuracy. Allbaugh makes 79.1 percent of his field goals and was named an All-Conference performer in 2019.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 97 straight extra points which is just 30 shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

BE LIKE MIKE

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Owen averaged 40.52 yards per punt and booted a long of 64 yards as a sophomore in 2019. Owen placed 16 punts inside the 20 and had six punts of 50+ yards. Additionally, Owen never had just one punt blocked in his first two seasons with Lenoir-Rhyne.
- Owen added nine kickoffs for a team-high 59.8 yard average and three touchbacks while filling in.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

- » Lenoir-Rhyne punt returners will need to step up and fill a huge void left by Kyle Dugger who was the program's all-time leader in punt return yards with 929.
- » Deondre Lester is the projected punt returner for the Bears but had just one punt return for two yards a season ago. In total, just two returners have returned a combined two punts in the previous two seasons.

PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
- » Before Marcus Clayton of West Florida returned a kickoff 75 yards for a touchdown in LR's most recent game, the last kickoff taken to the house was also by North Greenville in 2016.
