» LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SPRING SEASON

- » The 101st season in Lenoir-Rhyne Football history is one like no other. For the first time ever, the Bears will compete in spring games. The four-game regular season slate features Newberry, Barton, Wingate and Catawba with a chance to advance to a SAC Championship game on April 17.
- » The conference is broken into two divisions and the best record in each division will play for a SAC title in April.

SAC STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has won 18 straight games against South Atlantic Conference opponents with two of those wins coming in the NCAA Playoffs.
- » The last loss to a South Atlantic Conference opponent came back on Nov. 11, 2017 when the Bears dropped a 24-20 contest at Catawba.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne also went back-to-back with unbeaten conference seasons in 2013 and 2014. The Bears won 18 in a row from 2013-15 which is the longest winning streak against conference opponents in LR history. If you don't count playoff games, LR won 22 straight from 2012-15.

HOME OPENER

- » For the first time since dropping a 43-38 decision against eventual National Champion West Florida, the Bears return to Moretz Stadium. In regular season games, Lenoir-Rhyne has won 11 straight games at Moretz Stadium. This will also mark the home coaching debut for Mike Jacobs.

STREAK PART II

- » Lenoir-Rhyne hasn't lost a regular season game since a last-second loss at No. 12 West Alabama on August 30, 2018. The Bears have won 22 straight regular season games. As of gameday, the Bears will have gone 932 days without a regular season defeat.

RIVALRY RENEWED

- » Lenoir-Rhyne and Barton renew a rivalry that has been dormant since 1950. Barton, who then competed as Atlantic Christian, has never beaten Lenoir-Rhyne with the Bears holding a 9-0 edge.
- » In fact, Barton has scored just six points all-time against LR as eight games ended with LR shutting out the Bulldogs.
- » The largest margin of victory came back in 1930 when LR handed Barton a 38-0 loss in Hickory.

VICTORIOUS OPENER

- » Lenoir-Rhyne claimed an overtime victory over Newberry 27-20 in double overtime in the Bears season-opener. Sean White filled in for Grayson Willingham at QB and engineered a game-winning drive, throwing the winning touchdown to Kelin Parsons in double OT.
- » Keygan Mayfield's fourth down interception sealed the game for the Bears.
- » The Bears hadn't won an overtime game since beating Tusculum 55-52 back on Sept. 19, 2015. That game against the Pioneers went into triple overtime and was ended on a Kyle Dugger forced fumble and recovery.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

HISTORIC DEBUT

- » True freshman running back Dwayne McGee (nicknamed Deewee) ran for 160 yards on 30 carries against Newberry on Friday.
- » The yardage total was the most for an LR running back in their debut in the NCAA era which dates back to 1993.
- » With the LR offense struggling, McGee garnered the first 1st down of the game with his legs and then ran for two more on gains of 10, 13 and 11 on consecutive plays.

EMERGENCY QB

- » With the first two quarterbacks on the depth chart unavailable to play, true freshman Sean White stepped into a difficult role but became the second consecutive backup QB to go into Newberry in their first career start for LR and come away with a victory. Gunnar Anderson accomplished the feat back in 2018.
- » White threw the game-winning touchdown in double overtime and hit a 17-yard pass to Deondre Lester to set up the 8-yard game-winner.

FRESHMAN TO FRESHMAN

- » White hit freshman WR Kelin Parsons on the game-winning touchdown to cap a strong debut for the receiver.
- » Parsons finished the contest with three grabs for 39 yards including that touchdown and added a rush for 10 yards in the first half.

RC

- » Ryan Carter led Lenoir-Rhyne with his five grabs for 51 yards. Carter had the longest play of the game for LR's offense on a 29-yard catch and run.
- » Carter's career-high in catches is nine against Catawba and he set his career-high in yards that game with 67.

LATE TD

- » Lenoir-Rhyne's offense struggled through most of the game and didn't find the end zone until White hit Parsons for the winner in double OT.
- » The other touchdowns came in special teams (punt block returned for a touchdown) and on defense (interception returned for a touchdown).
- » The Bears did manage 347 total yards with 224 of those coming on the ground.
- » LR had 20 first downs in the game compared to just 13 for the Wolves.

» LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

DOMINANT D-LINE

- » All-Conference performers Dan Louba (First Team) and Amari Houston (Second Team) along with Quentin Hayes combined for 24 sacks a season ago and all are back to get after the quarterback this spring.
- » Louba, a two-time First Team All-Conference performer, led the group with 11 sacks and had 16 tackles for loss. Louba ranks fifth in program history with 19 career sacks and need just 10 to tie former teammate Jaquan Artis.

MAYE DAY

- » Jon Ross Maye had a debut to remember on Friday at Newberry.
- » The freshman linebacker finished the game with 14 total tackles and added a quarterback hurry and 0.5 tackles for loss.
- » With the effort, Maye was named South Atlantic Conference Defensive Player of the Week.
- » The 14 tackles was the most by any player in a single game in the SAC so far this season.

TRIO OF TO'S

- » Against Newberry, the LR defense forced three turnovers against the Wolves.
- » Eric Jackson recovered a fumble in the first half but a pair of second half turnovers were momentum shifters.
- » Percy King's fourth quarter interception return for a touchdown gave Lenoir-Rhyne a lead and a much needed score.
- » Keygan Mayfield's interception in the

second overtime clinched the game for Lenoir-Rhyne.

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has caused multiple turnovers in 13 of their last 15 games played.

BRICK CURTAIN

- » Over the past two seasons, Lenoir-Rhyne has only allowed one player to rush for more than 100 yards against them. That comes out to just one 100-yard rusher in the last 29 games.
- » The last back to break the century mark was Jerko'ya Patton from Limestone who took 12 carries for 147 yards thanks in large part to an 85 yard run.
- » Prior to that, the last 100 yard rushing game for an opposing player came back on November 11, 2017 when Catawba's Kenyatta Greene ran 19 times for 142 yards.
- » The last 100-yard rusher at Moretz Stadium was the week prior (Nov. 4, 2017) when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran 18 times for 108 yards.

NOTABLES FROM NEWBERRY

- » Maye wasn't the only standout for LR on defense. Houston finished with nine tackles, one tackle for loss and shared a sack with King. King's final line was six tackles, 0.5 sacks and an interception to go with his touchdown.
- » Quentin Hayes and JP Palmer also finished with six tackles.

» SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 40 straight games and multiple sacks in 25 consecutive games.

In the 40-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 123 sacks.

» LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 100 straight extra points which is just 27 shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

EARLY IMPACT

- » On the second special teams play of the day (aside from the opening kickoff), Lenoir-Rhyne's special teams broke through with a huge play.
- » Jordan Holmes blocked a Newberry punt and Alvin James scooped it up and returned it 20 yards for the first touchdown of the 2020-21 season.

BE LIKE MIKE

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Owen had a picture perfect punt on his first attempt of the season, perfectly placing

the ball at the one-yard line of Newberry.

LESTER THE RETURNER

- » For the third time in his young career, sophomore Deondre Lester was back to return kickoffs.
- » Lester broke a kickoff for 45 yards, his longest career return. For the game, the WR had three returns for 98 yards.
- » In 2019, Lester's two returns went for just 24 yards with a long return of 24.

PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
- » Before Marcus Clayton of West Florida returned a kickoff 75 yards for a touchdown in LR's most recent game, the last kickoff taken to the house was also by North Greenville in 2016.
