RECORD-BREAKING WIN

PAIR OF RECORDS FALL

Lenoir-Rhyne set the record for most goals in a game with 24 in a dominating win over Newberry on Wednesday night and senior attackmen Eric Dickinson broke the program record for most career assists with his 82nd helper against the Wolves. Dickinson already owns the program records for most career goals and most career points and is now just six away from setting the South Atlantic Conference record for most career helpers.

LOOKING FOR FIFTH STRAIGHT VS. CATAWBA

Lenoir-Rhyne has won four straight games against Catawba heading into Saturday's matchup. Most recently, the Bears handed No. 19 Catawba a 17-5 defeat inside Moretz Stadium in 2019. The teams didn't meet in the shortened 2020 season so this will be the first meeting in two seasons.

IOHNSON STAYS SOLID

Goalie Noah Johnson recorded 14 saves against Newberry on Wednesday and now has 16 career games with at least 10 saves in his career. Johnson has a 55.6 save percentage and allows just 8.7 goals per game. Johnson ranks 16th in the nation in save percentage and 11th in goals-against average.

LETHAL OFFENSE

Lenoir-Rhyne has three games with at least 20 goals this season and is amongst the national leaders in a handful of offensive categories. The Bears rank sixth in the nation in scoring offense at 17.3 goals per game and fourth in the land with 68 assists. The Bears are eighth in shot percentage and their scoring margin of +7.86 is eighth in the nation. The Bears rank just outside the top 10 (11th) in turnovers per game at 16.3 and their 27.0 points per game ranks seventh. Toron Eccleston ranks seventh in the nation in goals per game at 4.0 and his .585 shot percentage is 10th in Division II.



BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine has guided the Bears to four South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, one SAC Tournament title and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 91–58 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 58 times, including being as

high as No. 3 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 43 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and eight have been All-Americans. He had two players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had two players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and one bee named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and played won a National Championship in 1991.

COUNTDOWN TO 100

Lenoir-Rhyne enters the game with 98 wins in program history, all coming under head coach Greg Paradine. The Bears have a chance to hit the 100-win mark this season.

<u>13-1</u>

Over the past 14 games, the Lenoir-Rhyne Bears are 13-1 with the lone loss coming at No. 6 Belmont Abbey in 2020. The Bears would avenge that loss this season and handed No. 13 Belmont Abbey a 14-11 loss on February 20.

90 PERCENT

In 50 all-time South Atlantic Conference games, Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 90 percent winning percentage. The Bears are 45-5 all-time against SAC opponents and have won nine straight league contests.

STANLEY MOVING UP THE CHARTS

Senior defensemen Connor Stanley is moving up the record book with his 45 career caused turnovers. Stanley, who tied the program record with five caused turnovers against Limestone, moved into fourth place in program history. Stanley is three away from third place and eight away from second place. However, he will be a distant second behind Collin Lett's 111 all-time caused

turnovers from 2015-18.

HOME STREAK

Lenoir-Rhyne has won 12 straight games at Moretz Stadium which is the longest home winning streak in program history.

TIE AN ALL-TIME MARK?

With a win over Catawba, Lenoir-Rhyne would tie an all-time mark with it's 12th consecutive win. The Bears won 12 straight from March 5, 2016 - Feb. 11, 2017 and also accomplished the feat from March 2, 2018 - April 27, 2018.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

The Bears have three games with at least 20 goals so far in just seven games this season. This ties the record for the most games with 20+ goals in a season which was done in 2014 and 2017. The 17.3 goals per game ranks fourth in all of Division II.

AGAINST UNRANKED TEAMS

Lenoir-Rhyne is now 81-27 in program history against unranked teams and have won 15 straight contests heading into this weekend. The last time Lenoir-Rhyne lost to a team that wasn't ranked came all the way back on March 2, 2018 when they fell to Florida Tech 12-10.

TERRIFYING TRIO

Lenoir-Rhyne has three players who rank inside the top 25 in the nation in goals per game. The trio of Toron Eccleston (4.0 gpg), Myles Moffat (3.33) and Eric Dickinson (3.0) are one of the highest scoring trifectas in all of Division II.

LONG LAYOFF AT HOME

This is the first home game for Lenoir-Rhyne since a 21-11 victory over Tusculum on March 13 and one of just three home games in the month of March for the Bears.

Lenoir-Rhyne will finish the season with four of their last five at Moretz Stadium and LR serves as the host of the South Atlantic Conference Tournament. The Bears own an all-time record of 53–27 at home.

ABOUT THE INDIANS

After starting their season with an upset win over No. 4 Belmont Abbey by a final score of 13-9, the Indians have suffered a bunch of set backs. The Indians have only beaten Lincoln Memorial, Newberry (by one) and Anderson since the season opener and are coming off a 21-7 loss at home against Wingate. The Indians are led by Matt Mitchell who has 21 goals and three assists and Connor Chessock has 15 goals.

Catawba struggles on the face off, winning just 34.8 percent of draws on the season.

Defensively, Payton Leonard leads the squad with 16 caused turnovers which ranks third in the league.
