#### » RECAP

HICKORY, N.C. – Over 10,000 fans were on hand for the Division II National Showcase game and thanks to a 20-13 victory over Wingate, the Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team clinched at least a share of the ninth South Atlantic Conference Championship in program history. The Bears can claim an outright title with a win over Catawba in two weeks. Jaquay Mitchell was the star for the Bears, scoring each of the LR touchdowns and accounting for 176 total yards.

#### STATS OF THE GAME:

After the team's traded field goals in the first quarter, Mitchell caught a 41-yarder from Grayson Willingham with 14:35 left on the clock in the second quarter.

 The Bears would add a field goal to go up double-digits but Wingate added a field goal at the end of the first half to send the teams into the break with LR holding a 13-6 advantage.

 The defenses took over in the third quarter with neither team scoring before Willingham and Mitchell connected 2:39 into the fourth quarter on a 90-yard pass play. The TD was the longest passing touchdown in the 100-year program of LR Football, topping the previous record of 89 yards from Craig Corbett to Steve Fleming against Elon in 1980.

The Bulldogs cut the lead to one possession

with a 4-yard touchdown pass by Shaw Crocker to BJ Muckelvene. After holding LR, Wingate got the ball back down seven with 3:41 to play. A 4th and 14 toss from Crocker was intercepted by Javoris Smith to secure the LR victory.

For the second straight home game, LR netted a huge first offensive play of the game. Ameen Stevens took the opening handoff 70 yards and set up Chase Allbaugh's first field goal. Two weeks ago, Mitchell took the opening handoff 65 yards to set up and LR score against Carson-Newman.

 A week after setting the new career record for most touchdown passes, Willingham finished 10for-18 for 169 yards and his two touchdowns.

Muckelvene finished with seven grabs for 106 yards for the visitors. On the defensive side, Gabe Price added 15 tackles and Elijah Gilmore had 13.

 The Bears defense was led by Eric Jackson with 12 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss. Clayton Horn also starred for the Bears as the senior LB had nine tackles, a sack, a forced fumble and an interception. Ivan Milliken also had a career-high eight tackles.

#### **BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:**

 The game took place in front of a national audience and was broadcast on ESPN3 as part of the Division II Showcase game.

 Each of the last four games between these two have been decided by one possession with the Bears winning the last three. LR won by a touchdown at Wingate in the regular season in 2018 and by four in the NCAA Playoffs in Hickory last November.

 The Bears ranked No. 2 in the Southeast Region and the Bulldogs were No. 4.

#### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### **SPRING SEASON**

- » The 101st season in Lenoir-Rhyne Football history is one like no other. For the first time ever, the Bears will compete in spring games. The four-game regular season slate features Newberry, Barton, Wingate and Catawba with a chance to advance to a SAC Championship game on April 17.
- » The conference is broken into two divisions and the best record in each division will play for a SAC title in April.

#### **SAC STREAK**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has won 19 straight games against South Atlantic Conference opponents with two of those wins coming in the NCAA Playoffs.
- The last loss to a South Atlantic
   Conference opponent came back on Nov.
   11, 2017 when the Bears dropped a 24-20 contest at Catawba.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne also went back-to-back with unbeaten conference seasons in 2013 and 2014. The Bears won 18 in a row from 2013-15 which was the longest winning streak against conference opponents in LR history. If you don't count playoff games, LR won 22 straight regular season games against league opponents from 2012-15.

#### **HOME OPENER**

» The Bears cruised past Barton on March 20 in the first home game since losing to West Florida in the Quarterfinal round of the NCAA Playoffs back on Dec. 7, 2019. Thanks to their efforts against the Bulldogs, Grayson Willingham, Jon Ross Maye and Dwayne McGee were named SAC Players of the Week.

#### **STREAK PART II**

» Lenoir-Rhyne hasn't lost a regular season game since a last-second loss at No. 12 West Alabama on August 30, 2018. The Bears have won 22 straight regular season games. As of gameday, the Bears will have gone 946 days without a regular season defeat.

#### **RIVALRY RENEWED**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne and Wingate is one of the best rivalries in the South Atlantic Conference and the league champion has been decided when they have met each of the past two seasons.
- » The Bears have captured back-to-back SAC Championships but the Bulldogs have a chance to halt that streak with a victory on Friday evening.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 22-13 all-time edge against Wingate in head-to-head matchups and is 7-3 over the last 10.
- » The Bears and Bulldogs met in the NCAA Playoffs on Nov. 24, 2018 when the Bears came away with a 21-17 victory on some lategame heroics. A double-reverse flea-flicker from Grayson Willingham to Riley McGee with 45 seconds to play erased a 3-point deficit and eventually gave the Bears a spot in the Quarterfinal round of the NCAA Playoffs.

#### **BATTLE OF UNBEATENS**

- » For the second consecutive season, LR and Wingate will meet without either team having a loss.
- » In 2019, the two teams entered 8-0 overall and the Bears were ranked No. 7 in the nation and Wingate was No. 12. The game was broadcast on ESPN3.

#### **G IS MONEY**

- » Senior QB Grayson Willingham had the best game in terms of passing yards in his Lenoir-Rhyne career against Barton in the Bears most recent action.
- » Willingham went 22-of-27 and tossed a pair of touchdowns to go with his career-high 309 yards passing.
- » The 309 yards is the eighth-most in a single game in the 101-year history of Lenoir-Rhyne Football.
- » For Willingham, it was his third 300-yard passing game of his career.
- » Thanks to his efforts, Willingham earned SAC Offensive Player of the Week accolades.

#### **WELCOME TO THE SHOW**

- » It has been quite a debut for freshman RB Dwayne McGee in the Bears first two games.
- » McGee ran for 160 yards in the seasonopener at Newberry and followed that up with 192 against Barton the following week.
- » McGee became the first Lenoir-Rhyne running back to rush for 160 or more yards in back-to-back games since Andrew Tudor did it back in 2004 and just the fourth LR back to accomplish that feat in the NCAA Division II era.
- » McGee added three rushing touchdowns against the Bulldogs.

#### 'DRE DAY

- » Not to be outdone, sophomore WR Deondre Leser was a star for the Bears against Barton as well.
- » Lester went off for eight catches for a

career-high 144 yards and a touchdown in week two, including a 50-yard TD catch in the second quarter.

» In the history of Lenoir-Rhyne Football, Lester's 144 yards receiving ranks just outside the top 10 in yards in a game and is the ninth-highest amount in the NCAA Division II era.

#### **PUTTING THE 'W' IN WILLINGHAM**

- » Since Grayson Willingham became the starting quarterback in 2018, the Matthews, N.C. native owns a career record of 24-3 over his 27 starts.
- » Willingham has missed three games in his career.

#### **NEW LOOK LINE**

- » With some departures on the offensive line, the Bears front unit has looked a little different this year than years past.
- » Ian Brinson (RT) and Blake Jefferson (C) are the lone returning starters on the offensive line. Isaac Chapman and Bryce Heidinger saw action as reserves a year ago and true freshman Xavier Jennings has been solid in his first two career starts at left tackle.

### LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

#### **MAYE OWNS MARCH**

- » Freshman LB Jon Ross Maye won back-toback South Atlantic Conference Defensive Player of the Week awards in his first two weeks as a Bear.
- » In the season-opener, Maye had 14 tackles against Newberry, the highest single-game tackle mark in the league this year.
- » The following week, Maye dominated Barton with 11 total tackles, three tackles for loss, his first career sack and even blocked a field goal.
- » Maye's 12.5 tackles per game leads the South Atlantic Conference.

#### TRIO OF TO'S

- » In each of their first two games, the LR defense has forced a trio of turnovers.
- » Against Newberry, the LR defense forced three turnovers against the Wolves.
- » Eric Jackson recovered a fumble in the first half but a pair of second half turnovers were momentum shifters.
- » Percy King's fourth quarter interception return for a touchdown gave Lenoir-Rhyne a lead and a much needed score.
- » Keygan Mayfield's interception in the second overtime clinched the game for Lenoir-Rhyne.
- » King added a pair of INT's againt Barton and Jackson added one as well, while Malik Taylor forced and recorded a fumble on the goal line.
- » Lenoir-Rhyne has caused multiple turnovers in 14 of their last 16 games played.

#### **BRICK CURTAIN**

- » Over the past two seasons, Lenoir-Rhyne has only allowed one player to rush for more than 100 yards against them. That comes out to just one 100-yard rusher in the last 30 games.
- The last back to break the century mark was Jerko'ya Patton from Limestone who took
   12 carries for 147 yards thanks in large part to an 85 yard run.
- » Prior to that, the last 100 yard rushing game for an opposing player came back on November 11, 2017 when Catawba's Kenyatta Greene ran 19 times for 142 yards.
- » The last 100-yard rusher at Moretz Stadium was the week prior (Nov. 4, 2017) when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran 18 times for 108 yards.

#### **SACK STREAK EXTENDED**

- » Thanks to a Maye sack, and two subsequent later QB takedowns, the Bears extended their streak of games with a sack to 41 straight.
- » The last time Lenoir-Rhyne failed to come away with a sack in a game was way back on November 5, 2016 in a 21-14 victory at Brevard.

#### » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 40 straight games and multiple sacks in 25 consecutive games.

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 104 straight extra points which is just 23 shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

- » The special teams unit blocked three kicks against Barton. Maye and JP Palmer each blocked field goals and Amari Houston was credited with a blocked extra point.
- » The Maye blocked field goal set the tone for the game as it came on Barton's first drive and they came away scoreless.

#### **EARLY IMPACT**

- » On the second special teams play of the season (aside from the opening kickoff), Lenoir-Rhyne's special teams broke through with a huge play.
- » Jordan Holmes blocked a Newberry punt and Alvin James scooped it up and returned it

20 yards for the first touchdown of the 2020-21 season.

#### **BE LIKE MIKE**

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Owen boomed a 50-yarder against Barton and placed

#### **LESTER THE RETURNER**

- » For the third time in his young career, sophomore Deondre Lester was back to return kickoffs.
- » Lester broke a kickoff for 45 yards, his longest career return. For the game, the WR had three returns for 98 yards.
- In 2019, Lester's two returns went for just 24 yards with a long return of 24.

### **PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES**

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

#### **RETURN STREAK**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
