POSTSEASON OPENER

2 vs. 4

Lenoir-Rhyne enters the NCAA Quarterfinal matchup with Tampa as the No. 2 team in the nation, the highest ranking in program history. The Bears also earned the No. 1 seed in the South Region for the second time in program history but have a tough draw on Sunday. Tampa is undefeated and No. 4 in the nation but the Spartans were given a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

NCAA REMATCH

These two programs met in the NCAA Quarterfinal in 2017 as well with Tampa coming away with an 11-8 victory. Tampa would fall in the NCAA Semifinal at Limestone in double overtime the following round.

SEVEN STRAIGHT

This marks the seventh straight NCAA Tournament appearance for the Spartans who own an all-time mark of 4-6 in the Big Dance. Tampa is 3-3 in NCAA Quarterfinal games, having most recently defeated Wingate in the 2019 Tournament by a final score of 13-6.

THREE IN FOUR

This is the third NCAA Tournament appearance for the Bears in the past four years. Lenoir-Rhyne is 1-2 all-time in NCAA games, with the lone win coming in 2018. That season, Lenoir-Rhyne defeated Colorado Mesa by a final score of 14-12 at Moretz Stadium.

AGAINST THE BEST

Lenoir-Rhyne has played five games against ranked opponents this season and own a 4-1 mark. The lone loss came to Wingate on April 7 but they avenged that defeat in the SAC Championship, beating the Bulldogs 19-14 on April 25. LR is 18-22 all-time against ranked opponents.

BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine has guided the Bears to four South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, one SAC Tournament title and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 91–58 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 58 times, including being as

high as No. 3 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 43 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and eight have been All-Americans. He had two players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had two players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and one bee named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and played won a National Championship in 1991.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HOME COOKING

As the host of both the South Atlantic Conference and NCAA Tournaments, Lenoir-Rhyne has played nine of their 14 games at home this season and all postseason games have been at Moretz Stadium.

STREAKING SPARTANS

Tampa enters the game on an 18-game winning streak including a 10-0 mark in 2021. The Spartans went 8-0 in a COVID-shortened 2020 campaign and last lost back on May 11, 2019 in double-overtime at Limestone in the NCAA Quarterfinal.

194 FOR 42

Senior Eric Dickinson's 194 career goals leave him just six shy of reaching 200 for his career. Dickinson ranks seventh in NCAA Division II history in most career goals scored and can become one of just six in history to reach the 200 career goal mark. Dickinson's 292 career points rank 11th in Division II history.

ALL-TIMERS

One of the best head-to-head matchups in Sunday's Quarterfinal game will be the two FOGOs. Coming into the season, Ross Dickerson and Zach Bodeau ranked first and second in NCAA Division II history in faceoff winning percentage. Dickinson owned

a .761 winning percentage while Bodeau, a Rockhurst transfer, won at a .749 clip.

ALL-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

On Sunday, 18 combined players will take the field as All-Conference performers. Tampa had 10 players named to the All-Sunshine State Conference, while the Bears had eight on the All-South Atlantic Conference squad.

TOP 10

Lenoir-Rhyne ranks in the top 10 nationally in nine different statistical categories. The Bears are second in the nation in scoring offense (18.79) and shot percentage (36.5) and third in DII in assists (150). The Bears also rank third in winning percentage, ground balls and points per game and the scoring margin of +9.14 is fifth in the nation. The Bears 11 caused turnovers per game ranks seventh in the nation.

TERRIFYING TRIO

Lenoir-Rhyne has three players who rank inside the top 20 in the nation in goals per game. The trio of Toron Eccleston (3.69 gpg), Myles Moffat (3.54) and Eric Dickinson (2.92) are one of the highest scoring trifectas in all of Division II. Eccleston ranks fifth in the

nation in goals per game.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

The Bears have seven games with at least 20 goals so far in just nine games this season. This sets the record for the most games with 20+ goals in a season. The previous high was three which was done in 2014 and 2017.

RECORD IN SIGHT

Despite playing in six less games than the 2018 team, this year's squad has a chance to break the program record for most goals scored in a season. The 2018 Bears scored 287 times in 20 games while the 2020 Bears have 263 goals in 14 games played. LR is 25 goals away from setting a new all-time mark. They are also 42 points away from breaking the 2018 mark.

PERFECT ON THE ROAD

For the second time in program history, Lenoir-Rhyne completed a perfect regular season on the road. The Bears went 6-0 back in 2018 before losing at Wingate in the SAC Championship. This season, LR went 5-0 and won't play on the road again until a possible NCAA Tournament contest.
