ROUND III

ALL ON THE LINE

Lenoir-Rhyne meets Wingate for the third time in 2021 with this matchup determining the South Region's champion. The winner of LR/Wingate part III will advance to the NCAA National Championship next Sunday in Hartford, Conn. Wingate won the first matchup on April 7 by one goal and the Bears answered with a 19-14 win in the SAC Tournament Championship on April 25.

THIRD MEETING

This is the first time in the history of LR Men's Lacrosse that they will play the same opponent for the third time in a season. Coincidentally, all three of the matchups on the season have been at Moretz Stadium.

TO THE WIRE

Lenoir-Rhyne and Wingate each got to the National Semifinal in the closing moments of Sunday's NCAA Quarterfinal round. The Bears erased a 7-1 deficit after one quarter and scored with four seconds left into the first overtime to earn a spot in the National Semifinal. Wingate was tied at nine with UIndy when Danny Riley scored with eight seconds remaining to send the Bulldogs on.

TWO VS. ONE

Not only is this a two seed (Wingate) vs. a one seed (Lenoir-Rhyne) but it is also the number of National Semifinal appearances for each team. The Bears are in their second National Semifinal game (2018, 2021) and Wingate is for the first time in program history.

AGAINST THE BEST

Lenoir-Rhyne has played six games against ranked opponents this season and own a 5-1 mark. The Bears have a chance to defeat the No. 3, 4 and 5 teams in successive weeks.

BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine has guided the Bears to four South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, one SAC Tournament title and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 91-58 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 58 times, including being as

high as No. 3 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 43 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and eight have been All-Americans. He had two players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had two players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and one be named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and played won a National Championship in 1991.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

HOME COOKING

As the host of both the South Atlantic Conference and NCAA Tournaments, Lenoir-Rhyne has played 10 of their 15 games at home this season and all postseason games have been at Moretz Stadium.

RELEASE THE MCCrackEN

Colten McCracken scored the biggest goal of the season in the Bears 16-15 overtime win over Tampa. The freshman scored for just the seventh time this season with just four seconds remaining to send LR on to the National Semifinal.

196 FOR 42

Senior Eric Dickinson's 196 career goals leave him just four shy of reaching 200 for his career. Dickinson ranks seventh in NCAA Division II history in most career goals scored and can become one of just six in history to reach the 200 career goal mark. Dickinson's 298 career points rank 11th in Division II history.

RECORD IN SIGHT

Despite playing in five less games than the 2018 team, this year's squad has a chance to break the program record for most goals scored in a season. The 2018 Bears scored 287 times in 20 games while the 2020 Bears have 279 goals in 15 games played. LR is nine goals away

from setting a new all-time mark. They are also 16 points away from breaking the 2018 mark.

ALL-CONFERENCE

DOMINANCE

On Sunday, 16 combined players will take the field as All-Conference performers. Each squad had eight players selected to the All-South Atlantic Conference team.

TOP 10

Lenoir-Rhyne ranks in the top 10 nationally in nine different statistical categories. The Bears are second in the nation in scoring offense (18.60) and assists (160) and third in shot percentage (36.4). The Bears also rank second in winning percentage, ground balls and points per game and the scoring margin of +8.60 is sixth in the nation. The Bears 10.47 caused turnovers per game ranks 11th in the nation.

TERRIFYING TRIO

Lenoir-Rhyne has three players who rank inside the top 21 in the nation in goals per game. The trio of Toron Eccleston (3.57 gpg), Myles Moffat (3.43) and Eric Dickinson (2.86) are one of the highest scoring trifectas in all of Division II. Eccleston ranks sixth in the nation in goals per game.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

The Bears have seven games with at least 20 goals so far in just nine games this season. This sets the record for the most games with 20+ goals in a season. The previous high was three which was done in 2014 and 2017.

PERFECT ON THE ROAD

For the second time in program history, Lenoir-Rhyne completed a perfect regular season on the road. The Bears went 6-0 back in 2018 before losing at Wingate in the SAC Championship. This season, LR went 5-0 and won't play on the road again until a possible NCAA Tournament contest.

FIRST-EVER

Eric Dickinson became the first player in program history to earn USILA Regional Offensive Player of the Year accolades. Dickinson, who also earned SAC Player of the Year, was named the top offensive threat in the South Region.

NCAA HISTORY

This is the second time in LR history that the Bears have been the No. 1 seed in the South Region. The other being in 2018 when LR went 17-3 and lost to Saint Leo by one goal in the National Semifinal. The Bears own a 2-2 all-time record in NCAA Tournament games with wins over Colorado Mesa (2018) and Tampa (2021). In total, this is the third NCAA Tournament appearance for LR who also made the field in 2017 but lost to Tampa.

COMEBACK SZN

In LR's 16-15 win over Tampa, the Bears overcame a 5-goal second-half deficit which was the largest comeback win in program history. LR came back from 4-goal deficits twice but never more than that until last Sunday.
