#### ALL ON THE LINE

The brackets played out with the No. 1 seed in the North and the No. 1 seed in the South meeting in the National Championship game. The Bears and Dolphins have never met prior to Sunday.

#### RANKED RUN

A win over Le Moyne would not only give Lenoir-Rhyne its first National Championship, it would mean the Bears closed the season with wins over the No. 1, 3, 4 and 5 teams in the nation in the final four games of the season.

#### LENOIR-RHYNE HISTORY

The Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse Team joins the 2013 Football Team as the only teams to advance to a National Championship game in the NCAA Era. The Bears have a chance to join the 1960 Football Team as the only National Champions in LR history as the 1960 Bears brought home a NAIA National Title.

#### FIRST TIMERS VS. VETS

Not only do Lenoir-Rhyne and Le Moyne have contrasting styles of play, they also differ in national prominence. The Bears have been around for 11 years as a program and are playing in the National Championship for the first time in program history. The Dolphins are playing for the National Title for the 10th time in program history and have already won five championship games.

#### AGAINST THE BEST

Lenoir-Rhyne has played seven games against ranked opponents this season and own a 6-1 mark. A win would give LR its 16 of the season, one shy of the team record of 17 which came in 20 games in 2018 as compared to just 17 this year.

### BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine has guided the Bears to four South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, one SAC Tournament title and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 91-58 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 58 times, including being as

high as No. 3 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 43 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and eight have been All-Americans. He had two players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had two players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and one been named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lacrosse team and played on four ACC Championship teams and won a National Championship in 1991.

### LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### ROAD LESS TRAVELED

For the first time since March 30, Lenoir-Rhyne will play a game away from Moretz Stadium. Thanks to hosting the conference tournament and first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament, the Bears have played just five road games and are unbeaten away from Hickory.

#### 200 FOR 42

Senior Eric Dickinson became one of just six players in NCAA Division II history to top 200 career goals with his fourth tally against Wingate last weekend. Dickinson finished the game with six goals and now has 202 for his career to go with 305 career points.

#### BIG WEEKEND FOR THE PARADINE'S

Head Coach Greg Paradine has a chance to have an extra special Memorial Day weekend. Paradine's daughter Mason is a member of the North Carolina Women's Lacrosse Team who has advanced to the National Semifinal. The women's National Championship game is on Sunday at noon and the Bears play Sunday at 1.

#### PART II FOR COACH P

Paradine won a National Championship as a player at the University of North Carolina in 1991. Paradine played for the Tar Heels from 1990-93.

#### TAKING DOWN #1

A win over Le Moyne on Sunday

would be the Bears third victory of the No. 1 team in the nation in program history. The Bears twice topped No. 1 Limestone, including a dramatic win over the Saints in 2020.

#### RECORD BROKEN

Despite playing in five less games than the 2018 team, this year's squad broke the program record for most goals scored in a season. The 2018 Bears scored 287 times in 20 games while the 2020 Bears have 297 goals in 16 games played. LR also broke the mark for most points in a season.

#### ALL-AMERICANS

Lenoir-Rhyne came into the season with eight All-Americans in program history but added five on Thursday. According to the USILA, Eric Dickinson and Bryce Reece were First Team All-Americans and the trio of Myles Moffat, Zach Bodeau and Connor Stanley were Honorable Mentions. Additionally, Dickinson was named the Lt. Col. JI Turnbull Outstanding Attackman of the Year.

#### HOW THEY GOT HERE

It seemed like the run to the title game was a fading memory as LR stared down a 7-1 deficit to Tampa after the first quarter of the NCAA Quarterfinal. Additionally, the Bears trailed 10-5 at the half. However, LR put together their biggest second half comeback in program history and erased the five-goal deficit to send the game to overtime.

Unlikely hero Colten McCracken scored his seventh goal of the season with four seconds left in overtime to send the Bears to the Semifinals. In that round, LR ran up against familiar foe Wingate. The third encounter this year was all LR as the Bears stormed past the Bulldogs 18-10 behind Dickinson's six goals.

#### HERO DOING HERO THINGS

McCracken was the hero for LR against Tampa and will continue to play that role this weekend. However, it will not be in a Lenoir-Rhyne jersey. The freshman will honor his commitment to the Army Reserves as he enlists in boot camp in Oklahoma and is forced to miss the game.

#### HATCHER HEATER

Freshman Kyle Hatcher has taken his game to another level during the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament. Hatcher exploded for four goals against Tampa (all in the second half) in the Quarterfinal and netted a hat trick against Wingate.

#### LAST 23

Lenoir-Rhyne has been on a tremendous run since the start of the 2020 season. In the 23 games since the '20 season started, Lenoir-Rhyne is 21-2 with losses to No. 6 Belmont Abbey and No. 6 Wingate. During that span, Lenoir-Rhyne has beaten SIX PLUS LAST YEAR ranked teams including five wins over teams inside the top five.

#### NCAA HISTORY

This is the second time in LR history that the Bears have been the No. 1 seed in the South Region. The other being in 2018 when LR went 17-3 and lost to Saint Leo by one goal in the National Semifinal. The Bears own a 3-2 all-time record in NCAA Tournament games with a win over Colorado Mesa (2018) prior to this years victories. In total, this is the third NCAA Tournament appearance for LR who also made the field in 2017 but lost to Tampa.
