### » RECAP

Hickory, N.C. – The Lenoir-Rhyne University Football Team (0-1) fell to Virginia State (1-0), 34-9, Saturday afternoon in the 2016 season opener at Moretz Stadium.

Virginia State's Kavon Bellamy (Hampton, Va.) scored twice on the ground and rushed for a game-high 83 yards as the Trojans jumped out to a 20-0 lead in the second quarter and remained in control the rest of the way.

Virginia State scored touchdowns the first three times it touched the ball including a three-yard scoring run by Bellamy to cap off a nine-play, 85-yard drive on the opening possession.

The Trojans quarterback, Tarian Ayres (Buckingham, Va.), passed for 201 yards and a touchdown to go along with 46 yards on the ground as Virginia State held a 445-213 yards advantage in total offense.

Lenoir-Rhyne's lone score came at the end of the first half when redshirt freshman Jarrod Kellar (Shinnston, W.Va.) found senior tight end Ray Beam (Morganton, N.C.) in the corner of the end zone for a 15-yard scoring toss but the Bears were held off the scoreboard the rest of the way minus a safety with 21 second remaining. Kellar

threw for 158 yards on the day.

The Trojans' Trenton Cannon (Hampton, Va.) added two touchdowns – one rushing and one receiving – while Geo Feggins (South Hill, Va.) led all tacklers with 15 in the victory. For the Bears, senior defensive back Rodney Singleton (Hawthorne, Fla.) finished with a team-high 11 takedowns and recovered a fumble. Virginia State also totaled four sacks for the contest.

Lenoir-Rhyne remains at home to take on North Greenville next Saturday night at 7:00 p.m., while Virginia State hosts Tusculum on Saturday, September 10, at 2:00 p.m.



### » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### SEASON OPENER

» The 102nd season in Lenoir-Rhyne Football history is upon us with a season-opening non-conference matchup between the No. 6 Bears and Virginia St. This will be the first matchup between the two program since 2016 and the third meeting in history. Each team has won once in the head-to-head series.

#### PRESEASON POLLS

» The Bears rank No. 7 in the nation in the D2Football.com preseason poll. The last time the Bears ranked that high in the D2Football preseason poll came back in 2014 when they were ranked No. 6 fresh off a trip to the 2013 National Championship game.

» In the AFCA poll, the Bears preseason rank is No. 4 in the nation as voted by the coaches.

» As evidenced by those two polls, the Bears were also picked to win the South Atlantic Conference by the league coaches. The Bears earned five of nine first place votes.

#### NON-CONFERENCE STREAK

» Lenoir-Rhyne has won six straight regular season games against non-conference opponents. The last loss came in the 2018 season-opener when they Bears fell to No. 12 West Alabama 36-32. Since then, LR has defeated North Greenville, Fort Valley St., UNC Pembroke (twice), St. Augustine's and Virginia Union.

#### STREAK PART II

» Lenoir-Rhyne has a two-game winning streak against CIAA foes with both of those wins coming in the first two weeks

of the 2019 season. The last loss to a CIAA opponent came at the hands of Virginia St. on Sept. 3, 2016.

#### THREE PEAT?

» When looking solely at fall championships, the Bears have a chance to win a third straight league title.

» The Bears won in 2018 and 2019 before falling to Tusculum in the SAC Championship in an abbreviated 2020-21 season. The game was the first-ever SAC Championship game as the conference was broken into two divisions with the division winners meeting in a "championship" game.

» Lenoir-Rhyne is also the last SAC team to win three consecutive league crowns. The Bears won in 2012, 2013 and 2014.

» The last non-LR 3-peat came back in 2002-04 when Carson-Newman reigned supreme in the league standings.

#### FIRST TIME OUT FOR THE TROJANS

» This will mark the first game for the Virginia St. football program since a 27-24 home win over Virginia Union back on Nov. 9, 2019. The Trojans didn't play in the fall or spring of 2020 but wrapped up the 2019 campaign with an impressive 8-2 overall mark and a 6-1 record in league play.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### QB1

» The all-time winningest QB in LR Football history returns behind center for his fourth season as a starter. Grayson Willingham's name is all over the LR record book but the most impressive record is his won-loss record as the starting QB which stands as 25-4 in his 29 career starts.

» Willingham reached new levels of success in Mike Jacobs system during the spring, throwing for 950 yards in three games including a career-high 353 yards in the SAC Championship. Willingham tossed seven touchdowns to just two interceptions in the spring and hit on 61.8 percent of his passes.

» Willingham owns the record for most career touchdowns and is second in career passing yards. His 54.7 career completion percentage is fourth in program history and his 329 completions rank third.

#### DAREKE THE FREAK

» A two-time selection to Bruce Feldman's 'Freaks List' is Lenoir-Rhyne's next NFL prospect. Young made his two games count in the spring, finishing with 14 grabs for 218 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

» In the SAC Championship, Young went off for nine grabs and 166 yards which ranks as the fourth-most yards in a single game in the NCAA Era.

#### DEEWEE

» It was quite a debut for freshman RB Dwayne McGee (nicknamed Deewee) in the Bears spring season.

» McGee started his career with 352 yards rushing in his first two career games. Against Barton, McGee had 192 yards and three touchdowns and the true freshman had 114 carries in his four games.

#### 'DRE DAY

» Not to be outdone by Young, sophomore WR Deondre Leser has stepped up in a major way.

» After going for 8 catches and 144 yards against Barton, Lester followed up with four grabs for 77 yards and a touchdown against Wingate.

» Lester has found the end zone in back-to-back games and has long receptions of 40 and 34 in those two games.

» On the year, Lester led LR with 17 grabs and 272 yards.

#### IRON MAN IAN

» OL Ian Brinson enters the season in his familiar spot anchoring the offensive line.

» Brinson has started each of the past three seasons and has started 32 consecutive games for the Bears.

» For his career, Brinson has seen action in 40 career games.

## » LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### SACK STREAK REACHES 43

» In the 2020-21 spring championship game, Preston Joseph brought down the QB to extend Lenoir-Rhyne's streak of straight games with at least one sack to 43. The Bears have recorded 132 total sacks in that 43 game stretch. LR has recorded multiple sacks in 27 of their last 29 games in total.

### DOMINATING THE TRENCHES

» The strength of the Lenoir-Rhyne is the defensive line which has All-Conference performers Amari Houston and Dan Louba returning on the interior and a host of depth. Zeke Nance and Quentin Hayes return as starters on the edge and Rashad Yelding, Willie Lane, Andre Jefferson and De'Andre Shelton provide tremendous depth.

### BRICK CURTAIN

» Over the past three seasons, Lenoir-Rhyne has only allowed one player to rush for more than 100 yards against them. That comes out to just one 100-yard rusher in the last 31 games.

» The last back to break the century mark was Jerko'ya Patton from Limestone who took 12 carries for 147 yards thanks in large part to an 85 yard run.

» Prior to that, the last 100 yard rushing game for an opposing player came back on November 11, 2017 when Catawba's Kenyatta Greene ran 19 times for 142 yards.

» The last 100-yard rusher at Moretz Stadium was the week prior (Nov. 4, 2017) when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran 18

times for 108 yards.

### LB TRIO

» The Lenoir-Rhyne starting LB trio is a formidable one as they patrol the middle of LR's 4-3 defense.

» The combination of Jon Ross Maye and Percy King played their first season in 2020-21 and turned heads. Maye led the Bears with 34 tackles in his four games and added a blocked kick. King was third on the team with 25 tackles and added a team-high four interceptions, including a pair against Barton. Preston Joseph is the veteran of the group but entered the starting lineup for the first time in his career during the spring. The solid LB was fourth on the squad with 22 tackles and had a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

### E-JACK IS BACK

» One of the most talented defensive backs in the nation returns for his senior season. Eric Jackson has played in 42 career games for the Bears and has 172 career tackles and his 12 INTs rank eighth in program history. Jackson's 175 career interception yards ranks seventh in the 102-year history of LR Football. Jackson has three multiple INT games in his career including a 3-INT game at Mars Hill in 2019.

## » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 43 straight games and multiple sacks in 27 of their last 29 games.

In the 43-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 132 sacks.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

#### RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 111 straight extra points which is just 16 shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

#### BLOCK PARTY

- » The special teams unit blocked three kicks against Barton. Jon Ross Maye and JP Palmer each blocked field goals and Amari Houston was credited with a blocked extra point.
- » The Maye blocked field goal set the tone for the game as it came on Barton's first drive and they came away scoreless.

#### EARLY IMPACT

- » On the second special teams play of the season (aside from the opening kickoff), Lenoir-Rhyne's special teams broke through with a huge play.
- » Jordan Holmes blocked a Newberry punt and Alvin James scooped it up and returned it

20 yards for the first touchdown of the 2020-21 season.

#### BE LIKE MIKE

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Owen boomed a 50-yarder against Barton and placed one at the one yard line against Newberry in the season opener.

#### PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

#### RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
