#### » RECAP

MARS HILL, N.C. – The No. 8 Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team piled up 609 yards of total offense in a 56-28 victory over Mars Hill that featured three weather delays and took four hours and 52 minutes to complete. Grayson Willingham threw for 277 yards and three touchdowns, while Jace Jordan ran for 159 yards and added a pair of TDs on the ground. Lenoir-Rhyne had won only five of the previous 20 matchups at Mars Hill and was leading just 28-21 at the half before outscoring the hosts 28-7 in the second half.

#### **INSIDE THE MATCHUP:**

#### STATS OF THE GAME:

- As has been the strength of LR, the run game was dominating again this afternoon. The Bears pounded out 332 rushing yards on 55 attempts, good for an average of 6.0 yards per carry. The Red & Black were led by Jace Jordan who ran for 159 yards on 15 carries and added a pair of touchdowns in just his second game.
- Ameen Stevens ran for a pair of touchdowns, giving him five this year and 16 in his career.
   Caine Crews added a touchdown on the ground.
- Dareke Young netted his first-career 100yard receiving game as the junior had five catches for 108 yards and a touchdown. Young would add three carries for 19 yards.
- The Bears scored on their first drive but Mars Hill answered to even the game at seven. On the

first play of the next drive, Willingham hit Jaquay Mitchell for an 80-yard touchdown strike. It was the first LR 80-yard TD since Miles Freeman hit Victor Brannan for an 82-yarder against Tusculum in 2014

- DB Eric Jackson had a career-day finishing with 10 tackles, 0.5 tackle for loss and three interceptions including one in the end zone.
- DL Dan Louba added six tackles, three tackles for loss and a pair of sacks, while Jaquan Artis registered his 20th career sack.
- Preseason All-American WR Craig Rucker continued to be a playmaker, finishing with 10 catches for 161 yards and two TDs including a 75-yarder at the end of the third quarter. Rucker has two touchdown catches in each of his four games against LR and has gone over 130 yards on three occasions.

#### **BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:**

- The Bears' 609 yards of offense matched the most since Drew Cronic took over prior to the 2018 campaign. The Bears also put up 609 against Limestone on Homecoming last season. Before that, the Bears hadn't put up 600 yards in a game since 2014 when they had 622 against Tusculum on Sept. 27.
- Jordan became the first Bear to run for 100 yards in a game this season. Combined with Young's 108 yards, the duo became the first teammates to run and catch for over 100 yards in the same game since Sept. 29, 2018.



#### **LIONS AND BEARS, OH MY!**

- » Today marks the 50th all-time meeting between Lenoir-Rhyne and Mars Hill, and it's a dead heat in the series. The series between the Bears and Lions is tied 24-24-1, with LR winning the last two and six of the last ten. The Bears are 16-11-1 against Mars Hill at Moretz Stadium.
- » The Bears have scored 115 combined points in the two consecutive wins over Mars Hill. LR took down MHU 59-27 the last time the two played in Hickory in 2018 and followed that up with a 56-28 drubbing of the Lions in 2019 on the road.
- » In the 2019 game, Grayson Willingham threw for 277 yards and three touchdowns, and Dareke Young grabbed five passes for 108 yards and a score. The Bears had 609 yards of offense that day, including 332 yards on the ground.

#### **SAC STREAK BROKEN**

- » Before last Saturday's 28-21 loss to Newberry, Lenoir-Rhyne had won 18 straight regular season contests against South Atlantic Conference opponents.
- » The three straight undefeated seasons in league play was the longest in LR history and the 18 consecutive wins over SAC opponents tied the longest in program history. The Bears also won 18 conference games in a row from 2013-15.

#### **BOUNCE BACK MENTALITY**

» Since 2017, LR is 6-2 coming off a loss. The Bears have outscored opponents by an average of 19 points per game in those games. » Since 2010, the Bears are 22-14 coming off a loss.

#### **HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE**

» Since 2010, the Bears are 42-0 when scoring 40+ points. In the last two meetings with Mars Hill, they've scored over 50 points each time.

#### **NOCTURNAL BEARS**

» Since 2010, the Bears are 23-11 in night games (kicking off at 6 PM or later).

#### **LION LOW-DOWN**

- » Mars Hill is 2-1 on the season. They lost their opener 30-24 to Chowan in overtime and have won two consecutive blowouts against Virginia-Lynchburg (50-14) and UVA Wise (44-9).
- » Quarterback Jimmy Urzua is off to a strong start this season, throwing for 635 yards and nine touchdowns in the first three games.
- » Mars Hill has three different running backs that are over 100 yards rushing on the season, led by Traineal Moore. Senior wide receiver CJ Thompson leads the Lions with 274 receiving yards through three games.

#### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### **DEWEE**

- » With 113 yards rushing against Newberry, Dwayne McGee has topped 100 yards in four of his first six career games.
- » The freshman ranks 19th in the nation in all purpose yards per game at 156 and sixth in the nation with 6.8 yards per carry.

#### **MOVING THE CHAINS**

» Lenoir-Rhyne ranks fifth in all of NCAA Division II in third down conversion percentage. The Bears come into Saturday with a 57.6 percent conversion rate on third downs.

#### **TE INVOLVEMENT**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne tight end's have combined for eight catches in the first two games, with six of those coming from Cody Osburn.
- » A season ago, Lenoir-Rhyne tight ends had just four grabs in four games with two of those coming from Osburn.

#### **WILLINGHAM TOPS 200 AGAIN**

» After throwing for 205 yards against Newberry, Grayson Willingham topped 200 yards passing for the 12th time in his career. The only player in LR history to have more 200 yard passing games than Willingham is Brett Meunier who had 15.

#### **WILLINGHAM MOVIN' UP**

» With his 458 yards passing so far this season, Willingham is in second place in program history with 5,867 career passing yards. He sits just 717 yards shy of Brian Bryson's 6,583 all-time passing yard mark which has stood since 1987.

- » Willingham is third in program history with 372 career completions and needs just 61 to pass Meunier for second place.
- » The senior QB is already the program leader in career touchdown passes and is fourth in history in career completion percentage.

#### **STRIKE FIRST**

- » Despite dropping a game at Newberry in which the Bears put points on the board first, LR has a 64-10 mark since 2010 when scoring first. When opponents score first in that span, the Bears are 22-28.
- » Additionally, the Bears own a 61-7 mark since 2010 when leading after the first quarter.

#### **0-LINE CONSISTENCY**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has started the same five offensive linemen for each of the first two games this season.
- » Dating back to the spring, the same five offensive linemen (Jennings, Heidinger, Jefferson, Chapman and Brinson) started each of the four spring games running the consecutive games started string for the group to six straight.

#### **LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES**

#### **SACK STREAK REACHES 45**

- » The Bears continue to wreak havoc on opposing QBs as they ran the program record of consecutive games with a sack to 45 when De'Andre Shelton brought down Dre Harris of Newberry.
- » With just one sack against the Wolves, the Bears failed to record multiple sacks in a game for the just the third time in the last 31 games.

#### **100-YARD RUSHER**

- » Lenoir-Rhyne saw its streak of not allowing an opposing rusher to top 100 yards on the ground come to an end at 12 straight on Saturday.
- » SAC Offensive Player of the Week Mario Anderson toted the rock 20 times for 124 yards in Newberry's win.
- » The last opposing RB to top 100 yards was Jerko'ya Patton of Limestone on Oct. 26, 2019.
- » Prior to that, the last 100 yard rushing game for an opposing player came back on November 11, 2017 when Catawba's Kenyatta Greene ran 19 times for 142 yards.
- » The last 100-yard rusher at Moretz Stadium was the week prior (Nov. 4, 2017) when Carson-Newman's Derrick Evans ran 18 times for 108 yards.

#### FIRST DOWN D

» LR ranks in the top 10 in the nation (ninth overall) in first down defense. The Bears have allowed just 30 first downs over their first two games of the season.

#### **JUST PICKS**

» Jimmy Palmer ranks second ni the nation with two interceptions, averaging one per game. Palmer has each of the two interceptions for LR on the season and is fourth on the team with nine total tackles.

#### **CAREER-BEST PERFORMANCE**

- » LB Preston Joseph had a career-high eight tackles against Newberry on Saturday, topping his previous career-best performance of seven tackles against Barton in the spring of 2021.
- » Joseph leads all LR defenders with 14 total tackles on the year and is second on the squad with seven solo stops.

#### **RED ZONE D**

- Out of 144 ranked teams, the Bears are25th in the nation in red zone defense.
- » The Bears give up just 60 percent touchdowns when opponents get into the LR red zone.

#### D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

- » Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne has a 15-1 record when the defense scores a touchdown in a game.
- » The last defensive TD in a game came on a Preston Joseph fumble recovery against Wingate in a 44-21 blowout win on April 2, 2021.

#### SACK STREAK

#### RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 120 straight extra points which is just seven shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS HEAVY HITTERS**

- » Each week, the LR football team hands out the Southside Fitness Heavy Hitter of the Week award, and the first two awards of the 2021 season have gone to special teams stalwarts.
- » Starting wide receiver Tre Luttrell was given the award after week one due to his contributions on special teams, and wide receiver Kelin Parsons won in week two for his efforts on special teams.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS**

» Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record in those

#### games.

» Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game during that stretch. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

#### **BE LIKE MIKE**

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Last week, Owen pinned Newberry down inside their own 20 twice, and inside the 10 once, giving a boost to the Bear defense.

#### **PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES**

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

#### **RETURN STREAK**

» Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
